RYAN KNYSH - TEAM CANADA ISA WORLD SUP AND PADDLEBOARD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Local Athlete Ryan Knysh has been selected to represent Team Canada at this year's World Sup Championships in Fiji. Ryan is from Alberta Beach, Alberta and has been competing in the sport just a short 4 years. He is a realtor in the Stony Plain area, as well as a certified SUP instructor and has a crowdfunding campaign set up to help with the costs to compete in this year's World Games.

The ISA World StandUp Paddle and Paddleboard Championship (WSUPPC) is an ISA World Championship that features four disciplines—SUP Surfing, SUP Racing Technical, SUP Racing Distance and Paddleboard Racing Technical and Distance. Within the SUP Racing and Paddleboard disciplines,

athletes will be competing in up to three (3) events including the Technical and Distance Races and the Paddle Relay. There will be one Gold Medal National Team.

Sanctioned by the International Surfing Association

Ryan is selected for the Surf Race Portion of the event and is the first Land-locked competitor to be chosen in this discipline. He spends time in the winter months training in Southern California with his team and racing in larger events. This marks the largest achievement in his paddle career and he is honoured to compete for his country.

Fresh off a win at the longest running SUP race this past weekend in Edmonton (The 9th annual Easy Rider Sup Cup) he has released a crowdfunding campaign to help with costs and expenses involved

with this year's Worlds. Ryan has teamed with Pursu.it to create a unique way to give back to the people that support him. A video was filmed in California and is featured on his page.

RENTAL FRAUD NETS 13 CHARGES

File: 2016 - 857302 - On June 28th, 2016, St. Albert RCMP received a complaint of a rental property fraud from two separate victims. The victims attended the St. Albert RCMP Detachment and reported that the each had a viewing of an apartment at 69-133 Eastgate Way in St. Albert, paid a \$1500.00 security deposit and signed a lease for July 1st, 2016. The victims were notified by the Shaw Fraud Department, (Shaw Communications) warning that multiple people had requested hook up services for 69-133 Eastgate Way to start on the

same date.

Through the process of the investigation, additional victims came forward to St. Albert RCMP reporting rental fraud at 69-133 Eastgate Way, describing very similar circumstances, at which time St. Albert General Investigation Section became involved.

St. Albert General Investigation Section conducted witness and victim interviews, subsequently leading to the arrest of Craig Archibald Ayers (Date of Birth: 1965/11/19) on August 4th, 2016. Ayers was charged with thirteen (13) counts of Fraud Under \$5000.00 in relation to 69-133 Eastgate Way. Ayers was later released on a Promise to Appear

for St. Albert Provincial Court on September 12th, 2016.

St. Albert Victim Services has been connected with all the people who were defrauded in this case and they will continue to provide them free services throughout the court process.

CONTAMINATED WATER ADVISORY ISSUED FOR SOUTH DOCK CAMPGROUND PUBLIC BEACH ON JACKFISH LAKE

JACKFISH LAKE – Due to elevated levels of fecal coliforms currently present in the water of Jackfish Lake at the South Dock Campground public beach (located within the North Zone of Alberta

Health Services (AHS)), AHS is advising the public not to swim or wade from the South Dock Campground public beach, effective immediately.

The public is also advised not to drink this contaminated lake water, as water-borne organisms, including fecal coliforms, can cause vomiting

and diarrhea.

Elevated levels of fecal coliforms were detected via testing of the lake water, at this beach location. At current levels, skin, ear and eye infections can result from any contact with the water at South Dock Campground public beach.

AHS Environmental Public Health officers will continue to monitor the water at South Dock Campground public beach.

Jackfish Lake is situated North East of Athabasca, within Athabasca County.

This advisory will remain in effect until further notice.

CLASS 3 DRIVERS WILL NEED MEDICAL DOCUMENTATION TO ENTER U.S.

Submitted by Adam Johnson, Public Affairs Officer, Alberta Transportation

The Government of Alberta does not have a similar requirement for Class 3 driver's licence holders. Drivers with Class 1, 2 and 4 licences already have medical exams on file and are not affected. Drivers with a standard Class 5 licence are not affected.

