POLICE ASKING THE PUBLIC FOR HELP TO IDENTIFY SUSPECT IN SEXUAL ASSAULT

On December 31, 2015, at approx. 11:30 PM, a female was sexually assaulted by an unknown male near the railway tracks on Rollyview Road and 50 Street. Investigative avenues have been exhausted and the Leduc RCMP are releasing a composite sketch of the suspect.

The suspect is described as:

- A Caucasian male.
- 16 - 21 yrs. old, dark coloured long hair, parted from left to right.
- "Dots" on lower part of face which may have been slight acne scarring.

- Male also had a small scar on his upper left lip. This scar appeared to correspond with the crooked canine tooth, also in the upper left hand side.

- Brown eyes.

I enjoy being in the riding during the summer where I can reconnect with my constituents. After Parliament adjourned for the summer, I began my travels throughout the region.

In late June, I had the pleasure of attending the Alberta Beach Boat Launch Grand Opening, the re-dedication of the cenotaph at the Thorsby Legion, and the Village of Warburg's Heritage Day Parade.

My family and I celebrated Canada Day with many of our constituents in

our hometown of Edson at the beautiful Centennial Park. From the local talent and birthday cake to the fireworks, the celebrations of Canada's 149th birthday was an enjoyable family event.

I was pleased to be present, along with other dignitaries and members of the media, at the facility tour of the new \$200 million Edson Hospital. We were all very impressed with the spacious and bright rooms, and the special features in the operating and delivery rooms. A great new addition will also be a renal dialysis unit that will save many patients the lengthy drive to Edmonton for the medical service.

- Avoid all contact with blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) blooms. If contact occurs, wash with tap water as soon as possible.
 - Do not swim or wade (or allow your pets to swim or wade) in any areas where blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) is visible.
 - Do not feed whole fish or fish trimmings from this lake to your pets.
 - Consider limiting human consumption of whole fish and fish trimmings from this lake, as it is known that fish may store toxins in their liver. (People can safely consume fish fillets from this lake).
- As always, visitors and residents are

reminded to never drink or cook with untreated water directly from any lake, including Pigeon Lake, at any time. Boiling lake water will not remove the toxins produced by blue-green algae (cyanobacteria). An alternate source of drinking water should also be provided for pets and livestock, while this advisory is active.

Blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) is naturally occurring, and often become visible when weather conditions are calm. Appearing like scum, grass clippings, fuzz or globs on the surface of water, blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) can be blue-green, greenish-brown, brown, and/or pinkish-red, and often smell musty or grassy.

People who come in contact with visible blue-green algae (cyanobacte-

ria), or who ingest water containing blue-green algae (cyanobacteria), may experience skin irritation, rash, sore throat, sore red eyes, swollen lips, fever, nausea and vomiting and/or diarrhea. Symptoms usually appear within one to three hours and resolve in one to two days. Symptoms in children are often more pronounced; however, all humans are at risk of these symptoms.

Weather and wind conditions can cause algae blooms to move from one location in the lake to another. As such, this advisory will remain in effect for Pigeon Lake, until further notice.

Please note that areas of Pigeon Lake in which the blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) bloom is NOT visible can still be used for recreational

purposes, even while this Blue-green Algae (Cyanobacteria) Advisory is in place.

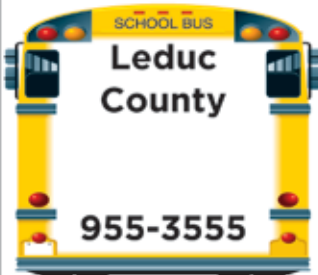

SAFETY FIRST!

BACK TO SCHOOL! SCHOOL BUS SAFETY
