TRANSPARENCY AT ALL LEVELS

I believe all levels of government must be accountable to the people they represent. Respecting taxpayer's money by making basic financial information publicly available should not be a debated issue, it is simply common sense.

When the Liberals campaigned, they promised transparency in government. Then why did the Liberals decide not to enforce Bills C-27 and C-377?

The First Nations Financial Trans-

parency Bill (C-27) ensured that First Nations Government make their financial information publicly available. This gave community members access to basic financial information such as audited financial statements, and the salaries and expenses of chief and council.

The Union Financial Transparency Bill (C-377) was intended to provide rank-and-file union members and the general public with unions' financial information. A forum research poll in July 2015 showed that 62% of Canadians supported this bill.

Both these Bills would have ushered a new era of accountability to Indigenous Canadians, union members and the public at large. Instead of repealing these laws through proper Parliamentary channels, as promised, the Liberal Government decided not to enforce them.

Basic financial information for many politicians at different levels of government, including Members of Parliament, is publicly available. I fully support and endorse transparency at all levels, as should the new Liberal government.

- 75 and over - talk to your healthcare provider about whether

screening mammography should remain part of your breast health routine.

With his hair mostly shaved off now and only a bright pink fauxhawk remaining, Gwodz seems to receive a healthy portion of friend-

ly jabs from his fellow firefighters, but even with all the good-natured pestering he gets, he takes it in stride as he knows his new look and the friendly banter he receives is all for a good cause. "I know my total was over \$500 towards the local campaign," Gwodz excitedly shares. "That's in addition to what the hair studio raised."

Gwodz is referring to the Other Side Hair Studio in Edson who annually coordinate a local fundraising effort by doing a one-day


colour-and-cut event with all the proceeds going towards the local cancer support group. Gwodz, who gets his hair cut at the studio, was asked by them if he wanted to take part in this year's campaign to help bring more awareness to their efforts. GRANDE YELLOWHEAD PUBLIC SCHOOL DIVISION BOARD NEWS

Listening to Our Students

The Board welcomed the opportunity for all division schools to participate in the Tell Them From Me (TTFM) student engagement survey that was embedded in last year's Alberta Education Accountability Pillar Survey. Although this made the process a little longer for students in grades 4 to 12 to complete, the survey is an excellent tool for students to have a voice in education and guide future school planning in order to meet identified needs.

The TTFM survey measures include:

- Social engagement measures such as sense of belonging and positive relationships.
- Institutional engagement measures such as value of school outcomes and positive behavior at school.
- Intellectual engagement measures such as interest and motivation.
- Emotional health measures such as anxiety and depression.
- Academic measures that reflect on achievement in English, Math and Science.
- Quality instruction measures such as

effective learning time and relevance.

Leslee Jodry, Assistant Superintendent of Learning Services, provided trustees with the copies of the detailed results from last year and discussed what has already been implemented in schools as a result. All GYPSD students in grades 4-12 will participate in the TTFM survey process as part of this school year's provincial accountability surveys.

OTHER News in Brief

- The Board approved a revision to the 2015-16 Budget to include funding for the replacement of three aging passenger vehicles and for a pilot project to investigate the implementation of new technology and other innovative educational resources under the Board's focus of improving student learning.
- Trustee Stitzenberger was appointed to be the Board's representative on the Teachers' Employer Bargaining Association (TEBA).
- Policy 10 - Policy Making, was amended for the Board to review division policies every two years.
- The First Quarter Financial Report noted that target revenues and expenditures are being met as of November 30th for the current school year.
- Trustees were provided with the

recent changes to both AP 120 & AP 445 for their information. AP445 - ATA Professional Growth Fund Committee was revised to align with recent changes to Policy 20 - Professional Growth of Teachers. AP120 - Policy and Procedures Development, Review and Dissemination now amalgamates information from AP121 due to their similarities.