Starting this September 1, all commercial and professional drivers with a Class 3 Alberta driver's licence will be required to have a medical confirmation letter from the Government of Alberta to enter the United States. They will have to keep the letter within their vehicle while driving south of the border. Class 3 drivers who don't have a medical exam on record could be subject to a fine, a vehicle seizure or denial of entry into the U.S.

As this change is introduced, any enforcement and penalties will be at the discretion of U.S. officials. Effective April 1, 2017, drivers in this category who do not have a medical exam

on record will be subject to full enforcement penalties in the U.S.

Class 3 driver's licence holders wishing to meet U.S. requirements may provide a Medical Examination for Motor Vehicle Operators to the medical review section of Alberta Transportation, along with a note requesting a medical confirmation letter. This form is available at any physician's office or Alberta Registry.

Class 3 driver's licence holders seeking more information can

contact Alberta Transportation at 780-427-8230 (toll-free in Alberta at 310-0000), between 8:15 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday.

o Any motor vehicle that the holder of a Class 5 licence may drive

o A single motor vehicle with three or more axles

o A motor vehicle with three or more axles that is towing a trail-

er with one or more axles (if the trailer is not equipped with airbrakes)

o A Class 2- or 4-type vehicle without passengers (bus, taxi, ambulance)

o A Class 1, 2 or 6 vehicle as a learner

WHITECOURT TOWN COUNCIL UPDATE

Submitted by Tara Gallant

Recent allocation of funds from the federal government will allow the Town of Whitecourt to extend the River Erosion Control Project downstream to include land owned by the Town and the Whitecourt Golf & Country Club. Originally identified as an area in need of protection, the spur proposed near the golf course was not included in the original project due to budget limitations. Development of the spur will require additional engineering and

environmental approvals, which will delay work in the area until next year. Construction of spurs along the Athabasca River near the Millar Western Forest Products site east towards 47 Street continues. As previously advertised, access to the Athabasca River from Riverside Trail and 47th Street is closed temporarily to allow construction to proceed. For details on the project please visit our website at www.whitecourt.ca.

The Town of Whitecourt has awarded funds to Community Lunch Box and Timio's Liquor

for projects under the Vitalization Grant Program. The grant program assists property owners in the downtown core and along Highway 43 to upgrade the façade of their building to meet the architectural theme adopted in Whitecourt's Vitalization Plan.

Whitecourt Town Council has provided first reading to By-law 1521 which will allow the Town to borrow \$3 million for continued development of road and utility infrastructure in the Athabasca Flats East area. The project includes the construction

of McIlwaine Drive and the extension of Mink Creek Road in preparation for the opening of the new Living Waters Catholic School and future residential development. The expenditure will be recovered as land is further developed in the area.

Following a Public Hearing that was held in June, Council will not be amending the Downtown South Area Structure Plan to remove the requirement to provide utility service and build the road to a paved municipal standard on 47 Avenue, from 49 Street west to 51 Street.

Whitecourt Town Council has approved a request to extend the requirement to develop underground improvements in the west Whitecourt area, to serve the Midstream Silica lot adjacent to the Town's rail spur.

The Province recently announced another round of funding available through the GreenTRIP Program to allow for further capital projects as part of Whitecourt Transit. The Town of Whitecourt will be applying for \$620,500 through the program to purchase an additional bus, accessories, benches and shelters to provide future enhancements and efficiencies to the Whitecourt Transit service.

Whitecourt Town Council has approved a request from the Whitecourt Mountain Bike Association to advance the group \$30,000 so that work can begin on Phase 1 of the Mountain Bike Park. The funds will be paid back over 2 years. For more information on the Association visit www.bikewhitecourt.com.

