## MAYERTHORPE RCMP CHARGE TWO WITH POSSESSION OF A STOLEN VEHICLE

# PORTION OF HIGHWAY 37 RENAMED “LAC STE. ANNE TRAIL”

After nearly two years of discussion and planning with Alberta Transportation, approval was given recently for the renaming of a portion of Highway 37. Long before proper roads were common this part of Alberta, a trail linked St. Albert with the mission at Lac Ste. Anne. The trail, some 50 km in length, originated in St. Albert and followed the Sturgeon River to Calahoo, then along what is now Highway 37 to Onoway and finally across country from Onoway to Alberta Beach and the mission at Lac Ste. Anne.

The four new Lac Ste. Anne Trail signs along Highway 37 were designed by the Onoway and District Historical Guild. The half wagon wheel symbolizes the many horse- and oxen-drawn wagons and Red River carts that used the trail over the years.

An historical marker was erected two years ago on the segment of the trail that winds its way from Highway 37 through Onoway to Highway 43. The marker reads

From the mid-1800s or earlier, there was a continuous going and coming between Edmonton and Lac Ste. Anne because Fort Edmonton depended on fish from Lac Ste. Anne to supplement its food supply.

After the St. Albert Mission was established in 1861, this trail was a veritable highway. Besides Father Lacombe and other missionaries, the trail was used by explorers, prospectors, surveyors, farmers, early settlers and native peoples.

From St. Albert, this route

touched on St. Peter or Ville-neuve, the Calahoo Indian Reserve to Noyes Crossing where it crossed the Sturgeon River. It then skirted the north end of Little Devil’s Lake (Matchayan), continued past Onoway and Alberta Beach to Lac Ste. Anne.

The trail is approximately 50 km in length.

Additional “Lac Ste. Anne Trail” signs will be installed this summer between Onoway and Alberta Beach.

Onoway, Alta. –An autopsy was conducted on June 27, 2016 in relation to a sudden death in Onoway. The Medical Examiner has determined that the manner of death is a homicide.

In the early morning of June 26, 2016 RCMP members responded to a sudden death at a residence in Onoway. Edmonton RCMP Forensic Identification Section and Police Dog Services attended with the Stony Plain/Spruce Grove RCMP.

RCMP Major Crimes Unit with the assistance of Stony Plain General Investigation Section has now taken carriage of this homicide investigation.

The RCMP is seeking public assistance in determining the movement of and activities of the victim, 37-year-old Glen Allen Abbott, in the days prior to June 26.

## TIPS FOR NEWCOMERS TO THE GAME OF GOLF

Few hobbies can be as enjoyable one moment and as frustrating the next as golf. Golfers know a great putt can be quickly followed by a bad tee shot, and maintaining their composure through the highs and lows of the game is a key to success on the links.

\* Have fun. Golf is a fun game; it just takes time to hone your skills. But even if you aren't ready for the professional tour after your first few rounds, you can still have fun. Don't let some beginner's frustration, which every golfer experiences, ruin the fun of the game. Take note of your surroundings when you hit the links, and appreciate the time you're spending with your group. If the game becomes more a source of frustration than fun, then take a break and put in some more work away from the course, be it at the driving range or studying at home.

# GOLFER'S GUIDE

## HELP KIDS LEARN THE GAME OF GOLF

Adults who play golf know just how fun and frustrating the game can be. Whether you're a veteran golfer or someone just learning the links, golf can be challenging.

But as exacting as the game can be, it also can be just as rewarding, even for kids. Children who embrace the game of golf will learn a host of lessons they can apply in all facets of life. A humbling game even for professional golfers, golf can teach kids lessons in humility and the value of persistence even when things aren't going your way.

Golf is also a great way for parents to get kids off the couch and outdoors for some fun in the sun. Instead of spending summer afternoons in front of the television, kids who play golf are out patrolling pristine golf courses while getting some cardiovascular exercise along the way. Golf can also strengthen a child's hand-eye coordination, which can help them in other activities, including many different sports.

When kids move on from preschool to elementary school, some might want to tag along with Mom or Dad to the driving range. As kids enter middle school and approach high school, those

As a child gets closer to high school, you might want to buy the child his or her own set of clubs. Look for inexpensive clubs (oftentimes, thrift stores or other secondhand retailers have clubs for sale) because growing children will eventually grow out of their first set of clubs. When your child finds a set of clubs that suits him or her, teach the proper way to swing and consider signing up your son or daughter for lessons. Those first few lessons can prove invaluable, turning a pastime into a passion kids will carry with them throughout their lives.

# WHITECOURT TOWN COUNCIL UPDATE

June 28, 2016

Council has approved the purchase of two new transit buses to serve Whitecourt Transit. The buses have been purchased in part with funds approved from the Province's GreenTRIP Grant Program, and are expected to arrive next spring. Council also adopted a public transportation strategic plan which was developed by the Public Transit Steering Committee. The Town has made a 10 year commitment to public transportation, and the goals and priorities outlined in the strategic plan will aim for Whitecourt Transit use to reach levels similar to a larger urban center, making public transportation a core service.

Council has adopted the 2016 20-Year Capital Plan. The plan, which is adopted annually, provides a vision for the Town of Whitecourt's infrastructure, land development, parks and trails, building and recreation facilities to meet the needs of our growing community. The plan sets broad direction that helps guide decision making, promotes sustainability in the future and enhances residents' quality of life. The plan can be viewed on [www.whitecourt.ca](http://www.whitecourt.ca).

Council has passed third and final reading of Bylaw 1518 which will allow the Town to borrow \$1,690,000 to construct a leachate treatment system, road and cell to meet continuing

demands for landfill services.

An energy audit was recently completed at the Allan & Jean Millar Centre and Scott Safety Centre to identify energy conservation methods that could reduce the facilities' energy consumption, save utility costs, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. Based on the audit, a number of projects will be undertaken which will be funded in part with a \$100,000 grant from the Taking Action to Manager

Energy (Tame+) Program.

Projects scheduled as part of Whitecourt's annual Street Improvement Program will be completed by Knelson Rock Products Ltd. This year's projects include a number of overlay and intersection rehabilitation projects. Once the schedule is complete, information will be posted on [www.whitecourt.ca](http://www.whitecourt.ca) informing motorists and residents of construction areas.

The contract to construct a

new salt/sand storage facility was awarded to Vertical Building Solutions. The facility will be located in the public works yard and will provide an environmentally friendly location to store both salt and sand used on local roads/pathways during the winter months.

Councillor Derek Schlosser has been appointed Deputy Mayor from July 1 to August 31, 2016.


