Arson Charges Laid Following Lengthy Investigation

Edson and Whitecourt RCMP GIS –with the assistance of RCMP GIS Units from Western Alberta District, Drayton Valley and Hinton; Grand Prairie Alberta Law Enforcement Response Teams and other RCMP specialized support units– were able to identify and charge two individuals in connection with multiple suspicious fires.

Thomas James Berube (37) and a male youth (17), both from Edson, are jointly charged with the following:

- Arson – damage to property (Edson Chrysler Dodge Jeep)
- Break and enter – commit theft over \$5,000 (Edson Chrysler Dodge Jeep)
- Arson – damage to property (motor vehicle)
- Theft of motor vehicle

over \$5,000

- Arson – disregard for human life (KW Pet Store)
- Killing or injuring animals (KW Pet Store)
- Break and enter – commit theft under \$5,000 (KW Pet Store)
- Arson – damage to property (Edson Honda)
- Break and enter – commit theft over \$5,000 (Edson Honda)
- Obstruction of justice

Berube is also charged with the following:

- Arson – disregard for human life (Petro Canada)
- Break and enter – commit indictable offence (Petro Canada)

The name of the youth will not be released pursuant to provisions of the Youth Criminal Justice Act.

Following judicial hearings, both Berube and the youth were remanded into custody to speak to bail

and are scheduled to attend court at Edson Provincial Court on March 17, 2020.

On Dec. 26, 2019, the KW Pet Store break and enter resulted in the theft of a four-month-old male Chihuahua dog from the premises. The Edson RCMP are looking for the assistance of the public in locating this dog.

MLA SHANE GETSON, LAC STE. ANNE-PARKLAND PRIVATE MEMBERS MOTION 501

EDMONTON: "It was a pleasure to introduce Private Members Motion 501 in the house on Monday March 2, 2020. The motion read as follows:

"Be it resolved that the Legislative Assembly urge the Government to establish corridors for transportation and utility infrastructure including railways, roads, pipelines and transmission lines, in order to improve access to global markets for Alberta products and resources via deep sea ports

in locations including but not limited to Hudson Bay, Kitimat, and the state of Alaska."

Transportation Utility Corridors (TUCs) are better for the environment when dealing with the need to transport energy goods across Canada, and they provide investor certainty in where to place their projects. Once the corridor is setup and established, red tape and applications are significantly reduced in approving energy projects within them.

Such corridors will add to investor confidence, and bring investment and jobs

back to our economy. Our energy is the most responsibly produced, and cleanest in the world.

Canada continues to import foreign oil unnecessarily. Recent international issues such as uncertainty Middle East, and COVID-19 have impacted, and will further impact Canada's import supply of oil. We can solve this easily by transporting Western Canadian oil out east.

It is also important to note that it is not just energy that can be transported in a TUC. Agriculture, manufacturing, and technology shipping can also be enhanced. Pur-

suing these has the potential to increase shipping speeds between Asia and Central/Eastern Canada by 4-10 days each way going through Alaska.

In addition, Bill 201 - The Strategic Aviation Advisory Council Act will assist in tying in air transport to Alberta's ability to ship products more effectively. More established TUCs and air transport together will move Alberta towards becoming a major economic hub for transportation of not only its products, but the products destined for other locations.

I was very pleased to see Motion 501 pass in the Legislative Assembly on Monday, and look forward to working with Government as they pursue the establishment of these corridors."

BUDGET 2020: STAYING ON TRACK TO BALANCE

Our government’s fiscal plan is working. This week, our government announced that the yearly deficit will be \$1.2 billion less than projected in Budget 2019. This will save taxpayers \$35 million in debt servicing costs and put this province on track to balance the budget by 2022-23. Balancing the budget

means that hard-earned taxpayer dollars will be invested in services for Albertans, instead of going to global banks and investors.

Through Budget 2020, this government is expanding the ambitious Capital Plan. This year’s budget adds an additional \$772 million in infrastructure projects over three years. This investment will help create 3,000 new, well-paying jobs by 2022. By expanding the Capital Plan,

our government is investing in roads, schools, hospitals, public transportation, and more. These key investments will help create jobs, grow the economy, and support the high-quality services that Albertans deserve. Despite what the opposition claims, Budget 2020 contained no cuts to spending on health or education. In fact, spending in these areas have been maintained at record highs. In order for

our core public services to be sustainable, the budget outlines new models to ensure funds directly support Albertans instead of getting caught in red tape.

Budget 2020 outlined A Blueprint for Jobs, our plan for job creation, which employs a variety of strategies to make Alberta an attractive place to do business. By reducing red tape and taxes, investing in key infrastructure, and focusing on skills development for our young workforce, Budget 2020 is helping get Alberta back to work.

With session officially underway this week, we brought our first bill to the floor, Bill 1: Standing Up for the Rule of Law. Premier Kenney introduced Bill 1, the Critical Infrastructure Defence Act, ensuring that no radical group should be able to hold our economy hostage. If passed, this bill would impose fines and potential jail time on any individual or organization who damages or interferes with critical infrastructure. By protecting our railways, highways, bridges, oil and gas production and refinery sites, this government is sending a strong message that lawlessness is not tolerated in Alberta.

Finally, this week marked an important victory for hardworking Albertan taxpayers as Federal courts have officially ruled the Federal Carbon Tax Unconstitutional! On February 24, the Alberta Court of Appeal announced a landmark 4-1 decision declaring the federal carbon tax unconstitutional. In their decision, the Court of Appeal called the effort to impose this punishing tax on families in Alberta a “constitutional Trojan Horse”. I am proud of the hard work this government has put in place since taking office to protect the interests of Albertans. By fighting the federal carbon tax, this government is helping get a better deal for Alberta.

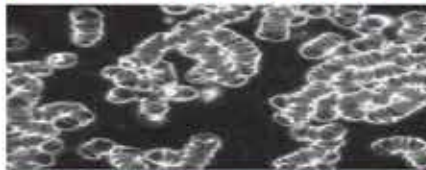
