ATTEMPTED MURDER CHARGES

County of Barrhead, Alberta – The Barrhead RCMP have made an arrest and laid an attempted murder charge following a serious incident which occurred on November 28 in the early morning.

At 7:42 a.m., RCMP respond-

ed to a complaint of a pickup truck on fire at the Tiger Lily Dump. The male driver of the truck was on scene and was fortunately uninjured. Investigation revealed that he was allegedly assaulted and gas was poured on both his truck and his person before the truck was lit on fire.

The RCMP Major Crimes Unit, the Interview Assistance

Team and Forensic Identification Section all provided assistance in the investigation.

Two suspects were located and arrested without incident.

34-year-old Chastity Willie Belcourt has been charged with attempted murder, assault with weapon and uttering threats against a person.

WHITECOURT RCMP INVESTIGATES DRUG TRAFFICKING – SEARCH EXECUTED AND TWO ARRESTED

On November 30, 2018, Whitecourt RCMP General Investigations section, with the assistance of the Whitecourt RCMP Detachment as well as the KDIV Police Dog Service

Unit simultaneously executed 2 Controlled Drugs and Substances Act search warrants at 2 separate residences in Whitecourt. As a result, a significant amount of drugs, various drug paraphernalia and weapons were seized.

During the execution of the search warrant, approximately

\$21,000 cash was seized as well as the following controlled substances:

- 14 ounces Cocaine - Street Value: \$40,000
- 56 grams powder Ecstasy - Street Value: \$4,480

PARLIAMENT UPDATE – WEEK OF NOVEMBER 26, 2018

The House of Commons debated the following:

- C-75 – Criminal Code (An Act to amend the Criminal Code, the Youth Criminal Justice Act and other Acts and to make consequential amendments to other Acts) (Third Reading)
- C-81 – Canada Accessibility Act (Third Reading)
- C-86 – Budget Implementation Act, 2018 No.2 (Third Reading)
- C-87 – Poverty Reduction Act (Second Reading)
- C-391 – Aboriginal Cultural Property Repatriation Act (Report Stage)
- C-405 – Pension Benefits Standards Act (Second Reading)
- C-417 – Criminal Code (disclosure of information by jurors) (Second Reading)
- C-422 – Parliament of Canada Act (First Reading)
- S-203 – Ending the

Captivity of Whales and Dolphins Act (Second Reading)

- S-215 – An Act to amend the Criminal Code (Sentencing for Violent Offences Against Aboriginal Women) (Second Reading)

- S-234 – An Act to Amend the Parliamentary of Canada (Parliamentary Visual Artist Laureate) (Second Reading)

- Emergency Debate – Canada's Oil and Gas Sector

On Monday, I spent the day in Leeds-Grenville, meeting with local business leaders and assisting the new candidate in the area, Michael Barrett.

On Tuesday, in the Standing Committee on Public Safety and National Security (SECU), we continued the study on Bill C-83, An Act to amend the Corrections and Conditional Release Act.

On Wednesday, I attended a luncheon featuring a keynote address by Premier Rachel Notley. She spoke of the challenges facing Alberta's energy industry and explained why every Canadian,

whether they work in energy or not, has a direct stake in Alberta's success. Later that evening, I asked a question during the Emergency Debate on Canada's Oil and Gas Sector in relation to the jobs losses in Alberta.

On Thursday, I attended the Transportation Committee meeting in the morning and the Public Safety and National Security (SECU) in the afternoon where we went through Bill C-83, clause-by-clause well into the evening. www.ourcommons.ca/Committees/en/SECU.

On Friday, while on House Duty, I asked a question during debate on the Poverty Reduction Act (C-87).

Both subjects remain in custody and are scheduled for court in Barrhead on December 11, 2018.

The RCMP do not believe that this was a random event, and public safety was not at risk.

GRASMERE SCHOOL WELCOMES NEW TEAM MEMBER!

Hero, is a Facility Dog, from the Dogs with Wings organization, who will help students who are reluctant readers or who may have anxiety or behavioural issues. Principal Wyman shares that Hero also presents students with "an opportunity to learn about empathy, caring for others and how to care for an animal."

The school is very excited to have Hero join the team. Hero's primary handler will be Grade 5 teacher, Anna Secord. All students will have access to Hero who will work primarily Ms. Secord's classroom for now, so that he and Ms. Secord can learn about one another.

Hero has been trained as a facility/therapy dog to assist children with learning difficulties and those who have high anxiety in a variety of situations, such as reading and communicating. Studies, and our own experiences, show that student engagement and comfort levels increase when students are paired with a furry companion.

Hero is NGPS' second facility dog from Dogs with Wings. Sage, a sweet black labrador retriever, joined the Pat Hardy Primary family in 2015!

Dogs with Wings (DWW) is a non profit group that relies upon donations and sponsorship to support their program. They provide dogs to their clients, free of charge, however, the cost to breed, raise,

train and place a single assistance dog into the home of a client takes approximately two years to complete and costs DWW \$40,000 per dog. Sponsorship and support helps to offset the expenses of training an outstanding assistance dog. Dogs with Wings Assistance Dog Society (DWW) is a federally-registered charitable organization.

