MADD PARKLAND CHAPTER KICKS OFF 2016 PROJECT RED RIBBON TO PROMOTE SOBER DRIVING THIS HOLIDAY SEASON

(Stony Plain, Alberta) – madd Parkland Chapters volunteers will be out in force over the coming weeks to distribute hundreds of red ribbons to Albertan’s as a reminder to drive sober during the upcoming holiday season.

madd Canada’s 29th annual Project Red Ribbon campaign normally

runs from November 1 to January 4, however madd Parkland has received National Board approval to hold-off from launching their Project Red Ribbon campaign until after November 11th, in respect of Remembrance Day. With plenty of parties and celebrations taking place over the holiday season, and with many people travelling to see family and friends, the risk of impaired driving increases.

The red ribbon is a symbol of the wearers’ commitment to sober driving, and a tribute to the thousands of Canadians who are killed and injured in impairment-related crashes each year.

For the second straight year, madd Parkland partnered with Parkland Funeral Services and local Tri-Municipal RCMP, Stony Plain & Parkland Enforcement and Fire Services, as well as AHS Emergency Services in displaying a strong presence of support for Project Red Ribbon. Spruce Grove Mayor, Stuart Huston, on behalf of Parkland Mayor, Rod Shaigec & Stony Plain Mayor, William Choy, provided a few words in recognition of all three municipalities providing on-going support for madd Parkland throughout the year and especially during the holiday season.

“We’re asking Albertan’s to join in and show their commitment to sober driving. Get a red ribbon, then tie it, wear it, show it, share it, and live it,” said madd Parkland Chapter President Brenda Johnson, who lost her son, Remy, in an impairment-related

crash in 2006.

Also in attendance was Title Sponsor, Allstate Insurance Company of Canada, who, along with many road safety professionals, enforcement & emergency service partners from around the area, support madd Parkland in urging Albertan’s to make this holiday season free from impaired driving crashes.

• Plan ahead when you know you’ll be over indulging. Take a cab or bus, arrange a designated driver or plan to stay over.

• Never drive impaired or ride with an impaired driver whether it be drugs or alcohol.

• If you see a driver you suspect is impaired, call 911 to report it to police. The call you make could save a life.

• madd Parkland Chapter again held their Red Ribbon Launch in conjunction with the National Day of Remembrance for Road Crash Victims. “This occasion is a reminder that we can and must do more to prevent traffic collisions from occurring.

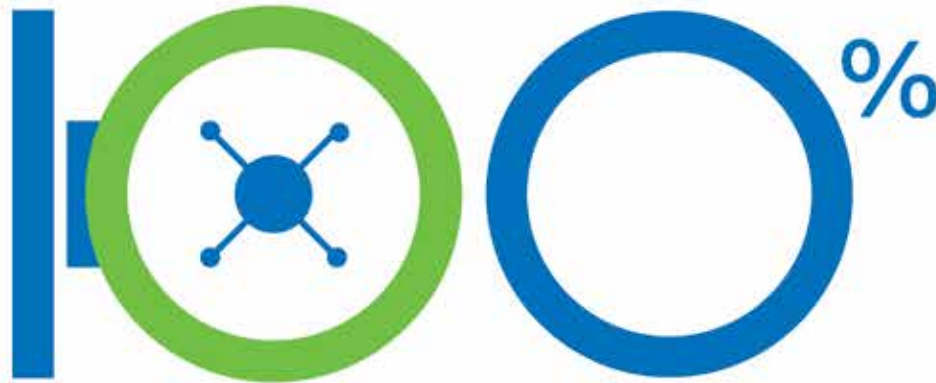

BLUE-GREEN ALGAE (CYANOBACTERIA) BLOOM ADVISORIES LIFTED

EDMONTON – Recent weather has cooled lake and reservoir water temperatures to such an extent that blue-green algae is no longer a health concern, including in eight bodies of water in Edmonton Zone, all of which had previous-

ly been placed under blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) bloom advisories.

