tions under the Firearms Act, scheduled to come into force on December 1, 2020, have been deferred until December 1, 2023. The Government will use the deferral period to continue consulting with part-

ners and develop an effective markings regime that is appropriate for Canada, balancing the needs of law enforcement with the impact on firearms businesses and owners, while prioritizing public safety.

ARREST MADE FOR ATM THEFTS

**Submitted by Eastern
Alberta District General
Investigation Section**

Gunn, Alta. - During the afternoon of Nov. 30, 2020, at approximately 11:30 a.m., the Eastern Alberta District General Investigation Section (EADGIS) with assistance from the RCMP Emergency Response Team (ERT) and RCMP Air Services, attempted to apprehend an individual wanted on numerous outstanding warrants.

The individual was followed to a rural area near Barrhead where he evaded capture after fleeing in a motor vehicle.

On Dec. 1, 2020 at approximately 1:20 p.m., EADGIS with the assistance of ERT and the Central Alberta District Crime Reduction Unit, collaborated in the arrest of the same male pursued the previous night.

Darwyn Ronald Beaudry

(38) of no fixed address was arrested in Gunn, Alta., after exiting a vehicle and fleeing on foot.

EADGIS became involved in attempting to locate Beaudry after a lengthy year long investigation into ATM thefts around the province of Alberta spanning from September 2019 to Nov. 17, 2020. Beaudry was identified as a suspect in multiple investigations and is alleged to have committed a number of crimes which resulted in significant property damage in the towns of Legal, and Slave Lake. The ATM thefts were from a credit union and gas station. He is also alleged to have committed a break and enter into the No Frills Pharmacy in Vegreville, Alta., which occurred on Nov. 20, 2019.

Beaudry is facing 23 charges from multiple RCMP detachments. Some of the charges include:

- Participation in a criminal organization
- Flight from police
- Resisting arrest
- Disguise with intent (x3)
- Break and enter/theft (x5)

He was remanded into custody after a judicial hearing and is set to appear in Stony Plain Provincial Court on Dec. 9, 2020.

"These ATM investigations have now resulted in over 100 charges and continue," says Corporal Robert Burgess, EADGIS. "We continue to follow up on calls received with additional information and more arrests are anticipated."

EADGIS continue to investigate the ATM thefts that occurred in the towns noted and are asking anyone with information regarding these thefts to contact them at 780-645-8870. If you wish to remain anonymous, you can contact Crime Stoppers at 1-800-222-8477 (TIPS).

COMMUNITY VOICE AT ONOWAY MUSEUM

Onoway Museum has received an early Christmas gift, and what a gift! Back issues of The Community Voice dating back to 1983, the first year it was published!

The Community Voice donated 28 bound volumes dating from 1983 until 2008.

These are an incredible addition to the museum's Reading Room and Archives! When the Onoway Museum started in 2006, one of the objectives was to keep up to date with local

history by keeping copies of the weekly The Community Voice. For many years the museum was open only in summer and otherwise was staffed by volunteers. The collection of local newspapers gradually became more important but many, many issues were missing. When the Onoway Museum officially opened at its current site (the Old Brick School) in 2008, having all the newspapers available for research came for the fore.

And now we are there! Elaine Lewchuck of The Community Voice donated 28 bound volumes dating from 1983 until 2008. Having all the issues in this compact format makes research so easy – and so much fun! The news from Onoway, Alberta Beach and area is all there – much of it written by long-time reporter Lavyne Osbak. Lavyne reported on town

These volumes are an invaluable source of information about our local history

council meetings and every possible happening in and around the area. An incredible amount of information is now so easy to find!

A couple of examples: We learn that the Onoway Fire Department campaign for Jaws of Life met its goal in November 1984 (and raised over \$16,000) to fund equipment. Did you know there was an armed robbery of the Treasury Branch in Onoway in November 2000, about the same time as local cross-country skier Amanda Ammar (age 14) competed successfully in national finals? (She later went on to compete in the Olympics.)

These volumes are an invaluable source of information about local history – and they are now carefully gathered at a site which is readily accessible by the public year round. Onoway Museum wholeheartedly thanks Elaine Lewchuck and The Community Voice, and invites anyone interested in what's been happening around Onoway over the last 50 years to stop by the museum and browse through these gems!

RCMP ARREST TWO AS A RESULT OF A DRUG TRAFFICKING INVESTIGATION

On Dec. 1, 2020 Parkland RCMP Drug Unit concluded a drug trafficking investigation in Stony Plain.

The Parkland RCMP Drug Unit executed a search warrant at a

residence in Stony Plain and located numerous items related to drug trafficking.