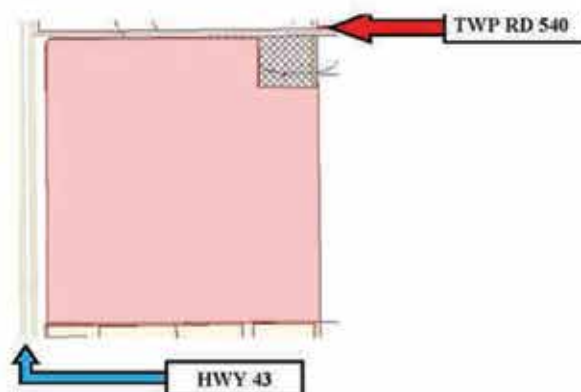

- 1 Gram Heroin - Street Value: \$280

- The combined street value of the drugs and cash was approximately \$84,745.84.

Russell John WILSON, 33-years-old and Kayla Joy LIGHTNING, 25-years old, have each been charged with 3 counts of possession of controlled substance, 3 counts of trafficking in a controlled substance, 3 counts of possession of a controlled substance for the purpose of trafficking, 1 count of possession of proceeds of crime over \$5000.00., 1 count of possession of cannabis for the purpose of unlawfully distributing it and 1 count of distributing cannabis that they knew was illicit cannabis.

FIRE PERMIT SEASON IN EFFECT YEAR-ROUND

Lac Ste. Anne County's fire season begins March first annually. On January 13, 2011, the County enacted a year-round permitting system. This means that **AT ANY TIME OF THE YEAR** a Fire Permit must be obtained from your local Fire Guardian for **ANY BURNING** you would like to do.



Please note that Fire Permits will not be issued for existing fires nor for ground fires; therefore, any existing fires must be extinguished immediately. Also, a Fireworks Permit must be obtained prior to setting off any fireworks within the County at any time.

****A FIRE PERMIT OR FIREWORKS PERMIT MUST BE OBTAINED AT ANY TIME OF THE YEAR****

It is unlawful to burn without a Fire Permit and you may be fined as per the County's Fire Bylaw. It is also unlawful to set off Fireworks without a Fireworks Permit and you may be fined as per the County's *Fireworks Bylaw*. (These Bylaws may be viewed on the County's website at LSAC.ca.) Fire and Fireworks Permits are FREE, so your cooperation in this regard is greatly appreciated.

Residents interested in obtaining Forest & Prairie (Wildfire) Insurance should contact their insurance agent, as a number of insurance companies and brokers offer this type of insurance coverage as an

add-on to existing farm/house policies. If there is a fire on your property and Lac Ste. Anne County Fire Services provides fire suppression, the County may invoice the land owners for those costs. Please call the Fire Services Department should you have any questions regarding fire insurance or billing for fire suppression costs at 780.785.3411 / 1.866.880.5722.

To obtain a Fire or Fireworks Permit, please contact the Fire Guardian in your Division, listed below, or call the County Office at 780.785.3411 / 1.866.880.5722. We encourage you to work with the Fire Guardian for pre-planning of your burning, such as pile sizes, location of piles, weather concerns, and necessary equipment to have on hand.

NOTE: Fire Guardians will respond within 24 hours to make arrangement for issuing a Fire Permit, so please plan your burning with this in mind.

DRIVEWAY CLEARING PROGRAM



Submitted by Lac Ste. Anne County | www.LSAC.ca

Anyone who is a property owner and resides within the Lac Ste. Anne County and requires the services of the County Public Works Department to clear the snow in their driveway must purchase a snowplow flag in advance at various outlets throughout the County.

The charge is \$25.00 per flag, per clearing. This means one (1) flag will be used each time

you request snow removal. The \$25.00 fee provides snowplowing from the road to the residence only. For snowplowing services with no flag (call in), the cost will be \$40.00 paid via credit card at the time of the call. Additional clearing and/or custom snowplowing requirements are to be requested through the Public Works Department at the County office and will be charged at a rate of \$80.00 per hour with a minimum charge of one (1) hour.

Please note that your approach and driveway must be a minimum of 22 feet wide, with no obstacles and have a clearance of 18 feet high, with no overhanging trees or wires, otherwise the County grader(s) will NOT clear your driveway.

After a major snowstorm, opening of roads will take approximately three (3) days, therefore plowing of driveways would not normally occur until the fourth (4th) day or later. Other arrangements should be made if you require your driveway plowed sooner.

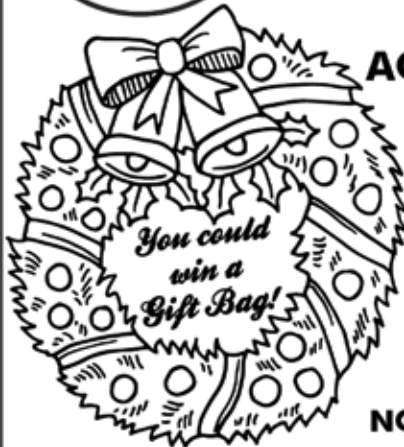

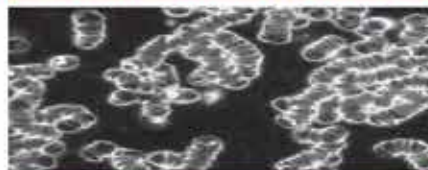
