# YELLOWHEAD COUNTY COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

January 24, 2017

Strategic Priorities – Council received an update on some of the operational initiatives being undertaken by staff based on the Yellowhead County 2017 Strategic Priorities Report. The report is created annually by Council to prioritize projects and other issues for Yellowhead County for the upcoming year.

Dust Control Fees – Council will keep the rates of the dust control

program fees at \$200/application. Residents can sign up for two dust control applications per year – one application in the spring and the other in the fall.

Donahoo School Historic Designation – Council approved an application submitted by the Donahoo Community Association for a Municipal Historic Resource Designation on the Donahoo School near Wildwood. The designation is part of the Yellowhead County Municipal Heritage Management Plan that identifies, protects and helps

conserve historic places throughout the region.

Airport Lease Renewal – Council approved a five-year lease to Rotaiva Aircraft Services Ltd. at the County’s Jasper/ Hinton Airport for \$400 per year. Rotaiva provides fueling services at the airport for local and transitory aircraft.

Property Purchase – Yellowhead County has agreed to purchase a 17 acre parcel (Plan 6692NY, Lot H) for \$8.5 million. The parcel, located adjacent to the County facility in Edson, is a serviced land base and

includes over 50,000 sq. feet of office and shop space. The acquisition will position the County favourably for its long-term future growth and potential partnerships that will be required via inter-municipal Collaboration Framework Agreements which are new provisions under the Municipal Government Act.

The next Council Meetings are February 14 & 28, 2017. The next Committee of the Whole Council Meeting is February 21, 2017. All meetings start at 9:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers.

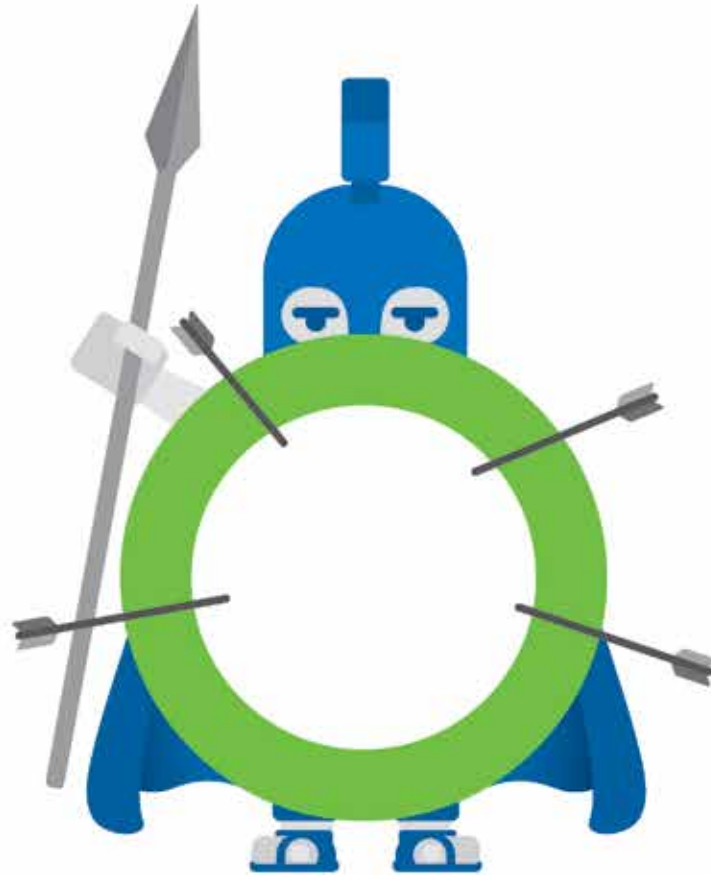

# CRIME SPREE NEAR BRETON

On January 28th, 2017 at 1:30 A.M. the area of Breton was subject to numerous break and enter and thefts along highway 20 and highway 616 near Range Road 50.

A group of individuals who were occupants in a dark green 1999 Jeep Cherokee, which was stolen out of Spruce Grove on January 27th, 2017 at 7:10 A.M., made stops at two different property only few miles south of Breton on highway 20 where they stole diverse items and attempted to steal jerry cans of fuel.

The perpetrators were seen by one of the property owners where

they broke into a garage in an attempt to steal fuel. After being caught in the garage, they fled north bound on highway 20 before turning westbound onto highway 616 and stopping at a property near Range Road 50.

The perpetrators were again chased from the property by the owner, who fired a shot at the vehicle's tire. The perpetrators were attempting to steal fuel and while attempting to flee from the property almost ran over the property owner.

The vehicle was later located in the alley north of 53 Avenue in

Breton.

Search of the vehicle revealed that the vehicle had initially left Spruce Grove after being stolen and had headed to Onoway's Shell gas station located at 4921 49 Street.

It was also found that on the same day, at approximately 6:23 P.M., the vehicle had travelled to Calgary where it had stopped at the Canadian Tire located at 596 64 Avenue NE.


