### RCMP OBTAIN WARRANTS FOR BRADLEY GORDON DUFF'S ARREST

Whitecourt, Alta. – On June 23, 2020, at 8:30 a.m., Mayerthorpe RCMP received a complaint of a suspicious person in a rural area northeast of Mayerthorpe, Alta., in a pick-up

truck with a dirt bike in the box. Mayerthorpe RCMP attended the location and located the stolen pick-up abandoned off road in the Connor Creek area. The stolen pick-up truck was linked to the June 18, 2020, incident in Barrhead, Alta., outlined in the background

below.

A short time later information was received by Mayerthorpe RCMP of an individual matching Bradley Duff's description, having been in the area seeking fuel for the dirt bike.

## **RCMP Obtain Warrants For Bradley Gordon Duff's Arrest**

An extensive search of the area was conducted by Mayerthorpe, Evansburg, Whitecourt and Barrhead RCMP along with the assistance of RCMP Air Services, Police Dog Services and the Emergency Response Team; however, the search was unsuccessful in locating the suspect.

Whitecourt and Barrhead RCMP, along with the assistance of the RCMP Western Alberta Crime Reduction Unit, continue to investigate these incidents.

As a result of further investigation, RCMP have

obtained warrants for Bradley Gordon Duff's arrest in relation to the following charges:


- Break and enter to a residence
- Dangerous operation of a conveyance (x2)
- Flight from police Bradley Duff is also facing an additional charge of assault relating to an incident that occurred on May 13, 2020, for which Whitecourt RCMP have obtained a warrant for his arrest.

A 28-year-old female from Whitecourt, Alta., is also charged with break and enter to a residence. She was released on an undertaking for Barrhead Provincial

Court on September 22, 2020. Her name cannot be released as the information has not yet been sworn.

The public are warned not to approach Duff as he is believed to be possibly armed and dangerous. If anyone has information about Bradley Duff's whereabouts, please contact Whitecourt RCMP at 780-779-5900, 911 or your local police.

We are focused on getting workers and businesses in this community and across the country back on their feet." MP Soroka stated.

Since the beginning of the pandemic, Conservatives have been putting forward constructive solutions to fix the design flaws in the Liberals' programs and help deliver better outcomes for Canadians. We are building on that success with the new Back to Work Bonus. We know helping workers and local businesses will drive Canada's economic recovery.

Under our Conservative plan, Canadians who lost their jobs through no fault of their own during the pandemic will continue to receive their full \$2,000 CERB. In addition, as businesses reopen, workers who make between \$1,000 and \$5,000 per month would qualify for a CERB top-up that would be gradually phased out by 50 cents for every extra dollar earned over the \$1,000 threshold.

Library occupancy will be limited to maintain the recommended 2M physical distancing and may not exceed 5 persons (including staff) at this time. Please follow signs and floor markings.



#### WHITECOURT TOWN COUNCIL UPDATE

#### Submitted by Town of Whitecourt

JUNE 24, 2020

Whitecourt residents can drop off waste at the Whitecourt Regional Landfill for free between August 25 to 29, 2020. The initiative is being offered in lieu of the annual Spring Clean Up campaign which was postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This initiative will provide an additional refuse disposal option to residents while taking into account the health and safety of staff and the public to prevent further spread of COVID-19. Additional details on the initiative will be provided to residential utility customers and on the Whitecourt website in July.

Whitecourt will be submitting an application to the Federation of Canadian Municipalities Asset Man-

agement Program for grant funding to complete an asset management implementation plan. The plan will involve a more comprehensive catalogue of infrastructure asset data sets than currently inventoried, and the creation of a management strategy, procedures, reporting and training for staff and Council. Asset management helps communities manage infrastructure municipal assets and make decisions on maintaining, replacing and repairing municipal infrastructure; it takes into account community growth and changing needs.

The 2019 Collision Report is complete. The report, which is completed annually, shows that collision trends remain similar to 2018, and that traffic through the community is down by approximately 3% from 2018. Study findings also reflect a slight

increase in collisions at the intersections of Dahl Drive and 55 Avenue, and Highway 43 and Highway 32. The report will be forwarded to the Whitecourt Protective Services Committee for review, and information will also be sent to Alberta Transportation, which is responsible for safety and maintenance of the highway.

The annual review of Off-Site Levies is complete and, based on the study, rates will be changing as of January 1, 2021. Off-Site Levies are a cost recovery tool that help pay for infrastructure projects that allow the community to grow, including roads, and water and sewage treatment.

Councillor Derek Schlosser will serve as Deputy Mayor from July 1 to August 31, 2020.

Whitecourt Town Council will hold only one meeting

during the months of July and August. The meetings will be held on the following dates:

- Monday, July 20
- Tuesday, August 25

Council's regular meeting schedule, of every second and fourth Monday of each month, will resume in September.







