BLUE-GREEN ALGAE BLOOM ADVISORY ISSUED FOR LESSARD LAKE & LAC LA NONNE

ONOWAY & LAC STE. ANNE COUNTY – A blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) bloom has been identified in areas of Lessard Lake and Lac La Nonne. Residents living near the shores of this lake, as well as visitors to this lake, are advised to take the

following precautions:

- Avoid all contact with blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) blooms. If contact occurs, wash with tap water as soon as possible.
- Do not swim or wade (or allow your pets to swim or wade) in any areas where blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) is visible.
- Do not feed whole fish or fish

trimmings from this lake to your pets.

- Consider limiting human consumption of whole fish and fish trimmings from this lake, as it is known that fish may store toxins in their liver. (People can safely consume fish fillets from this lake).

PRECAUTIONARY AIR QUALITY ADVISORY ISSUED FOR EDMONTON ZONE OF ALBERTA HEALTH SERVICES

Due to wildfires burning in British Columbia, air quality is expected to be variable across much of the Edmonton Zone of Alberta Health Services (AHS) over the coming days and potentially, weeks.

As such, AHS is issuing a precautionary air quality advisory for the entire Edmonton Zone of AHS.

Residents of the Edmonton Zone of AHS, and visitors to the Edmonton Zone of AHS, are advised to be aware of air conditions and take precautions against potential health concerns that can be associated with smoky air conditions.

Although minor smoke conditions do not typically cause health concerns in healthy individuals, if smoke conditions become more severe, even healthy individuals may experience temporary irritation of eyes and throat, and possibly short-

ness of breath.

If you can taste and/or smell smoke in the air:

- Monitor your symptoms.
- Minimize physical activity outdoors.
- Remain indoors with windows, doors and air circulation fans/vents closed.
- If you drive to another location, keep windows and vents closed. Run your car fan on re-circulate mode to avoid drawing in outdoor air.

Individuals with respiratory conditions (such as COPD and asthma), and individuals with existing cardiovascular conditions (such as angina, previous heart attack and congestive heart failure), may notice a worsening of symptoms in smoky air conditions. These individuals should monitor for worsening of symptoms and take the precautions routinely recommended by their physicians if a worsening of symptoms occurs.

Individuals experiencing symp-

toms can also call Health Link 24 hours a day, seven days a week, toll-free at 811, to speak to a registered nurse.

Air quality can and will vary with weather conditions and prevailing winds. Because air quality is expected to be variable, this advisory will remain in effect until further notice.

Information about the air quality in many areas of Alberta is updated hourly on the Alberta Environment Air Quality Website: <http://airquality.alberta.ca>. Air quality information is also available by phone, toll-free, at 1-877-247-7333.

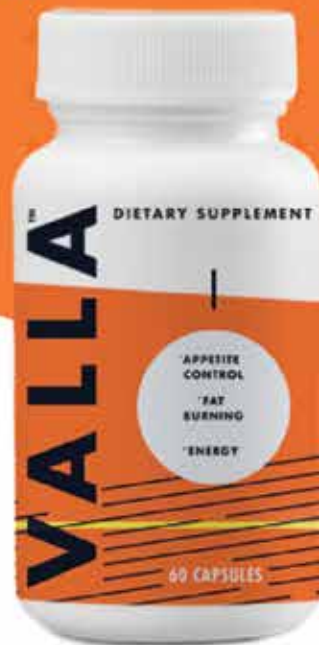

Blue-Green Algae Bloom Advisory Issued For Lessard Lake & Lac La Nonne

As always, visitors and residents are reminded to never drink or cook with untreated water directly from any recreational body of water, including Lessard Lake, at any time. Boiling of this water will not remove the toxins produced by blue-green algae (cyanobacteria). An alternate source of drinking water should also be provided for pets and livestock, while this advisory is active.

Blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) is naturally occurring, and often become visible when weather conditions are calm. Appearing like scum, grass clippings, fuzz or globs on the surface of water, blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) can be blue-green, greenish-brown, brown, and/or pinkish-red, and often smell musty or grassy.

People who come in contact with visible blue-green algae (cyanobacteria), or who ingest water containing blue-green algae (cyanobacteria), may experience skin irritation, rash, sore throat, sore red eyes, swollen lips, fever, nausea and vomiting and/or diarrhea. Symptoms usually appear within one to three hours and resolve in one to two days. Symptoms in children are often more pronounced; however, all humans are at risk of these symptoms.

