



I'll have to admit that there's been a bit of a learning curve dealing with parliamentary procedure, but lucky for us our founding fathers had foreseen this circumstance, and the procedures are well documented and can be taught in short order.

I have had several opportunities to speak in the House. I'm starting to settle down a bit now and a little less nervous. Initially, like I said in my Maiden Speech, I felt like a long-tailed cat in a room full of rocking chairs! I have been able to ask questions about why we are not using fire retardant gels for forest fires and if the twining and the overpass at Highway 60 is still a go. I also had a chance to respond to a Motion on the Oil by Rail cars contract which was made by the previous government. The Motion was defeated so that contract has been scrapped. It felt good to be

your voice and to have a place at the table.

One of the biggest highlights so far was meeting the Grade 6 classes of Muir Lake and Dunstable schools during their tour of the Legislature, answer their very direct questions, and have another job interview. Rest assured, these school kids are engaged on what's happening in their province and have absolutely no problems articulating what matters to them!

I've also had the chance to attend a few local events and if you see me out at one of these events, please come over and let me know how things are going for you, and where you would want me to focus some of my attention.

I am also a member of the following committees, and as such in addition to the regular local constituency work, am now able to have some input on a larger provincial scale:

- 3. Resource Stewardship Committee
- 4. Northern Caucus

- 6. Skilled Trades Caucus, Deputy Chair

## WHITECOURT RESPONDS TO EMPLOYER NEEDS

The Town of Whitecourt is taking action, and listening to local businesses and industry.

Whitecourt's location is an obvious advantage for business; however, understanding our workforce capabilities, human resource and training needs, along with the potential to become a regional training centre, is a bit more complex.

Responding to employer-expressed needs, the Town of White-court has commissioned a Community Training and Workforce Needs Analysis to quantify local labour force strengths, and identify gaps in occupational skills and training. This information will be used to develop a strategy to strengthen Whitecourt's workforce competitiveness.

"Economic development and business attraction and retention is changing. It used to be about providing affordable land and utilities, and now it is about fostering the right talent in the right place to meet business needs," said Rhonda Hough, Economic Development Officer for Whitecourt.

Whitecourt has engaged McSweeney & Associates to develop this strategy. McSweeney & Associates will be completing a thorough analysis of Whitecourt's economy and workforce, including interviews with local employers and focus groups for the Town's leading and emerging employment sectors to get a complete overview of workforce and training needs. These business visitations will commence the first week of June 2019.

Whitecourt Mayor Maryann Chichak added, "Our Council knows that healthy businesses mean a healthy and vibrant community. This is a priority for us so to ensure Whitecourt is the go-to place for regional operations, and we hope that many of our businesses will be involved in this project."




