

The highest months for reported break and enters were November, October, and December. Break and enters can also occur during the off-season but end up being reported in the spring. In an effort to curb break-ins during the winter months, Alberta RCMP is providing these tips:

- It's not just pumpkins that should be hollow this time of year, remember to take home all valuables.
- Don't 'fall' into old habits. If you can't take all valuables home, be sure to lock them in a shed or garage.
- Help 'squash' crime by locking all doors and windows.

An Edson, Alta. RCMP member has been charged following an investigation conducted by the Alberta RCMP Western Alberta District General Investigation Section.

Const. Ryan Deroche (34), of the Edson Detachment,

has been charged with:

- Two counts of uttering threats
- · One count of assault; and
- Two counts of mischief under \$5,000.

On September 29, 2020, GYPSD hosted a virtual community information night on the The West Yellowhead Community Violent Threat Risk Assessment and Intervention Protocol (VTRA).

VTRA partners were on hand to answer questions

and share information on the VTRA process with community members who joined in the virtual meeting. Partners are engaged and responsive with a shared responsibility to actively take steps to prevent traumatic events in schools and the community. GYPSD is a partner on the West Yellowhead Community Violent Threat Risk Assessment and Intervention Protocol and uses this assessment tool in situations of threatening and violent behaviours.

Together with partners from the Royal Canadian

Mounted Police, Children Services, and Alberta Health Service Mental Health and Addictions, Grande Yellowhead staff have undertaken training to equip schools to recognize these signs, assess them, and put in place interventions to support and reduce the level of risk.

ORANGE SHIRT DAY 2020

Orange Shirt Day is a movement that officially began in 2013 to address



an incident that occurred in 1973 when six-year old Phyllis Webstad entered the St. Joseph Mission Residential School, outside of Williams Lake, B.C. Phyllis was wearing a brand new orange shirt for her first day of school but the missionaries made her take it off and replaced it with the school's institutional uniform.

The goal of Orange Shirt Day recognized on September 30th, is to create awareness of the individual, family, and community inter-generational impacts of Residential schools through Orange Shirt Day activities, and to promote the concept that "Every Child Matters".

GYPSD staff and students wore orange and participated in various events and activities in support of reconciliation.