Weather and wind conditions can cause algae blooms to move from one location in the lake to another. As such, this advisory will remain in effect for Lessard Lake, until further notice.

Please note that areas of Lessard Lake in which the blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) bloom is NOT visible can still be used for recreational purposes, even while this Blue-green

Algae (Cyanobacteria) Advisory is in place.

GOLFER'S GUIDE

HELP KIDS LEARN THE GAME OF GOLF

Adults who play golf know just how fun and frustrating the game can be. Whether you're a veteran golfer or someone just learning the links, golf can be challenging.

But as exacting as the game can be, it also can be just as rewarding, even for kids. Children who embrace the game of golf will learn a host of lessons they can apply in all facets of life. A humbling game even for professional golfers, golf can teach kids lessons in humility and the value of persistence even when things aren't going your way.

Golf is also a great way for parents to get kids off the couch and outdoors for some fun in the

sun. Instead of spending summer afternoons in front of the television, kids who play golf are out patrolling pristine golf courses while getting some cardiovascular exercise along the way. Golf can also strengthen a child's hand-eye coordination, which can help them in other activities, including many different sports.

Though many people do not begin playing golf until they've reached adulthood, it's never too early for boys and girls to start learning the game of golf. Parents of preschoolers can start their kids off with a toddler play set. Though it's just a toy, a play set can help lay a solid foundation for future

golfers. Kids who have watched Mom and Dad play golf or practice their swing can develop their own swings on their play set.

As kids approach school age, don't overlook the nearby putt-putt or miniature golf range as a valuable teaching tool. Miniature golf clubs are small enough for many children to use comfortably, and kids can use miniature golf courses as a place to put any lessons or advice on putting to good use. What's more, a miniature golf course is more than just golf, with creative courses and other fun activities, so kids won't feel overwhelmed with golf.

When kids move on from pre-

school to elementary school, some might want to tag along with Mom or Dad to the driving range. You should try to avoid overwhelming kids with too much instruction or information. Instead, keep things as simple as possible, teaching them the basic swing and encouraging them no matter how quickly they adapt.

As kids enter middle school and approach high school, those who are enjoying the game of golf can take advantage of the driving range if they haven't already begun to. A driving range typically has markers that indicate the distance of a regular hole, regardless of which tee you will play from on an actual golf course. Kids can aim for holes at shorter distances to learn how far their drives are going. You can then adjust the lessons you teach your children based on how far youngsters can drive the ball.

As a child gets closer to high school, you might want to buy the child his or her own set of clubs. Look for inexpensive clubs (oftentimes, thrift stores or other secondhand retailers have clubs for sale) because growing children will eventually grow out of their first set of clubs. When your child finds a set of clubs that suits him or her, teach the proper way to swing and consider signing up your son or daughter for lessons. Those first few lessons can prove invaluable, turning a pastime into a passion kids will carry with them throughout their lives.



GOLFER'S GUIDE

FIVE TOP GOLF TIPS TO HELP BOOST YOUR GAME

(NC) When it comes to golf, it's the little things that can have the biggest impact on your game. Whether it's your first attempt, or 10th season, golf expert Bob Weeks has got you covered at the links this summer with these five tips:

Choose the right clubs: Regardless of your experience or skill level, choosing the right equipment can be the difference between duffing it and striking the ball straight down the fairway. It's important to work with a professional to get the clubs best-suited to your game and then, to have them custom fit. You should be fit for the length, loft, lie angle, shaft flex and even the grip size. If your clubs aren't custom fit, it will be like

walking around in shoes that are the wrong size.

Get on the ball: Choose the right kind of golf ball for your game. While golf balls all look the same, it's what's inside that determines if it's right for you. Golf balls fall into two categories: distance or control. Distance balls are generally two-piece balls with a large core and a cover. They are harder and better suited for higher handicappers or beginners. Control balls, usually three- or four-piece balls, are softer and spin more meaning they will land on the green and stop. More skillful players should use these.

