Jim Eglinski, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, is pleased to advise that the call for proposals for new Union Training and Innovation Program launched today.

Successful applicants will receive financial support to purchase up-to-date training equipment and materials so workers can get the skills they need on the job site. Successful applicants will also receive funding to support approaches that

will break down barriers facing women and Indigenous people who want to enter the skilled trades.

The program will include two streams of funding:

- Financial support for unions to purchase up-to-date training equipment and materials to help unions keep up with constant technological change and meet industry standards
- Funding for innovative approaches to break down barriers facing women and Indigenous people who want to enter the skilled trades.

“This will help apprentices and tradespeople in my Yellowhead riding to obtain the skills they need to pursue a career in a skilled trade. I encourage eligible organizations to apply for funding to support apprentices in completing their training,” concluded MP Eglinski.

FIRST INSTALLMENT OF FEDERAL GAS TAX DELIVERED TO PROVINCE

Jim Eglinski, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, is pleased to advise that the Federal Government has delivered the first of two annual \$109.5 million federal Gas Tax Fund (GTF) installments to Alberta.

In total, the province will be provided with over \$219 million this year through the fund. The Federal Government has announced that the funding, which flows through the provincial government to all of its municipi-

palities, is now available to support community infrastructure projects.

“Community infrastructure helps to connect people to jobs and it provides access to better community services, attracts new businesses and creates economic growth,” stated MP Eglinski.

GTF funding is allocated to municipalities on a per capita basis. Municipalities can pool, bank and borrow against this funding, providing significant financial flexibility. Unspent capital funds may be carried forward

a total of five years.

Based on previous years, GTF funding supports approximately 250 local infrastructure projects across Alberta each year. The allocations in the riding of Yellowhead are as follows:



While in Ottawa for the first week of July, I met with nine constituents who were visiting the capital. Also that week, I participated in events at Parliament Hill and the United States Embassy. I was back in the riding at the end of the week to attend Edson's Great Canadian BBQ in the Park, as well as plant a commemorative tree at the George Pegg Historical Garden in Glenvis.

For the week of July 10, I spent time in my Edson office meeting with constituents regarding various issues such as veterans and softwood lumber. I also participated in the Edson Summer Festival, handing out flags and conversing with local residents.

The following week, I attended Edson's Rotary Club meeting and later participated in a conference call. Midweek, I made a trip up to Grande Cache to attend several meetings regarding local issues and later attended the Town Council meeting. On the weekend, I visited Bench Creek Brewery in Edson before going

to the "Got Your Six" shooting competition, which was a local fundraiser to raise awareness of PTSD.

For the last week of July, I met with constituents in my Edson office. I also met with a local radio station and recorded two messages. On the Thursday, I participated in TransAlta's tour of their Brazeau Hydro Plant and coal facilities in Wabamun.

August promises to be another good month where I can meet up with many of my constituents before heading back to Ottawa in September.

GOLFER'S GUIDE

HELP KIDS LEARN THE GAME OF GOLF

Adults who play golf know just how fun and frustrating the game can be. Whether you're a veteran golfer or someone just learning the links, golf can be challenging.

But as exacting as the game can be, it also can be just as rewarding, even for kids. Children who embrace the game of golf will learn a host of lessons they can apply in all facets of life. A humbling game even for professional golfers, golf can teach kids lessons in humility and the value of persistence even when things aren't going your way.

Golf is also a great way for

parents to get kids off the couch and outdoors for some fun in the sun. Instead of spending summer afternoons in front of the television, kids who play golf are out patrolling pristine golf courses while getting some cardiovascular exercise along the way. The Chauffeur – likes driving the cart more than swinging the club and is happy to drop you off at every hole.