- Stuart Graham, principal of The Learning Connection, gave a presentation on their new location in Jasper which currently has 16 students registered for off-campus programming.
- Trustees were pleased to learn about the many initiatives that continue to take place throughout the division in regards to supporting our First Nations, Métis and Inuit students. Sandy Axmann, Supervisor of Learning Services, discussed how this support is based on providing FNMI programming, engaging parents and collaborating with community partners, and she also outlined a number of specific examples for the Board in her report.
- GYPSD is proud to offer a new program of studies this school year, the Career and Technology Foundations (CTF), for students in grades 5 to 9 to

explore their interests and skills through learning experiences based on various occupational areas. Although not a prerequisite for entry in to Career and Technology Studies courses in grades 10-12, the new CTF program assists students in making informed decisions as they enter high school. Please visit www.alberta-actf.ca to learn more about the program.

• Since 2012, the division has made great strides in implementing an in-depth health and wellness program throughout GYPSD schools. Along with the development of a new formal Policy as well as receiving substantial grant funding, Grande Yellowhead has accomplished many wellness goals over the last three years which were highlighted for the Board at today's meeting. GYPSD representatives have been asked to present on the division's wellness initiatives at the upcoming provincial Shaping the Future conference later this month.

• For the second year, both internal and external stakeholders will be asked for their feedback through participation in the Thought exchange process which assists the division in its planning for providing meaningful and supportive learning opportunities.

TREATIES 1-11 CHIEFS UNITE IN CALL TO RENEW THE TREATY RELATIONSHIP

January 21, 2016, Treaty No.6, Enoch Cree Nation, Alberta... Indigenous Nations met over the past two days to bring to life an action plan that will set priorities in implementing the Treaty rights of the First Nations who are a part of Treaties 1-11. Approximately 300 Indigenous Chiefs, elders and members attended to unite in common interests on the protection of the

Treaties and Inherent Rights. "We as Treaty Peoples are developing our strategies to implement our jurisdiction over our lands, water and resources. We owe this to our future generations and those yet unborn. We are cautiously optimistic with the promises of the newly elected federal government from Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls (MMIWG), implementation of the 94 recommendations of the Truth

and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) and the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (UNDRIP)," stated Chief Bernice Martial of Cold Lake First Nation. The discussions focused on engagement with Canada and the newly elected, Prime Minister Justin Trudeau and the Governor General, David Johnston who represents the Crown (Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth of England) who entered into Trea-

ties with Nations. The Peace and Friendship Treaties allowed for the Queen's subjects to live among our Nations for as long as the sun shines, the grass grows and the rivers flow. "We must help each other collectively and pass on the knowledge of Treaties and our Inherent Rights to the next generation. Our responsibility is to educate our youth on the history of our Peoples. We are all Treaty Peoples, which includes all Canadians. We need to educate everyone on the Spirit and Intent of our Treaties, as this is a big part of Canada's history," said Chief Martial.

The Treaty meeting also included a report from the United Nations Climate Change conference (COP21) that occurred last month in Paris. Our landscapes, ecosystems and environment has shifted, we no longer will allow our land, water and resources to be sacrificed. We are the original stewards of our land and have an obligation to the next seven generations to uphold for them, which includes all peoples that live within our country.

"Hunting, Fishing and Trapping are guaranteed to pursue as our livelihood. Our own traditional economic practices are still as relevant today. We are losing these rights to our livelihood and need to reinforce our stance that these issues are not negotiable. This is recognized through our Inherent Rights and Treaty," concluded Chief Martial.

Cold Lake First Nations is a Denesuline (Chipewyan) Tribe and part of the Dene Nation. The Nation is located 300 kilometers northeast of Edmonton, Alberta in Treaty No.6 territory. The dynamic First Nation has a total membership of over 2400 members. Approximately 1500 Band Members live in or near its four distinct neighbouring communities all of which are located in the scenic Cold Lake area.
