POLICE VEHICLE RAMMED

Stony Plain, Alberta – On January 1, 2018 the RCMP arrested one adult female who rammed a police vehicle, then engaged the RCMP in a pursuit.

At 2:45 a.m., an RCMP member in a fully marked police truck was transporting a prisoner from the Paul Band First Nations to the Stony Plain RCMP Detachment. Near Highway 16 at Range Road 35, a vehicle purposefully rammed the police truck. The suspect made continued attempts

to ram the police truck which caused the RCMP member to take evasive driving action.

Additional RCMP members responded to assist and located the suspect vehicle. A pursuit was initiated which eventually ended when the suspect vehicle stopped and one female was safely arrested and taken into custody without further incident.

It was later determined that the vehicle had been stolen.

28-year-old Renee House is now facing nine criminal code charges as a result of this incident. Charges include Assault police officer with a weapon, dangerous operation of a motor vehicle, operation of a motor vehicle while being pursued by police, failing to comply with a condition of an undertaking, and others.

House was remanded in police custody and is scheduled to appear in Provincial Court on January 24, 2018.

The RCMP can confirm that the accused and the prisoner in the police vehicle were associated.

Further information will not be provided on this incident; the charges are before the courts.

STEP 2018 HELPS EMPLOYERS HIRE STUDENTS

Alberta students will get a leg up in their careers through the Summer Temporary Employment Program (STEP).

The province's economy is improving and the government wants to make sure all Albertans benefit from the recovery, including students and employers. STEP gives students the opportunity to develop important skills while helping employers hire the staff they need.

Applications are now being accepted for STEP from employers who want to hire students for summer work between May and August. Eligible employers will

get a \$7-per-hour wage subsidy.

"STEP has been a valuable program for students interested in gaining unique, first-hand work experience, and it helps employers hire knowledgeable, enthusiastic summer staff. As our economy is looking up, we want to continue helping students and employers alike. I encourage employers to apply and support our future generation of bright Albertans." - Christina Gray, Minister of Labour

Last summer, STEP helped about 3,000 students connect to valuable work experience with almost 1,400 employers across the province in a wide range of fields such as tourism, research, information technology, marketing and customer service.

More than 5,700 students have gained jobs through STEP since the program was restored in 2015 after being cut in March 2013 by the previous government.

STEP is available to small businesses, non-profit organizations, public libraries, school boards, publicly funded post-secondary institutions, municipalities, First Nations and Métis settlements.

STEP 2018 has a budget of \$10 million. Employers interested in hiring a student for 2018 are encouraged to apply as soon as possible. Albertans can learn more about the program and the application process at Alberta-Canada.com/STEP.

Application forms are available online and must be submitted before the Feb. 9, 2018 deadline.

Membership is just \$70 per session, with a discount for multiple family members.



safe, and are equipped with a 360 degree double rim closure providing fly and odor control. The Earth Machine Backyard Composter has an 80 gal capacity, a twist locking pest-resistant lid, and comes with an aeration rod. Extra aeration rods are also available for \$15.00 each.



LAC STE. ANNE RECEIVES FEDERAL INFRASTRUCTURE FUNDING

OTTAWA: Jim Eglinski, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, is pleased to inform residents of funding for Lac Ste. Anne County through Infrastructure Canada's Municipal Asset Management Program (MAMP).

The MAMP helps Canadian municipalities make informed decisions on infrastructure investment based on sound asset management practices.

Lac Ste. Anne County, which partially resides in the north of MP Eglinski's riding of Yellowhead, will receive \$50,000 for the Lac Ste. Anne County Asset Management Program.

"It is always great to see local municipalities successful in their applications for essential infrastructure funding from the federal government. This funding investment will help inform Lac Ste. Anne County when making infrastructure investment decisions," stated MP Eglinski.

The funding is part of a government announcement for funding to 72 initiatives in communities across Canada through three programs: the Municipalities for Climate Innovation Program (MCIP), the Green Municipal Fund (GMF), and the MAMP.

Innovation Program is a five-year, \$75-million program designed to encourage Canadian municipalities to better prepare for and adapt to the new realities of climate change as well as reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

The Green Municipal Fund is a \$550-million program designed to support initiatives that demonstrate innovative solutions or approaches to a municipal environmental issue, and can generate new lessons and models for municipalities of all sizes and types in all regions of Canada.

"I encourage local municipalities to apply to all funding opportunities available to them. This guarantees they have access to every resource possible for their communities," concluded MP Eglinski.