Consider the elements: Weather is always a factor in golf and dealing with it must always be

considered. For instance, in cold temperatures, the ball will travel shorter distances, so take more club. The opposite is true for warmer temperatures. If you're playing into the wind, swing easy as that will keep the ball from spinning too much and rising up into the breezes. And downwind, make sure to judge the intensity of the breezes so you can choose the proper club. Your ball will roll further than normal on a downwind shot so take that into account.

Putting and chipping is priority: Lots of players like to boom their drives and will spend a lot of time on the range hitting their drivers. But if you want to improve your scores, you should spend more time working on

your putting and chipping. Since most average players miss a lot of greens, the best way to save strokes is by chipping it close and making more putts. Focus more on your short game than your drive and you will improve.

Play the 19th hole: Win or lose, there's no better way to celebrate than hitting the 19th hole. Less is often more in golf and the same applies when considering what to eat and drink after a round. Molson Canadian 67 for example is specially brewed with 67 calories and an ABV of 3% per 341ml, offering a light, refreshing alternative for active players.

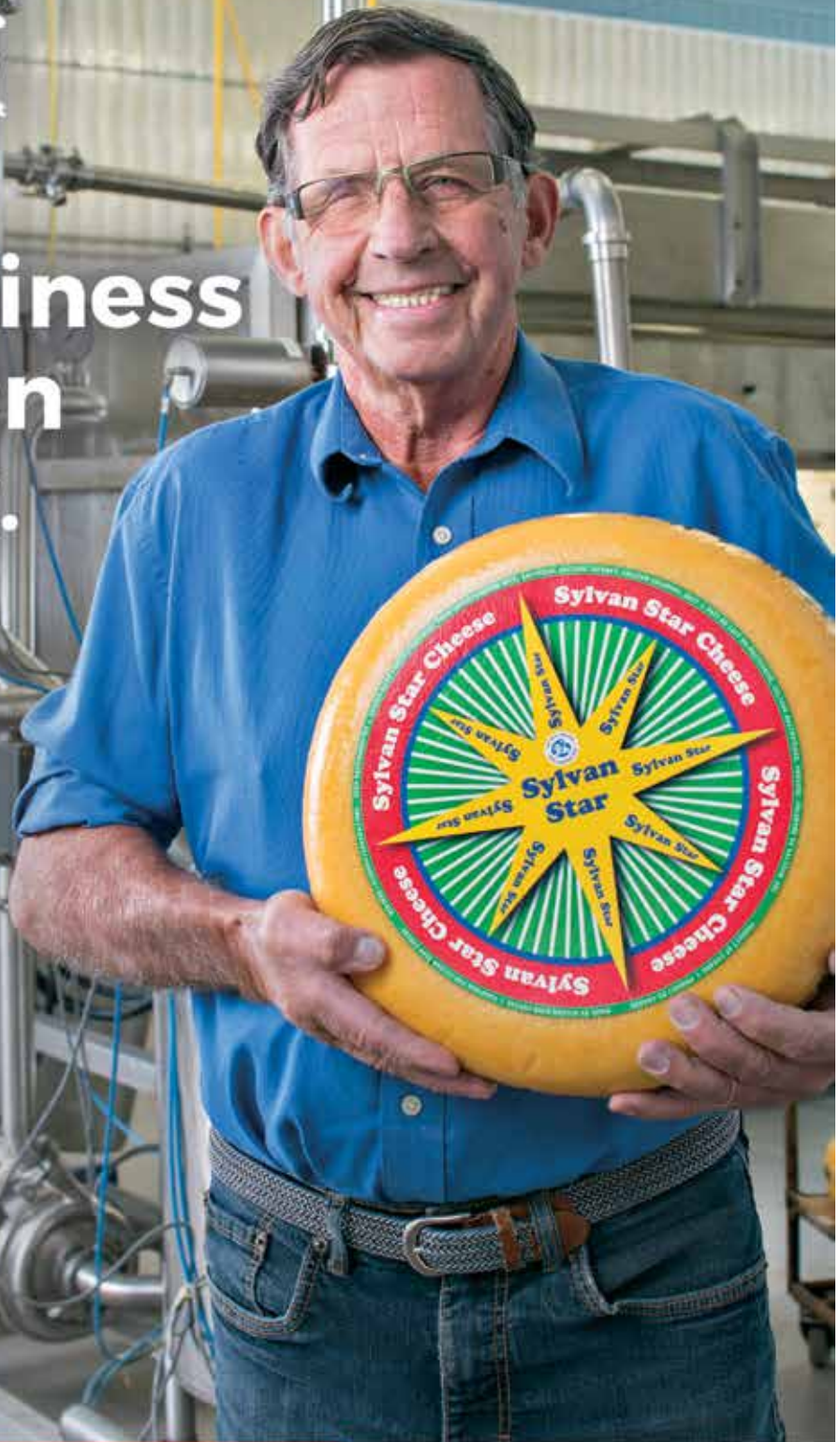

I am pleased to be home with my constituents where I will be spending my time in communities across this beautiful riding of Yellowhead. Returning home allows me the opportunity to meet face-to-face with you, attend events, catch up on phone calls, and answer correspondence. Meetings, events, phone calls and responding to your letters will help me represent you better when Parliament resumes in September.

The spring parliamentary session concluded on June 21, 2017. Below is a summary of hot topics:

1. Interesting how the federal government can quickly produce \$10.5 million to pay Omar Khadr, who fought against Canada, but can't seem to provide enough funding in the Veterans Affairs budget to make sure our elderly veterans are properly cared for. Mr. Trudeau was wrong to compensate Omar Khadr, and wrong to do it in a secret deal.

2. Métis commissioner, Marilyn Poitras stepped down from the five-member commission, citing issues with the "current structure" of the inquiry into Murdered and Missing Indigenous Women and Girls.

3. Prime Minister Trudeau promised to borrow only \$10 billion, and balance the budget by 2019. The Finance Department's report shows a different story. It says the deficit won't be eliminated for at least 35 years! His borrowing and spending is out of control. So much for a 'modest deficit'.

