UKRAINIAN HALL RECENTLY SIGNED

For 37 years the building on the hill one mile west of Sangudo was known as the Ukrainian Hall. Due to declining usage and a volunteer base that was dwindling and aging, the hall ceased operation in the late 1990s.

A sign recognizing its contribution to the community was recently placed near the site, the cost of which was covered by the Russell Werenka family.

The following information is included on the sign:

On June 23, 1965, the Ukrainian Women's and Men's Associations were organized to support and encourage the preservation of the Ukrainian culture and language. The building of a hall in Sangudo to serve as a home for these organizations began in 1958 and the hall opened in 1961. Over the years the hall hosted weddings, funerals, Christmas parties, New Years parties, church services, meet-

ings, dances and political gatherings, and served as a polling station for elections.

The hall was sold in 1998 and is now a private residence.

The Onoway and District Historical Guild continues to sign historic sites and buildings in the County and beyond. Approximately 115 school sites, post offices, cemeteries and historic sites have been marked. For more information, call 780.967.1015.

MORINVILLE RCMP CASE OF A SUDDEN DEATH TRANSITIONS TO HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION

Update#1 – August 9, 2016, at approximately 8:26 A.M., the Morinville RCMP responded to a report that the body of an adult male had been located in a rural area near the intersection of Township Road 540 and Rural

Route 263 by a local resident.

Police attended the location and cordoned off the area to conduct a thorough examination of the scene and removal of the body.


An autopsy was conducted today at the office of the Chief Medical Examiner in Edmonton which determined that the

manner of death in this case is homicide. The identity of the deceased man has yet to be determined and further examination is required.


The RCMP has ensured that all required resources have been made available to move the investigation forward. Members from the RCMP's Major Crimes Unit (MCU) based in Edmonton have assumed carriage of the investigation with assistance from the Forensic Identification Section (FIS) as well as members from the RCMP detachments in Morinville and St. Albert. In addition, assistance is being received from the Edmonton Police Service.

At this time, no additional details or comments will be available as the investigation is ongoing, however, should new information become available the media will receive an updated media release.

St. Albert, AB - On August 2, 2016, St. Albert RCMP Bike Patrol located a vehicle with two occupants parked in a secluded parking area off Pound Maker Road. As this was an unusual area to find a vehicle, the officer check the car which smelled strongly of marijuana. Nine grams of marihuana were seized along with paraphernalia from the vehicle and

the adult occupants were warned about this illegal behaviour and were not charged in this case.

"Marihauna is illegal in Canada unless the person has a medicinal prescription," says Cst. Patrick Lambert with the St. Albert RCMP Crime Prevention Community Policing Section. "But even if a prescription is issued for a marihauna, it is a still a controlled substance that would impair a persons ability to drive. Impaired Driving remains a policing priority and has the ability to kill!"

PROVINCIAL PARKS GET \$239 MILLION TO OFFSET UNDERFUNDING

Recreational users will soon see new and improved campsites, hiking trails, shower buildings, playgrounds, more picnic tables and campsites with power, expanded parking lots and refurbished day-use areas throughout the parks system.

"With nearly a million people moving to Alberta in the past decade, funding for parks barely covered routine maintenance and left little room to invest in new parks and amenities to meet increasing demand. Our unprecedented investment in the provincial parks system is an investment in the well-being of Albertans, supports our move toward a diversified economy through increased tourism, and will create hundreds of jobs." -Shannon Phillips, Minister of Environment and Parks

This investment will be far-reaching and support implementation of Alberta Parks' commitments under the South Saskatchewan Regional Plan (SSRP) (\$50 million) and the Lower Athabasca Regional Plan (LARP) (\$25 million). It will also address facility upgrades and capital maintenance through \$152 million in Capital Maintenance and Renewal (CMR) funding.

Alberta's provincial parks are in dire need of increased maintenance funding to offset decades of neglect that have left many assets such as shelters, roads, visitor information centres and water systems in poor condition.

This money will also support work below the ground, such as water-line replacements and such cosmetic surface improvements as painting and campsite refurbishment.

Alberta's provincial parks system is managed under five regions, all of which receive annual life-cycle maintenance funding to address priorities to enhance the visitor experi-

More than 100 provincial parks, provincial recreation areas and dayuse areas in every region will benefit from government's capital and maintenance commitment, with more than \$38 million supporting projects, planning and flood mitigation this

Many projects are still in the design and planning stage, while others are at various stages of construction.



