Barrhead RCMP with assistance from Westlock RCMP





PARLIAMENT UPDATE - WEEK OF JUNE 3, 2019

On Monday, in the Standing Committee on Public Safety and National Security (SECU), we heard from the Honourable Ralph Goodale, Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness, the Honourable Bill Blair, Minister of Border Security and Organized Crime Reduction, and representatives from the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, the Canada Border Services Agency, the Correctional Services of Canada, and the Parole Board of Canada, regarding the main estimates.

On Tuesday, I rose in the House to speak on my Private Member's Bill, C-206 – "An Act to amend the Criminal Code (abuse of vulnerable persons)". My Bill dealt with the physical, emotional, sexual or financial abuse of a person over the age of 65 or of a

person 18 years of age or older who depends on others for their care because of a mental or physical disability as an aggravating circumstance for sentencing purposes. My speech can be found on my Facebook page: www.facebook.com/jimeglinski.mp/

On Wednesday, I met with representatives from the geothermal industry and later that evening, I rose in the House to give my 'farewell' speech to my colleagues, my constituents and to my staff in Ottawa and the riding. I will miss you all!

On Thursday, I participated in

debate on C-93, "An Act to provide no-cost, expedited record suspensions for simple possession of cannabis".

This week, I attended six meetings, and two events.

I flew back to the riding Thursday evening and the next day I dropped in at the Alberta Forest Fire Centre in Edson, before heading on to the Hinton Neighbourlink grand opening's ribbon cutting ceremony.

Later that evening, I attended Ecole Desrochers' graduation dinner and said a few words to the 2019 graduates.

On Saturday, I will be speaking at the Edson Legion's D-Day Commemorative Ceremony, acknowledging the 75th anniversary of the allied forces invasion of Normandy. The parade will begin at 10:45am, followed by a brief ceremony at the Cenotaph.

On Sunday, I will be returning to Ottawa as Parliament is scheduled to sit for the next two weeks.

MAYORS' MESSAGE—2019 PROPERTY TAX/ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

Submitted by Town of Mayerthorpe

This year's budget was approved at a Special meeting of Council held November 20, 2018. The Town's operating budget increased overall – 10.62% over last year's budget to \$4,471,132. The increase to the total municipal tax portion was 2%, which is in line with inflation for Alberta.

The 2018 Residential Assessment for the 2019 Taxation Year decreased by \$2,323,930 primarily as a result of market value decreases. The 2018 Non-Residential Assessment for the 2019 Taxation Year decreased by \$682,490 primarily as a result of market value decreases. Market value decreases are an indication of the overall economic climate in Alberta.

Overall, Council supports the 2019 Budget and looks forward to completing the various approved projects to support the growth of Mayerthorpe!

Important information you should know:

PROPERTY TAX RATE IMPLICATIONS

Council approved an increase to the 2019 municipal Residential Tax Rate by 4.61% and increasing the municipal Non-Residential Tax Rate by 6.63%. In accordance with the 2019-2021 Strategic Plan, Council also approved increasing the Residential Minimum Tax Levy to \$858.00, the Mobile Home Minimum Tax Levy to \$525.00, and the Non-Residential Minimum Tax Levy to \$1,716.00.

Your property tax consists of Municipal, Education and Senior taxes, and if applicable, Local Improvement Levies. Property Taxes are for January 1 to December 31, 2019. Please note: the deadline for tax payments, without penalty, is July 2, 2019. Late payment penalties

will begin July 3, 2019, and will be added to the balance owing at this time. Current taxes outstanding will be penalized at 12% on July 3, 2019. Tax arrears will receive a 12% penalty and will be imposed on January 1, 2020.

Please be aware:

• Failure to receive a tax/assessment notice is not considered sufficient reason for

non-payment of taxes.

- Late payment penalties will be applied after the July 3, 2019 due date.
- Tax payments sent by mail are deemed to have been received by the Town on the date of the postmark.
- Post-dated cheques are accepted.

WHAT ELSE IS ON YOUR TAX NOTICE?

Each individual property tax notice will also include the Alberta School Foundation Fund (School Requisition) and Lac Ste. Anne Foundation (Senior Requisition); these two requisitions are set by the Province of Alberta and Lac Ste. Anne Foundation. The Town is required to collect and flow through these requisitions to these two entities.


Drop-in Singles Pool
