



# INCREASED ACCESS TO THE CANADA EMERGENCY BUSINESS ACCOUNT

Submitted by Gerald Soroka, MP for Yellowhead

OTTAWA: Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, is pleased to inform constituents that as of June 19 the government will be accepting applications so that more small businesses can access the Canada Emergency Business Account.

This includes owner-operated small businesses that

had been ineligible for the program due to their lack of payroll, sole proprietors receiving business income directly, as well as family owned corporations remunerating in the form of dividends rather than payroll, will become eligible this week.

To qualify under the new eligibility rules, applicants with a payroll lower than \$20,000 will need:

• A business operating account at a participating fi-

nancial institution;

- A Canada Revenue Agency business number;
- A 2018 or 2019 tax return; and

• Eligible non-deferrable expenses of between \$40,000 and \$1.5 million.

We wish everyone the best and a healthy and safe summer and look forward to seeing you all in 2021.



tiful sunshine we have been blessed with recently.





## DARWELL PUBLIC LIBRARY NEWS

## Submitted by Darwell Public Library

We are happy to be part of the phase 2 re-opening of Alberta and look forward to welcoming you back to the library, however, there have been a few changes. The Darwell Public Library will be returning to limited public operations starting Tuesday, July 7, 2020.

We will be opening on a limited basis for July and August 2020 on Tuesday 11AM to 4PM and Friday 5PM to 8PM -Subject to change.

We will have 2 computers available for use and sessions will be restricted to 60 minutes.

During the library closure we have been providing curbside service and we will continue this service by appointment. Please contact us during library operating hours to set up a time.

All due dates were extended on checked out items during the pandemic and overdue fines have not been levied. We ask you to continue placing returned items through the book drop as all material will be held aside for the recommended 3-day quarantine period prior to check in. Any fines incurred during quarantine will be waived.

Library occupancy will be limited to maintain the recommended 2M physical distancing and may not exceed 5 persons (including staff) at this time. Please follow signs and floor markings.

to place local holds. We encourage patrons to explore a world of virtual information and entertainment with the variety of e-resources available through the Darwell Public Library website @ https://darwellpubliclibrary.ab.ca/ Just log in with your library card number and pin to discover an assortment of e-books, audiobooks, movies, tv shows, magazines, newspapers as well as reference, learning and activity resources for everyone.

We are working to reschedule programs that were cancelled due to the library closure and exploring virtual program opportunities and ask for your patience and understanding as we navigate the changing landscape. Stay well and safe and we

## YELLOWHEAD COUNTY COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

#### Submitted by Yellowhead County

June 23, 2020

Economic Corridor Initiative Presentation – Bart Guyon, Reeve, Brazeau County, and Brian Senio, Research Analyst, Global Public Affairs, presented to county council regarding a proposed western economic corridor.

The presenters are seeking to create a collaboration of industries, First Nations communities, municipalities, and the provincial and federal government, which will aim to stimulate economic recovery, job creation, and investment attraction in the western Alberta region.

Agricultural Services Board Establishment – Earlier this year, Yellowhead County Council rescinded the Agricultural Service Board (ASB) and assumed all previously delegated responsibilities of that board. Alberta Agriculture and Forestry requires a municipality to establish an ASB to meet applicable legislation and the requirements of the annual provincial ASB grant. Council gave third reading to Bylaw No. 15.20, being a bylaw to establish an Agricultural Service Board and an Agricultural Services Appeal Committee.

Council Appointment of an Agricultural Service Board – As county council had previously rescinded the Agricultural Service Board (ASB), council is now responsible for manning the ASB. Yellowhead County Council appointed the whole of council as the Yellowhead County Agricultural Service Board with the Mayor as chair.

River Ridge Area Structure Plan Amendment - River Ridge Properties Ltd. has recently submitted an application to amend the River Ridge Area Structure Plan 25.13. This application is in support of the subdivision of one additional lot from the plan area, meaning the proposed amendment will increase the number of country residential lots within the plan area from 47 to 48. Council gave first reading to Bylaw 16.20 amending the River Ridge Area Structure Plan as indicated on Schedule "A" and forwarded the bylaw to a public hearing to be held on July 28, 2020.

PLEASE NOTE: The next scheduled regular Council meeting is July 28, 2020 at 9:30 AM. The next scheduled Governance & Priorities meeting is July 21, 2020. The July 14 council meeting has been cancelled.
