Business licence renewal fees are \$150 for residential and \$300 for non-residential. Payment can also be made at the Civic Centre using cash, debit, cheque, Visa, MasterCard or American Express.

## Easy Ways To Trim Wedding Costs

### Arrangements

Floral arrangements are a big and potentially expensive part of many couples' weddings. The bride needs her bouquet, as do her bridesmaids.
