Results of the Police Services Community Satisfaction Survey have been finalized, and Council has identified three priorities for the 2020/2021 RCMP Annu-

Enhanced property crime reduction, break and enter and theft reduction initiatives; and,

3. Preservation of the prolific and priority offenders program.

The Police Services Community Satisfaction Survey will be conducted annually, and residents will have an opportunity to participate in the 2020 survey in the fall.

Annexation of the area between Flats Road and the Athabasca River has been approved. The annexation includes the Whitecourt Golf & Country Club, and Graham Acres Recreation Area. The Town is the majority property owner of this area, and with a large amount of undeveloped property, there will be little actual changes to the usage of the annexed land in the near future. Over the next several months, Administration will be working towards adoption of the North Flats Annexation Area Structure Plan, along with corresponding changes to the Municipal Development Plan and Land Use Bylaw.

Additional lighting will be installed along a portion of the Highway 43 path, as well as along Memorial Point Trail. In total, 17 decorative light fixtures will be added in the area to improve safety and usability of the trails.


Last month our photography club went to a light up at Central Park in Spruce Grove and took some really cool pictures.
