# PREVENTING HEPATITIS B

World Hepatitis Day is July 28. Close to 300 million people around the world live with a hepatitis B infection.

It is potentially life-threatening and is spread through blood or body fluids from an infected person.

What is it? Hepatitis B is a liver disease caused by a virus. It is the leading cause of liver cancer.

What are the symptoms? Symptoms include tiredness, poor appetite, nausea and vomiting, stomach and joint pain, dark-coloured urine and light-coloured stool and yellowing of eyes and skin.

Who is at risk? Activities such as unprotected sex, sharing needles, tattooing or acupuncture put people at increased risk. In some countries, medical treatments and blood products may also be a source of

infection. Is there a vaccine to help prevent illness?

Yes, there is a vaccine available for all ages. A vaccine series against hepatitis B is 95- to 100-per-cent effective in preventing infection caused by the virus before exposure and for at least 30 years following immunization. **Clubroot Inspection, Fusarium Head Blight Survey and Grasshopper Survey to Begin**

Ag Services will inspect all canola fields for visible symptoms of clubroot on canola plants, per *Policy 408 – Control of Clubroot Disease*. An approximate calendar indicating where and when inspections will occur throughout the County. Please keep in mind this is an approximation; producers will be notified of any major changes to the inspection schedule.

Surveys will be conducted for grasshoppers to aid in provincial forecasting. The surveys will take place randomly throughout the county, and only within county ditches or along field edges.

**New this year, Ag Services will be surveying approximately 10% of cereal fields for Fusarium Head Blight. The selection of these fields is at random, and is for informational purposes only.**

# ALEXIS NAKOTA SIOUX NATION CELEBRATE BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW SCHOOL WITH SOD TURNING CEREMONY

A safe and healthy place to learn is vital to a good education. The Government of Canada is committed to working in partnership with First Nations communities to build school facilities that improve educational outcomes and

foster pride and cultural identity for First Nations students.

On July 17, 2019, the Honourable Seamus O'Regan, Minister of Indigenous Services, joined Chief Tony Alexis to participate in a sod turning ceremony at Alexis Nakota Sioux Nation in Alberta. This event marks the official start of construction of the

new junior-senior high school in the community.

The new school will address overcrowding issues at the current school and will also provide more career and technology studies options to prepare the First Nation students for post-secondary education and employment opportunities.

"We're working with First Nations to address the gap in education outcomes between Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples. Our government has made important commitments and today we're watching those commitments turn into real and meaningful change. I want to congratulate Chief Tony Alexis, the council and community of the First Nation. Mostly, though, I want to congratulate the students and future students who will benefit from the new school that will help to prepare them for success in all their future endeavours." - The Honourable Seamus O'Regan, P.C., M.P., Minister of Indigenous Services

# WHITECOURT TOWN COUNCIL UPDATE

Submitted by Town of Whitecourt

JULY 17, 2019

Whitecourt Town Council further tabled the motion to provide two years written notice to Woodlands County on the termination of the Water and Wastewater Agreement at its July 15, 2019 Regular Meeting. The motion will be deliberated at Council's next meeting scheduled on August 26, 2019. Council is concerned about the potential impact this may have on the region, and has requested clarification from Woodlands County on its position on revenue sharing as it directly impacts Whitecourt Town Council's decision on whether to terminate the water agreement as these two agreements are linked to each other. The topic of intermunicipal agreements has been forefront in local news and discussions, and information on three intermunicipal service agreements (Tax Revenue Sharing, Cost Sharing, and Water and Wastewater Agreements) is posted on [www.whitecourt.ca/Government/Intermunicipal-Agreements](http://www.whitecourt.ca/Government/Intermunicipal-Agreements). Community members of both Whitecourt and Woodlands

County are invited to refer to the information.

Whitecourt will be upgrading the Whitecourt Fire Department's communication system with new hardware that is compatible with the provincially supported Alberta First Responder Radio Communication System (AFRRCS). The upgrade will provide cost efficiencies; increase reliability of the system; and, allow the Whitecourt Fire Department to directly communicate with RCMP, EMS ser-

vices and STARS to coordinate joint responses at emergency scenes. The project will be funded in partnership with Woodlands County.

At the request of Living Waters Catholic Schools, the Town of Whitecourt will be preparing a land allocation and use agreement to provide space for an additional playground site at Ecole St. Joseph School. Living Waters Catholic Schools plans to relocate the play structure from the former school site (in the hilltop

area) to the new school and requires a plot of land to accommodate the equipment.

Whitecourt Town Council approved a request from the Whitecourt Seniors Circle to expand its parking lot. The organization has over 270 members, and as a result requires additional parking space at the facility located at 5212 50 Street. The approved expansion, which will be built to the west of the existing parking lot, will add approximately 16 parking stalls.



## DON'T LET GOLFING PAIN BE PAR FOR THE COURSE

(NC) A little know-how can help golfers avoid unnecessary injury. Considering the number of times a swing is repeated during a game, it's not surprising that the season often ends early for those who are not physically prepared.

Below are a few simple stretching techniques that can help prevent or

reduce the impact of injuries:

- Side bending stretch
1. Stand with feet shoulder-width apart.
  2. Hold the golf club above your head with your arms straight.
  3. Slowly bend to one side, without rotating, until you feel a stretch in the side of your back.

4. Hold for 15 seconds and repeat twice for each side.

- Shoulder stretch
1. Hold the shaft of a golf club vertically behind your back.
  2. Gently pull the club up with your top hand until you feel a slight stretch in the shoulder of your lower arm. Hold for 15 seconds.

3. Gently pull the club down with your bottom hand until you feel a stretch in the top shoulder and arm.

4. Hold for 15 seconds.
5. Reverse hand positions and repeat.


