And if your immediate community doesn't have what you're looking for, our directory will offer services in neighbouring communities, bridging the gap and bringing all three communities' essential services into one convenient point of contact.

### STONY PLAIN RCMP AND RCMP MAJOR CRIMES UNIT INVESTIGATE SUDDEN DEATH

Stony Plain, Alberta - On December 26th, 2016 Stony Plain RCMP and the Edmonton RCMP Major Crimes Unit responded to a complaint of found human remains on Sundance Road on the Paul Band First Nation. Police have identified the deceased as Christian Sidney Mark Grayhorseman of the Edmonton area.

Mr.Grayhorseman was also known as Sonny and SonShine.

Police are investigating this death as a homicide. Police interested in speaking to anyone who has information on Mr. Grayhorseman's activities and whereabouts in the days leading up to his death.

An autopsy is scheduled for Thursday December 29th, 2016.

### **CANADA SUMMER JOBS 2017**

OTTAWA: Jim Eglinski, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, is inviting local employers to apply for funding through Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ) 2017 to help create jobs for students next summer. Budget 2016 added \$113 million per year for three years to the existing CSJ base funding of \$107.5 million, doubling the number of students employed each year.

The Canada Summer Jobs initiative provides funding to notfor-profit, public-sector and small private-sector employers with 50 or fewer employees. It creates summer job opportunities for young people 15 to 30 years of age who are full-time students intending to return to their studies in the next school year.

"As in previous years, we are focusing on local priorities in the Yellowhead riding. This program will help provide experience and skillsets to students today so they can qualify for the relevant jobs in the future," said MP Eglinski.

The application period for Canada Summer Jobs 2017 will take place earlier this year, running from December 5, 2016 to January 20, 2017. This will ensure students may be hired beginning in April 2017. Eligible employees can apply online at: www.service-canada.gc.ca/csj or print off an application form from the website. Applications are available at any Service Canada Centre.

## LOOMING FISCAL CRISIS

Just over a year ago, Canada's economy was the envy of the world, as our Conservative government proudly balanced the federal budget. All that hard work was quickly undone by the new Liberal Prime Minister.

The Federal Finance department during the Christmas break released a new report stating we will now have annual budget deficits for the next quarter century, a predicted culminated federal debt of \$1 trillion in the next 15 years and we will likely see a tripling of current debt levels to \$1.5 trillion by 2050. If Prime Minister Justin Trudeau stays on course, Canada may not see another balanced budget until the year 2055. In fact, analysts are predicting bigger deficits could lead to the collapse of our economy.

This week we learned from the

Parliamentary Budget Office that the stimulus measures from infrastructure spending will likely be delayed. The government committed \$186 billion over 11 years in last fall's fiscal update. The economic impact of this is now projected for later 2017 and into 2018.

How can Justin Trudeau pull out of this self-inflicted economic tailspin? He can stop his reckless spending, or, raise taxes. Unfortunately we've already seen which choice he prefers.

Future generations will be on the hook and his spending is putting programs that provide financial security to those who are entering their golden years at risk.

Justin Trudeau's out-of-control spending and continuing tax hikes are sending Canada on a dangerous path. What happened to the Liberal promise to balance the budget before the next election?

### **SENIORS STAY** INDEPENDENT WITH NEW LOAN **PROGRAM**

More than 800 applications have been received since the program's launch on July 1, 2016, and the government has paid out more than \$5 million in loans and about \$230,000 in grants. Approximately 10 new applications arrive each day.

"Seniors built this province and they deserve to retire in dignity. Thanks to our government's SHARP program, Alberta seniors can receive the financial assistance they need to repair or adapt their homes, supporting them to age in the community." - Lori Sigurdson, Minister of Seniors and Housing

"It's really given us a new lease on life, so to speak. Instead of moving into a care facility, we can stav in our home-close to our family and friends, for as long as our health allows." - David and Jill Osborne, recipients of the home-equity loan

The Seniors Home Adaptation and Repair Act includes measures to protect consumers, including a provision to review the costs of repair projects to ensure they are fair.

**Quick facts** 

- The program provides low-interest home equity loans to a maximum of \$40,000 per household to seniors with a household income of \$75,000 or less. Homeowners must have at least 25 per cent home equity.
- · Low-income seniors who do not qualify under the loan program may be eligible for a grant to help pay for essential home repairs.