Effective immediately, Alberta Health Services has lifted the blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) bloom advisories for:

- Half Moon Lake
- Hastings Lake
- Lake Isle

- Jackfish Lake
- Wizard Lake
- Pigeon Lake
- Hawrelak Park Lake
- Hasse Lake

As always, visitors and residents are reminded to never drink or cook with untreated water directly from any lake or reservoir, at any time.

PARLIAMENT UPDATE – WEEK OF NOV 14

This week in Parliament, we discussed the budget, the Canada Pension Plan, online access to violent sexual material, and controlled substances.

The following was debated in the House:

- Bill C-16 – An Act to amend the Canadian Human Rights Act and the Criminal Code
- Bill C-25 – An Act to amend the Canada Business Corporations Act, the Canada Cooperatives Act, the Canada Not-for-profit Corpora-

tions Act, and the Competition Act (Second Reading)

- Bill C-26 – An Act to amend the Canada Pension Plan, the Canada Pension Plan Investment Board Act and the Income Tax Act (Second Reading)
- Bill C-29 – Budget Implementation Act, 2016, No. 2 (Second Reading)
- Bill C-301 – An Act to amend the Income Tax Act and to make a related amendment to another Act (registered retirement income fund) (Second Reading)
- Bill C-307 – An Act to amend the Controlled Drugs and Sub-

stances Act (tamper resistance and abuse deterrence) (Second Reading)

- Bill C-309 – Gender Equality Week Act (Second Reading)
- Motion 47 – Instruction to the Standing Committee on Health (violent and sexual online material)
- Motion 64 – Italian Heritage Month

NOVEMBER IS DIABETES MONTH: HOW TO LOWER YOUR RISK

Submitted by Alberta Health Services

Diabetes is a large and growing health problem for Albertans. In 2015, the estimated number of Albertans living with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) is 288,000. November marks diabetes month and an opportunity to raise awareness of this disease and educate Albertans on what they can do to protect their health.

Did you know your lifestyle can raise or lower your risk for type 2 diabetes? Here are some healthy lifestyle habits to help lower your risk.

- Manage your weight: If you carry extra weight, reducing your weight by 5-10 per cent will lower your risk for type 2 diabetes by half. For example, a person who weighs 220 pounds (100 kg) should try to lose 11-22 pounds (5-10 kg). If you would like help with

weight loss, ask your doctor to refer you to a dietitian.

- Be active: Aim to be active for at least 30 minutes, 5-7 days each week. Try activities that make your heart beat faster like brisk walking, swimming, cross country skiing, sports, or running. You should breathe faster but still be able to talk.

- Follow Canada's Food Guide: Enjoy the suggested servings from each of the four

food group for your age and gender. To see the guide, visit www.healthcanada.gc.ca/food-guide. Eat three meals every day. Spreading your food over the day helps control your blood sugar. At each meal, choose three or four food groups and fill half your plate with vegetables and fruit. Include snacks if they help you eat smaller portions at your next meal. Other healthy eating strategies to help reduce risk include:

Eat more fibre: If your blood sugars are higher than normal, fibre helps manage them by slowing the movement of sugar from food into your blood. Read the Nutrition Facts table on food packages to find foods higher in fibre. Whole grain foods, vegetables and fruit, and cooked peas, beans, and lentils have fibre.

Eat small amounts of healthy fats: Things like olive and canola oils, avocado, nuts and fish have healthy fats. Cut down on saturated and trans fats found in animal products like cheese, butter, red meats and poultry skin.

Limit foods with added sugars: If your blood sugar is already higher than normal, sweet foods and added sugar in foods quickly raise blood sugar. Drink water instead of juice or sweet drinks with added sugar. Limit sugar, jam, honey, desserts, candy, syrups, and sweet sauces.

