in-person learning to proceed, health measures are being put in place for their safety. Each school will implement public health measures, including frequent cleaning of surfaces, introducing hand sanitizers to school and classroom entrances, grouping students in cohorts, and adjusting schedules to allow for greater physical distancing. While school may feel a little different at first, these changes will allow a safe, near-normal return to class.

In addition to these measures, \$15 million of capital spending is being moved up to replace old water fountains with water bottle refill stations, install automatic doors, automatic flush toilets, and other touchless technology to help limit the spread. Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, keeping Albertans informed on new measures has been a key part of Alberta's response. To help prepare families, Alberta's government has developed a re-entry toolkit to help prepare parents and students for what to expect in the new school year. This toolkit includes videos for students explaining some of the health measures, a guide for parents, frequently asked questions, school posters, a self-screening questionnaire in multiple languages, and links to health guidelines. The resources in the school re-entry toolkit will help families discuss changes with their children.

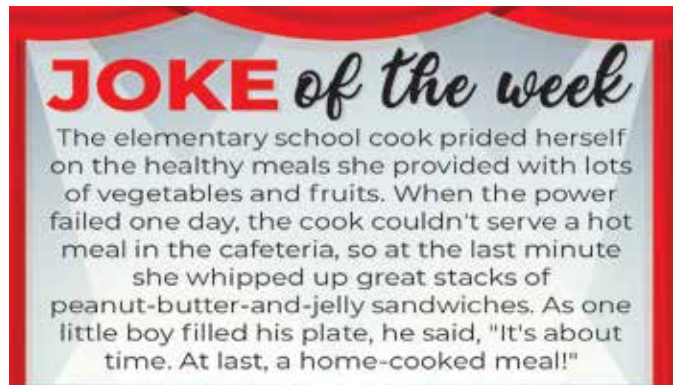
I know many school authorities are working to give parents as much choice as possible. Some divisions are working to allow for the choice to school from home with online/email assignment support. I thank those divisions that are working to provide as much choice as possible, and provide learning to those who may be immune compromised.

As Alberta's students, parents, and teachers prepare for back to school, the Minister of Education will continue to work closely with school boards, and Dr. Hinshaw the Chief Medical Officer of Health, to ensure that all schools are prepared to

welcome students back.

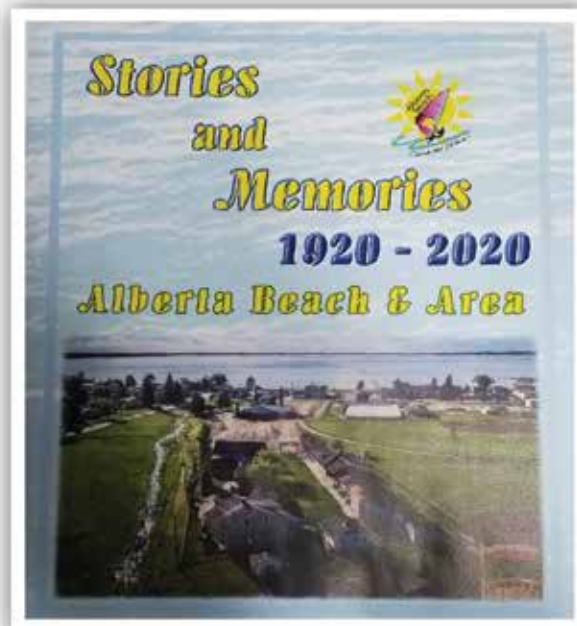

BLUE-GREEN ALGAE (CYANOBACTERIA) BLOOM ADVISORY ISSUED FOR LAKE ISLE

LAC STE. ANNE COUNTY/PARKLAND COUNTY—A blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) bloom has been identified in areas of Lake Isle, which has shores in both the Edmonton Zone and North Zone of Alberta Health Services. Visitors to this lake, as well

as residents living near the shores, are advised to take the following precautions:

- Avoid all contact with blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) blooms. If contact occurs, wash with tap water as soon as possible.
- Do not swim or wade, or allow your pets to swim or wade in any areas where blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) is visible.

teria) is visible.

- Do not feed whole fish or fish trimmings from this lake to your pets.

- Consider limiting human consumption of whole fish and fish trimmings from this lake, as it is known that fish may store toxins in their liver. (People can safely consume fish fillets from this lake).

As always, visitors and res-

idents are reminded to never drink or cook with untreated water directly from any recreational body of water, including Lake Isle, at any time. Boiling of this water will not remove the toxins produced by blue-green algae. An alternate source of drinking water should also be provided for pets and livestock, while this advisory is active.

Blue-green algae is naturally occurring, and often becomes visible when weather conditions are calm. Appearing like scum, grass clippings, fuzz or globs on the surface of water, blue-green algae can be blue-green, greenish-brown, brown, and/or pinkish-red, and often smell musty or grassy.

People who come in contact with visible blue-green algae or who ingest water containing blue-green algae may experience skin irritation, rash, sore throat, sore red eyes, swollen lips, fever, nausea and vomiting and/or diarrhea. Symptoms usually appear within one to three hours and resolve in one to two days. Symptoms in children are often more pronounced; however, all humans are at risk of these symptoms.

Exposure to the blue-green algae may be fatal to pets.

Weather and wind conditions can cause algae blooms to move from one location in the lake to another. As such, this advisory will remain in effect for Lake Isle, until further notice.

Please note that areas of Lake Isle in which the blue-green algae bloom is NOT visible can still be used for recreational purposes, even while this blue-green algae Health Advisory is in place.



SCHOOL BUS SAFETY

1. Take your seat right away and stay seated until you leave the bus. 2. Sit back in your seat, face forward and keep your feet to the front. 3. Talk quietly so not to distract the driver. Remember, it's the driver's responsibility to keep you safe! 4. Wait for the bus to come to a complete stop and the doors to open before you leave your seat. 5. After leaving the bus, take five giant steps away from the bus so you are out of the Danger Zone and in a safe spot.