The following items were located during the search:

- 86 grams of Methamphetamine
- 45 grams of Fentanyl
- 4 grams of Cocaine

- 6 tablets of Ecstasy tablets
 - 1- 303 caliber - Ross Rifle CO M10
 - 1 - 303 caliber - Ishapore 1939 Rifle
 - 1 - Horton LX-175 Cross Bow
 - 1- HX Outdoor Brass Knuckles
 - 1 Container of Bear Spray
- Gary Mongeon (53) and Tri-

sha Doherty (44) of Stony Plain, Alta. were arrested for numerous charges in relation to trafficking, weapons and failure to comply with release orders. Gary Mongeon was remanded into custody. Trisha Doherty's first appearance is scheduled for Jan. 20, 2021 in Stony Plain Provincial Court.

PARKLAND RCMP ARREST THREE AS A RESULT OF DRUG UNIT INVESTIGATION

Parkland Drug Unit concluded a drug investigation in Spruce Grove / Stony Plain. Members of the Parkland RCMP Drug Unit with the assistance of the Parkland Serious Crimes Unit obtained and executed warrants at various locations in Spruce Grove. Items related to drug trafficking were located during the searches including:

- 50 g of cocaine
- 59 g of methamphetamine

- 400 ml of GHB
- Paraphernalia related to drug trafficking
- A firearm with 95 rounds of ammunition
- A large amount of Canadian currency

Jacob Roach (31) and Channele Vandal-Lauman (25) of Spruce Grove, Alta. and Brandon Regamey (24) of Leduc, Alta. were arrested for numerous charges.

The three suspects were charged with Unlawful possession of a controlled substance for the purpose of trafficking (x3).

Additionally Brandon Regamey and Channele Vandal-Lauman are charged with:

- Occupy a motor vehicle knowing it contained a firearm
- Possess a loaded prohibited firearm without authorization

Brandon Regamey has six more charges of possess a firearm while prohibited and six charges of fail to comply with probation order.

Channele Vandal-Lauman has six additional charges of fail to comply with release order.

All three are scheduled to ap-

pear in Stony Plain Provincial Court on Dec. 16, 2020.

On Nov. 2, 2020 Parkland RCMP issued a media release regarding the investigation of an armed robbery in the area of Prescott Boulevard. Jacob Roach and Brandon Regamey were jointly charged in that investigation as well with offences related to aggravated assault and robbery with firearm.

No further details will be released as the matters are now before the courts.

COVID-19 UPDATE FOR WHITECOURT

Submitted by Town of Whitecourt

Due to increasing COVID-19 caseloads, Whitecourt's status has now changed to enhanced and our community is shaded purple on the COVID-19 Re-launch Status Map. With this change in status, enhanced public health restrictions are now in effect until at least December 15, 2020, even if our caseload numbers drop below ten (10).

Mandatory Business and Service Restrictions

In addition to the mandatory gathering restrictions announced by the Government of Alberta on November 24 for all Albertans, Whitecourt must now comply with business and service restrictions as detailed on the Government of Alberta website. Provin-

cial restrictions and guidelines vary depending on the type of business and service provided. Restrictions will come into effect on Wednesday, December 2, 2020.

Some businesses, including retail, grocery, pharmacies, clothing stores, hardware, indoor entertainment and indoor fitness, private or public swimming pools, recreation, sports and physical activity centres (including dance and yoga studios, martial arts, gymnastics for one-on-one indoor training with a trainer or coach) can remain open with capacity limited to 25% of the occupancy set under the Alberta Fire Code. To calculate occupancy limits please refer to the Province's Reduced Capacity and Occupant Loads guidance document.

Indoor group physical activities including team

sports, fitness classes and training sessions are prohibited unless:

- the group only involves members of the same household;
- the activity involves students at a school or post-secondary institution as part of an education program;
- the activity involves students at a post-secondary institution.

Mandatory Restriction for Places of Worship

In addition to restrictions listed above, faith services are limited to a maximum in-person attendance of one-third the occupancy set under the Alberta Fire Code. Further details on restrictions for places of worship can be found online and include the following:

- Must hold service at their normal location, including

rental spaces like a community hall;

- Maintain physical distancing between households;
- Mask use is mandatory;
- Online services are encouraged.

Town of Whitecourt Operations

Due to enhanced public health restrictions, the following changes in service and operation will take effect Wednesday, December 2, 2020:

- Access to the Allan & Jean Millar Centre, Town Office and Whitecourt Public Library will be limited based on occupancy. Facility users may experience wait times to access these facilities, and we appreciate your cooperation and understanding.