Take action to help prevent diabetes, talk to your doctor about your risk, and make healthy lifestyle changes one at a time

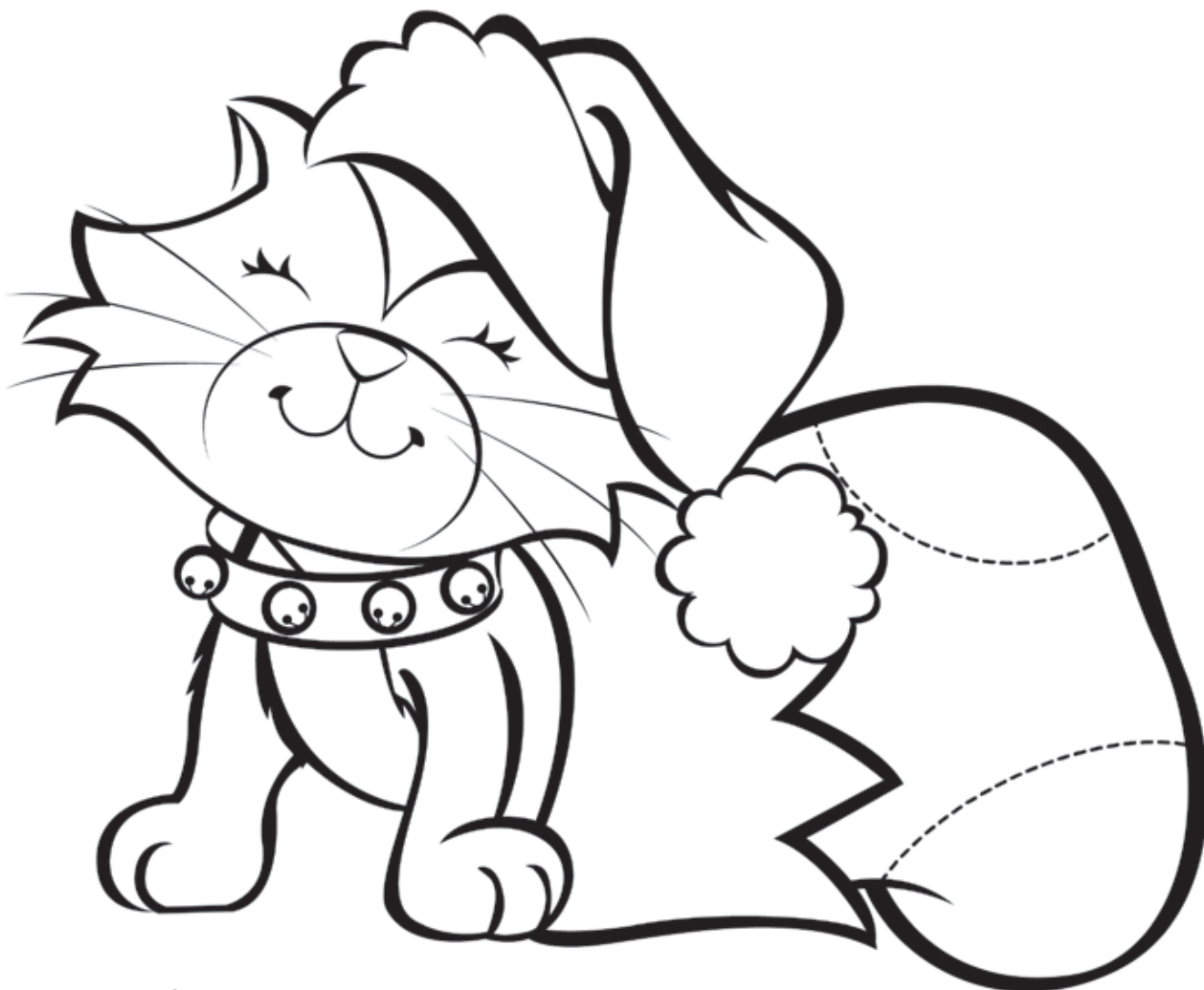
