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MORINVILLE RCMP SEEKING PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IN IDENTIFYING SUSPECT IN INDECENT ACT - STURGEON COUNTY

Sturgeon County, Alta – Morinville RCMP are currently investigating an Indecent Exposure Incident that occurred in the Riverlot 56 Natural Area in Sturgeon County.

On May 13, 2021 at 12:14 p.m. two female youth reported to Police that they had observed an unknown male in the trees while walking on the trail, on the northwest side of Sturgeon Road. The youth said they initially believed the male was urinating in the woods but soon realized he was masturbating. The youth continued along the trail and shortly thereafter the same male was observed in the trees again, and again he was masturbating. The youth fled and approached two adult females who escorted the youth from the area.

The male is described as being:

- Mid 40's
- Dark skinned
- Dark brown or black hair
- Heavy set
- Wearing a white t-shirt and blue jeans

The male was later observed walking away from the area heading southeast.

Despite extensive patrols in the area by Police the male was not located.

Morinville RCMP would like to thank the wom-

en who assisted the youth during this stressful incident and ensured they were safely escorted out of the wooded area.

WHITCOURT TOWN COUNCIL UPDATE

MAY 28, 2021

Festival Way, located in Rotary Park, is available for booking. Festival Way is an accessible pathway and vendor space (there are 23 10 foot by 10 foot stalls, each with access to power, tent anchors and a cement pad) designed to host arts, culture, and family events. For the inaugural year of this amenity, a discounted rental rate is being offered. To rent the space for your summer market or other special event contact the Allan & Jean Millar Centre at 780-778-3637.

Council has adopted

amendments to the Municipal Development Bylaw and Land Use Bylaw which will change how offstreet parking is managed in the downtown core.

- The minimum off-street parking requirements for the downtown area have been removed.

- The option for property owners to provide money in lieu of parking has been removed.

- Property owners within the downtown area will now be required to plan and address their own parking needs without municipal involvement.

The 2021 20-Year Capital and Major Maintenance Plan has been adopted. The

Plan, which includes 133 projects, provides a vision for the long term development of Whitecourt's infrastructure; land development; parks and trails; and, building and recreational/cultural facilities to meet the needs of our growing community. The Plan incorporates projects and timelines identified through engineering studies, planning sessions, workshops, budget deliberations, and public engagement activities. The Plan is available to view at www.whitecourt.ca/Reports.

582334 Alberta Ltd., owner of 5015 50 Avenue, has been awarded \$4,873 in funding through the Vital-

ization Grant Program. The Vitalization Grant Program offers businesses located in the downtown area and along the Highway 43 corridor up to \$10,000 to enhance their business or property to meet the Town's architectural theme of stone and wood. A second round of applications will be accepted in the coming weeks; watch the Whitecourt website for details.

Whitecourt has extended the waste and recycling service contracts with Green for Life (GFL) Environmental Inc. for one year. The extension will provide the municipality time to determine logistics of new waste, recycling and composting services that were recommended after a public engagement process earlier this year.

Whitecourt has entered into a three-year agreement with Whitecourt Veterinary Clinic Ltd. for the continued provision of animal pound services.

In March 2021, RCMP received the complaint and immediately launched an investigation.

On March 22, 2021, investigators arrested Elea-

zar Fronda (40) of Spruce Grove and charged him with sexual assault.

Fronza has been released from custody and is scheduled to appear in Stony Plain Provincial Court on June 16, 2021.

COVID-19 UPDATE FOR WHITECOURT

MAY 31, 2021

As announced by the Province on May 26, Alberta's Open for Summer Plan provides a three-stage road map to lifting health restrictions and safely getting back to normal. The plan includes three stages based on vaccination thresholds and hospitalizations, and Alberta will enter Stage 1 on Tuesday, June 1.

- Outdoor social gatherings,

with distancing, increases up to 10 people. Indoor social gatherings are still not permitted.

- Outdoor patio dining can resume with a maximum of four people per table.

- Outdoor physical, performance and recreational activities are permitted with up to 10 distanced people, for all ages.

- Retail can increase to 15% of fire code occupancy (must maintain ability to distance).

- Personal wellness services

can reopen, by appointment only.

- Wedding ceremonies may have up to 10 people, including the officiant, bride/groom, witnesses and any photographers/videographers. Receptions remain prohibited.

- Distancing and masking requirements remain in effect.

In addition, the capacity limit for worship services increased to 15% of fire code occupancy as of May 28.

Isolation and Quarantine Requirements for Vaccinated Albertans

The Government of Alberta has changed isolation and quarantine requirements for Albertans that partially or fully vaccinated.

If you are fully-vaccinated* and are exposed to a COVID-19 case:

- If you have no symptoms, you are not required to quarantine.
- If you do have symptoms, you must isolate for 10 days

and should get tested – your isolation can end early if you test negative.

If you are partially vaccinated* and are exposed to a COVID-19 case:



- If you have no symptoms, you must quarantine for 10 days and should get tested.
- Your quarantine can end early if you test negative on day 7 or later.
- If you test negative before day 7, you must remain in quarantine and need a second negative test on day 7 or later to end quarantine.
- If you do have symptoms,

you must isolate and should get tested.

• If you test negative before day 7, you must continue to quarantine (10 days total from exposure date).

• If you test negative on day 7 or later and your symptoms have resolved, your quarantine can end.

*You are considered fully vaccinated 14 days after receiving both doses in a 2-dose vaccine series, or 1 dose in a 1 dose vaccine series. You are considered partially vaccinated 14 days after receiving the first dose in a 2-dose vaccine series.

HOW TO AVOID INJURIES ON THE GOLF COURSE THIS SUMMER

(NC) For even the best of us golf can be a frustrating sport. The precision, patience, resiliency, and mental strength required challenges even the most talented and level-headed participants. With that being said golf is one of the most popular Canadian summer past times and is enjoyed by Canadians of all skill levels. While golf will undoubtedly test our men-

tal strength, it can be even more taxing on our bodies. The constant bending over, repetitive swing motion, and hot weather conditions take a physical toll.

Here are some tips to help prepare your body for a round of golf and avoid injury:

Find your swing: It is very easy for amateur golfers to injure themselves by repeatedly doing an incorrect

swing. Everyone's swing is different, but it is important to work with a swing that benefits our game and body. Consulting with a professional before hitting the links will help develop our game and avoid injury.

The right equipment: Wearing proper golf attire goes beyond simply looking the part. Your playing partners will be intimidated when they see you strut to

the tee box looking like Jordan Spieth; that is until you flub your first drive 20 yards right into the water. Wearing soft spike golf shoes gives you greater shock absorption and cushioning. This helps your back in both the short and long term.

Preparation: Always make sure to stretch your muscles prior to and after a round of golf. We may be in a rush to reach the 19th hole, but it is important to cool our muscles down after a strenuous round.

Carrying your bag: Lugging your golf bag around the course adds a lot of unnecessary stress to your body. Elect to either drive a golf cart or else push your pull your bag using a golf bag cart.

Hydrate: Hydration is fundamental to success and safety in any sport. This is magnified when we are playing an outdoor sport during the summer. Drinking water helps decrease your risk of injury and fatigue when on the golf course.