AUGUST IS IMPAIRED DRIVING MONTH

Driving impaired, whether by alcohol, drugs, fatigue or distraction. imposes enormous costs on our society. Families, the health care system, the legal system, insurance companies and the general public all pay the price for impaired drivers. If you drive impaired, your luck will run out - you will get caught. Even worse, you may be involved in a severe collision that harms someone you love.

Facts to Know

- · Choosing to drive while impaired by drugs or alcohol can get you a criminal record and will cost you: your freedom, your dignity; your job; your chance of future employment and even your life.
- If the police determine your ability to operate a vehicle has been impaired by alcohol or drugs, even if your Blood Alcohol Concentration (BAC) is below .08, you can be charged with impaired driving.
- · Refusing to provide a breath sample will result in a criminal charge and an immediate suspension in the same manner as other Criminal Code (Canada) charges (over .08).
- · Police may disqualify you from driving for 24 hours if they believe your ability to safely operate a motor vehicle is affected by drugs, alcohol, medical condition or physical ability. Police may also seize your vehicle for 24 hours.
- · Designated drivers should not consume any alcohol or use any drugs.
- · On average over the past five years, approximately 8,600 people were convicted of impaired driving in Alberta each year.
- · According to statistics, males between 18 and 21 years of age are most likely to have been drinking before the crash. Also, male drivers are much more likely to have consumed alcohol prior to a collision compared to female drivers.
- On average in Alberta, one in five drivers involved in fatal collisions have been drinking prior to the collision. This compares to an average of about one in 20 drivers involved in injury collisions. As the severity of the collision increases, so does the likelihood the collision will involve a drinking driver.
- · The highest numbers of casualty collisions involving alcohol occur during warmer weather months (May to October).
- · The most casualty collisions involving alcohol occur on the weekends. The most likely time period for these collisions, on any day of the week, is between 11 p.m. and 3 a.m.
- · Drinking and driving collisions are

often associated with long weekends.

- It is estimated that about 20 per cent of fatal collisions in Canada involve driver fatigue.
- · Research indicates that driver distraction contributes to 20 to 30 per cent of all collisions.

How many people are killed or injured in collisions involving drinking drivers?

From 2009 to 2013, on average each year almost 90 people were killed and 1,330 people were injured in collisions involving at least one driver who had consumed alcohol prior to the crash. Specifically, in 2013, 80 people were killed and 1,133 were iniured

How big of an issue is drug impaired driving?

A recent Canadian study of alcohol and drug use among drivers found that drug use in nighttime drivers exceeded that of alcohol use.

How many drinks does it take to be impaired?

Impairment begins with the first drink. The effects of alcoholic drinks vary greatly because the rate of absorption and Blood Alcohol Concentration (BAC) vary from person to person due to factors such as weight, amount of fat tissue and stomach contents. For more information, visit transportation.alberta.ca/4961.htm.

What happens if you refuse to comply with a lawful demand made by a Peace Officer?

Refusing to comply with a lawful demand can result in a charge under section 254 of the Criminal Code. A lawful demand includes: a demand for a breath sample, both at the roadside and for a breathalyzer test; a demand for a blood sample; a demand for physical coordination tests; and a

demand for a drug evaluation.

How long are repeat offences monitored?

Alcohol related offences are monitored for 10 years. Tougher sanctions are in place for repeat offences during this time.

Can medication impair a driver's ability to operate a vehicle?

Talk to your pharmacist about possible side effects of any prescription or over-the-counter medication you may take.

What can I do to minimize distractions that may arise while driving?

- Use a cellphone only if the vehicle is parked in a safe place. If the phone rings while driving, have a passenger take the call or let it go to voice mail.
- Take a rest stop to eat or drink.
- · Avoid emotionally charged conversations with passengers as they may lead to erratic driving behaviour.
- Never take notes or use a laptop while driving. Legally park in a safe place before writing things down.
- · Be prepared for the unexpected actions of other motorists or poor driv-

ing conditions.

- If you need to attend to a child, find a safe spot to park the vehicle before doing so.
- · Avoid programming electronic devices like mp3 players and GPS units while driving.

What can I do to manage fatigue? Drivers can consider doing the following to manage their fatigue:

- Sleep well prior to long road trips.
- · Share the driving with fellow pas-
- Take regular rest stops every couple of hours and do some exercise.
- · When stopped, eat light meals or
- Drink plenty of water.
- If one feels tired during the trip, stopping to nap for 20 - 40 minutes is an effective way of reducing sleep-
