Spruce Grove Fire Services wants to share safety tips to keep you from having a cooking fire.

• Never leave cooking food unattended. Stay in the kitchen while you are frying, grilling or broiling food. If you have to leave, even for a short time, turn

off the stove.

• If you are simmering, baking, roasting, or boiling food, check it regularly. Remain in the home while food is cooking, and

use a timer to remind you that you're cooking.

- You have to be alert when cooking. You won't be alert if you are sleepy, have taken medicine or drugs, or have consumed alcohol that makes you drowsy.
- Always keep an oven mitt and pan lid near-by when you're cooking. If a small grease fire starts, slide the lid over the pan to smother the flame. Turn off the burner, and leave the pan covered until it is completely cool.
- Have a "kid-free zone" of at least 1 metre around the stove and areas where hot food or drink is prepared or carried.







Gasoline can be more dangerous than dynamite since it emits invisible, explosive vapours that ignite easily, even at low temperatures.

- Never store gasoline in basements, pits or otherconfined areas. Gasoline must be stored in areas that are well ventilated, free from ignition sources & in areas permitted by the National Fire Code of Canada.
- Never smoke while you are handling gasoline or other flammable liquids
- Never use gasoline to start your BBQ or as a cleaner or solvent.





# Thank You to the Stony Plain Fire Department for keeping Our Community Safe



# PREPARE

Install smoke alarms on every level of your home, as well as inside and outside every sleeping area.

Test smoke alarms monthly, and replace the batteries if needed.

Purchase and learn how to safely use a fire extinguisher.

Create a fire escape plan with your family, reviewing and practicing it twice a year.

Your fire escape plan should include two exit points from every room, as well as a designated outdoor meeting spot.

Make sure everyone in your family knows when and how to call 911 or the fire department.

# PREVENT

Turn off portable heaters whenever you leave a room or go to sleep.

Keep matches and lighters out of reach from children, and make sure they know never to play with these items.

Replace or repair loose plugs, exposed wiring or frayed extension cords, and avoid overloading outlets and extension cords.

Keep any items that can catch fire at least three feet away from cooking and heating devices.

Remain in the kitchen when frying, grilling or broiling food. Always turn off the stove if you leave the kitchen even for a brief period of time.

# STAY ALIVE

In the event of a fire, yell "Fire" repeatedly and evacuate immediately. Once outside, call 911 and never reenter a burning building for any reason.

If a door or door handle feels warm to the touch, do not open it. Use an alternate escape route.

If you must walk through smoke, get as close to the ground as possible to escape under the smoke, closing doors behind you.

If your clothing catches fire, always remember to stop, drop and roll, covering your face with your hands.

If you can't escape a room, close the door and cover vents and door cracks with a towel or cloth to keep out smoke. Signal for help at the window with a piece of cloth or a flashlight.



Follow these fire safety tips, and review them with other members of your household, to protect yourself, your property, your community and your loved ones.
