PARLIAMENT UPDATE

Week of December 4, 2017

This week was busy in the House of Commons as we prepare for the winter break. We covered topics including ISIS fighters, indigenous rights and education, the salaries of Ministers, and access to information.

The House of Commons debated the following:

- Bill C-24 – An Act to amend

the Salaries Act and to make a consequential amendment to the Financial Administration Act (Report Stage)

- Bill C-58 – An Act to amend the Access to Information Act and the Privacy Act and to make consequential amendments to other Acts (Third Reading)

- Bill C-61 – Anishinabek Nation Education Agreement Act (Third Reading)

- Bill C-66 – Expungement of Historically Unjust Convictions Act (Second Reading)

- Bill S-236 – Recognition of Charlottetown as the Birthplace of Confederation Act (Report Stage)

- CPC Motion – ISIS Fighters Returning to Canada

- Bill C-262 – United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples Act (Second Reading)

- Bill C-352 – An Act to amend the Canada Shipping Act, 2001 and to provide for the development of a national strategy (abandonment of vessels) (Second Reading/deemed non-votable)

- Bill C-364 – An Act to amend the Canada Elections Act and to make a consequential amendment to another Act (political financing) (Second Reading)

- Bill C-375 – An Act to amend the Criminal Code (presentence report) (Second Reading)

- Bill C-377 – An Act to change the name of the electoral district of Châteauguay—Lacolle (Second Reading)

I participated in debate on the Conservative Motion (ISIS Fighters Returning to Canada)

by asking a question. You can find all questions, comments and speeches from debates on the corresponding day's Hansard on the House Publications page at www.ourcommons.ca/en.

In the Standing Committee on Industry, Science and Technology (INDU), we began the consideration of a draft report on Canada's Anti-Spam Laws (CASL). We also heard from the newly appointed Chief Science Advisor and had the opportunity to ask her questions on how she will advise the government on matters related to science. This week, I attended seven meetings, three events, and recorded two messages. I will be attending functions in Ottawa over the week-end. Look for my update next Friday on the happenings of Parliament as the House will continue to sit for one final week before the winter break.

YELLOWHEAD COUNTY COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

November 28, 2017

Public Hearing Bylaw 14.17 – A Public Hearing was held for Bylaw 14.17 that would rezone a property south of Chip Lake from Rural District to Country Residential Limited District. The subdivision would create a third parcel from the quarter section. No concerns were brought

forward by the public.

CFWY Presentation – Community Futures West Yellowhead (CFWY) Manager General Manager, Nancy Robbins, gave Council an overall of CFWY. CFWY is jointly operated by Yellowhead County, along with four other regional municipalities with an aim to assist existing local small businesses and start-ups through business coaching, business training, business development, and business financing with a current focus on

Inclusiveness and Cluster Development.

YC Library Board Presentation – Director of Library Services for the Yellowhead County Library Boards, Robert McClure, presented the services and philosophies offered by the board. He explained that traditional services such as books and summer reading programs are offered, but emphasized that residents also have access to the internet, computers, and other electronic services with an em-

phasis on digital literacy. These offerings are designed to bring an improved quality of life to community members.

Weed Control Resolution – Council is supporting a resolution that asks that the province meet their mandated obligations for weed control on publicly owned vacant provincial land. The resolution will be brought forward at the North West Association of Alberta Agricultural Fieldmen (AAAF) Regional Conference, and if passed, will be lobbied to the province by the AAAF organization on behalf of the supporting communities.

Road Plan Closure – A small section of a road plan northeast of Shiningbank Lake used for road drainage is being closed as it does not meet the requirements for the current road infrastructure. A new road plan better suited to the requirements will be implemented. These changes will not affect travel on the adjacent TWP RD 570.

Sun Gro Access Road – Council approved a temporary extension to Sun Gro Horticulture Ltd. for the completion of the road construction to RR 85, with a new deadline of June 22, 2018.

Lease Renewal – Yellowhead County renewed a lease agreement with Eugene and Wanda Miluch to continue the crop production on the property at a rate of \$950 per year over a five-year term.

SDAB Appointments – Darrell Talpash and Bob Gliddon were appointed to the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board (SDAB) with a four-year term expiring October 31, 2021. The board hears appeals from decisions made by the County's Development Authority and Subdivision Authority. The board consists of 6 community members and three County Councillors.

The next scheduled Council Meetings is December 12, 2017. The next scheduled Governance & Priorities Meeting is December 19, 2017. All meetings start at 9:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers.