4. Thanks to this Liberal government, we won't have a softwood lumber deal anytime soon. This is one of the main industries in our riding of which I have repeatedly brought to the Government's attention.

MURDER CHARGE LAID IN DEATH OF RONALD WORSFOLD

St. Albert, Alberta - An autopsy has been completed and murder charges laid in relation to the death of 75-year-old St. Albert resident Ronald Worsfold.

On July 8, the family of Ronald Worsfold reported that he was missing from his St. Albert residence

and had not been in contact with his family since the evening of July 7th. A missing persons investigation was launched and the following day, July 9, investigators located a body which was believed to be Mr. Worsfold, in a rural area of Parkland County near Stony Plain.

An autopsy was completed on July 11, 2017 by the Chief Medical Examiners office in Edmonton. The autopsy confirmed the body found

near Stony Plain was Ronald Worsfold and that the manner of his death was homicide.

The RCMP Major Crimes Unit has charged 28-year-old Beryl Musila from St. Albert with first degree murder and indignity to human remains in relation to the death of Mr. Worsfold. She is scheduled to appear in Sherwood Park Provincial Court on July 12, 2017.

Investigators can now confirm that

the theft of Mr. Worsfold's Toyota Corolla five days before his disappearance was not connected with his death or disappearance.

The RCMP thanks the public for their efforts and support in bringing this investigation to a quick conclusion and offers sincere condolences to Ronald's family and friends.

No further information will be released as this investigation is now before the courts.

WHITECOURT RCMP SEIZE DRUGS, WEAPONS, AND CASH DURING EXECUTION OF SEARCH WARRANT

Whitecourt, Alberta – Two males and one female were arrested after Whitecourt RCMP executed a search warrant in a Whitecourt neighbourhood on July 8, 2017. A large amount of Canadian Currency, 191g of marijuana (shatter), 93g of crack cocaine, 18g of fentanyl, 26g

of Crystal Methamphetamine and a variety of other drugs were seized by investigators.

Whitecourt RCMP with assistance from the RCMP Police Dog Service and the Whitecourt Integrated Traffic Unit executed the search warrant at a residence on Baly Road, where they also located a stolen, loaded firearm and a stolen motorcycle. Two men and a woman were arrest-

ed at the residence without incident and are now facing Criminal Code charges in relation to the search warrant.

Sasha Stimson, age 26 of Whitecourt, Derek Primeau, age 22 of Whitecourt, and Kyle Macmilan age 19 of Whitecourt are currently in custody and will make their first appearances at Whitecourt Provincial Court on July 11, 2017.