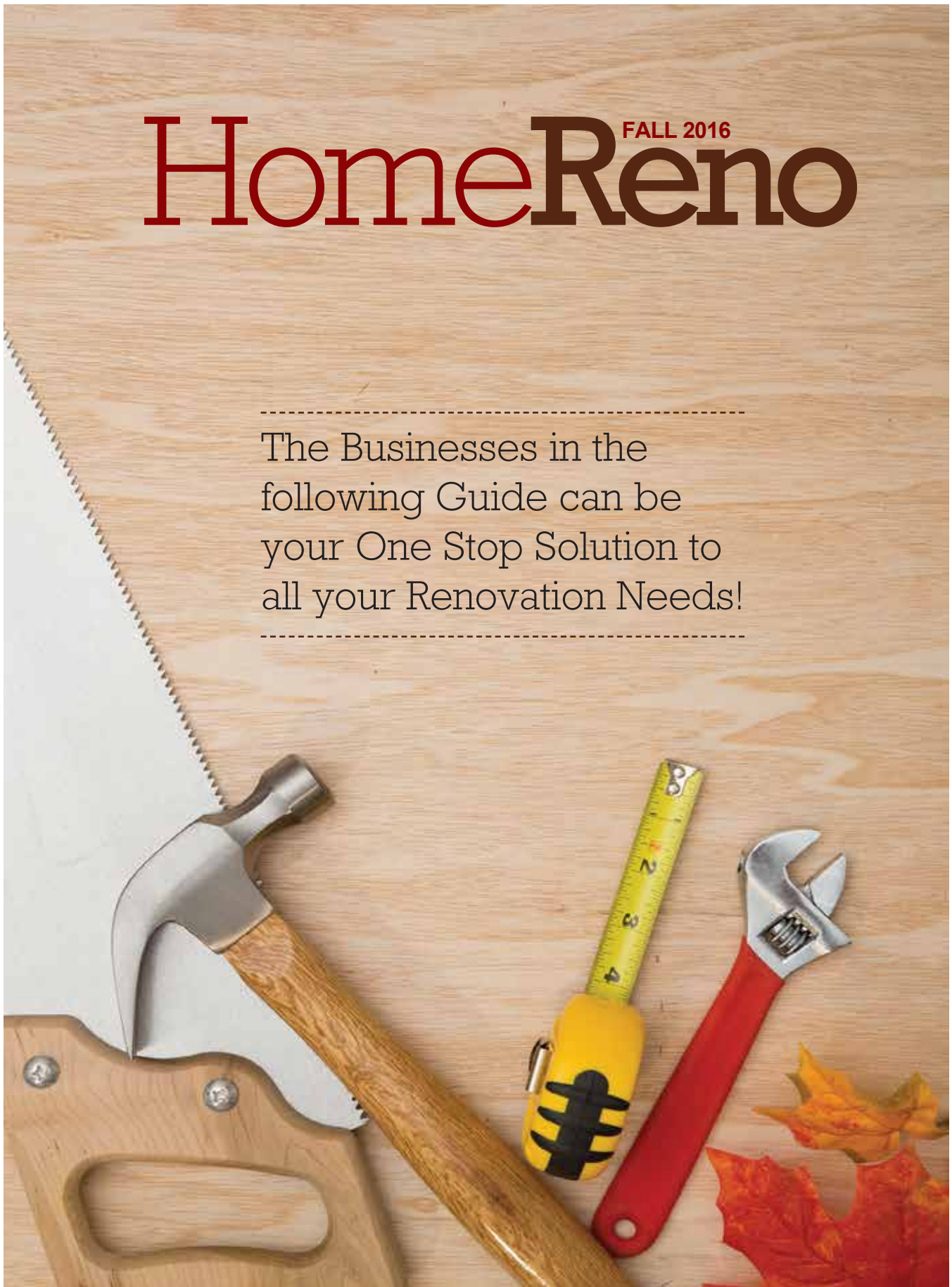

4 SIMPLE WAYS TO WINTERIZE YOUR HOME

If your project involves a coped cut, Woodcraft stocks Eclipse Coping Saws and Gröz Coping Saw Frames.

“Remember to protect your eyes,” product manager Jessica Douglas said. “Pick up a pair of SAS Safety Glasses before you begin your project. The lightweight glasses can be worn alone or over eyeglasses.”

For all the marking and measuring necessary to prepare the molding, you will find the multipurpose Kreg Multi-Mark Marking Gauge indispensable. To fill any small gaps, Woodcraft recommends Famowood Wood Filler, along with Norton 5X Small Area Sanding Sponges for smoothing filled holes.
