# LEDUC COUNTY RESPONDS TO ANNEXATION DECISION

Leduc County, Alberta – The Government of Alberta, by way of an Order in Council dated Nov. 22, 2016, approved the Town of Beaumont’s annexation of 21-quarter sections of land.

“While this annexation has minimal growth and financial implications to Leduc County,

we are disappointed in the outcome,” says Mayor John Whaley. “We believe greater emphasis should have been placed on municipal collaboration and the principles of annexation.”

The annexation takes effect Jan. 1, 2017. The Order in Council provides a 50-year property tax protection period, which means properties will continue to be assessed and taxed at

either the town or county tax rate — whichever is lower. This will change if the property owner proceeds with subdivision or landowner-initiated redistricting.

# PARLIAMENT UPDATE

Week of November 21, 2016

This week in Parliament, we discussed trade, hate crimes, palliative care, and the boundaries of national parks.

The following was debated in the House:

- Bill C-18 – An Act to amend the Rouge National Urban Park Act, the Parks Canada Agency Act and the Canada National Parks Act (Second Reading)
- Bill C-25 – An Act to amend the Canada Business Corporations Act, the Canada Cooperatives Act, the Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act, and the Competition Act (Second Reading)
- Bill C-30 – Canada-European Union Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement Implementation Act (Second Reading)
- Bill C-274 – An Act to amend the Income Tax Act (transfer of small business or family farm or fishing corporation) (Second Reading)
- Bill C-277 – Framework on Palliative Care in Canada Act (Second Reading)
- Bill C-305 – An Act to amend the Criminal Code (mischief) (Second Reading)
- Motion No. 69 – Water quality
- Motion No. 73 – German Heritage Month

I had the opportunity to put forward a question during debate on Bill C-18 on November 24.

- Bill C-238 – National Strategy for Safe Disposal of Lamps Containing Mercury Act (Report Stage)
- Bill C-245 – Poverty Reduction Act (Second Reading)
- Bill S-211 – National Sickle Cell

Awareness Day Act (Second Reading)

- Bill S-217 – An Act to amend the Criminal Code (detention in custody) (Second Reading)
- Bill S-228 – An Act to amend the Fisheries Act (closed containment aquaculture) (Second Reading)
- Opposition Day Motion – Cuba
- Report of the Standing Committee on Justice and Human Rights in relation to proposed Bill C-242, An Act to amend the Criminal Code (inflicting torture).



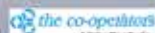
