Women ages 50-74 – the group most at risk of developing breast cancer – will have local access to mammography services when the Alberta Health Services Screen Test program arrives in the community.

A mobile mammography

trailer will be stationed at Alexander First Nation Health Services on July 8 and 9, 2021. Appointments are required. Residents can book an appointment or learn more about the program by calling 1-800-667-0604.

Screen Test is improving access to cancer screening for hundreds of women in

Alberta communities where mammography is not readily available.

A mammogram is an X-ray of the breast and has proven to be the most effective way to detect breast cancer. Early detection allows for a greater number of options for treatment and a better chance of survival.

RCMP INVESTIGATE FIREARMS INCIDENT & SEEK DASH CAM FOOTAGE

On June 16, 2021, at approximately 7:30 p.m., Fox Creek RCMP received a 911 call of an erratic driver where a firearm had been involved in an interaction sometime between 7-7:30 p.m., in the area of Highway 43. Fox Creek RCMP with the assistance of RCMP Police Dog Service but were unable to locate a firearm believed to be used in this

incident.

On June 17, 2021, the Fox Creek RCMP with the assistance of Greenview Search and Rescue (SAR), conducted a search in a new location pertaining the outstanding firearm. The Greenview SAR was successful in locating the firearm—that was subsequently seized by police.

Fox Creek RCMP, at approximately 8:45 p.m., arrested a 29-year-old male, Blaine Clifford Landsverk, of Duffield,

Alta., and he is facing the following charges:

- Point a firearm
- Theft under \$5,000
- Unauthorized possession of a firearm
- Possession of a controlled substance (Cocaine)
- Mischief under \$5,000

Following a judicial hearing, Landsverk was released on cash bail with conditions;

however, was unable to meet bail and remains in custody awaiting his next scheduled appearing in Fox Creek Provincial Court on June 28, 2021.

Fox Creek RCMP are seeking dash cam footage from anyone who was in the area of Highway 43 and Little Smokey General Store on June 16, 2021, between the hours of 6:45 p.m. and 7:45 p.m.

EASING BORDER MEASURES FOR TRAVELLERS ENTERING CANADA

Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, wishes to advise that the first phase to easing border mea-

asures for travellers entering Canada begins on July 5, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. EDT. Fully vaccinated travellers who are permitted to enter Canada will not be subject to the federal requirement to quarantine or

take a COVID-19 test on day-8. In addition, fully vaccinated travellers arriving by air will not be required to stay at a government-authorized hotel.

EDSON MAINLINE EXPANSION PROJECT APPROVED WITH 25 CONDITIONS

OTTAWA: Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, is pleased to advise that Natural Resources Canada has announced approval of the NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL) Edson Mainline Expansion Project with 25 conditions. This decision was based on facts, science, Indigenous knowledge, the public interest and careful consideration of the concerns of potentially impacted Indigenous communities.

In addition to the 24 conditions recommended by the Commission of the Canada Energy Regulator (CER), the Government of Canada has added a new condition in direct response to concerns raised by Indigenous groups. The proponent is required to provide funding to Indigenous groups to support their active participation in the ongoing regulatory process and to report on its engagement with Indigenous groups. In total, the proponent must comply with 25 binding conditions related to safety, environmental and wildlife protection, and protection of Indigenous rights and interests. With the implementation of NGTL's environmental protection procedures, mitigation measures and conditions, the project is unlikely to cause adverse environmental effects.

This \$509-million project will create up to 1,470 jobs during construction and contribute approximately \$285 million to Alberta's GDP.

Golfer's **GUIDE**

9 WAYS TO IMPROVE YOUR GOLF GAME

Warmer weather sends scores of golfers to their favorite courses each and every day. Golf is a challenging pastime, but a few pointers can help golfers hone their short games, long games and everything in between.

- Choose the right clubs. There is more to selecting clubs than pulling any old iron out of your golf bag and whacking away. Wind, hazards and obstructions in landing areas should influence your decision of which club to use. Novice golfers may want to rely on their caddies to make club recommendations, and as they become more confident in their abilities they can start to make their own choices.

- Anchor your feet. Anchor your foot behind the ball to drive the ball further. Right-handed players will keep the right foot anchored, and lefties will do the opposite. Do not lift your foot prematurely; otherwise, you can lose power and distance.

- Identify your weaknesses. As with any hobby, identifying those

areas that need the most work can help you become a better golfer. Keep track of each shot you take, and then look at the results to see which areas of your game need the most work.

- Fix your alignment. Align your shots by assessing the target from behind the ball. Then set the clubface behind the golf ball and align it with the target before you enter your stance.

- Use your torso for power. The torso is essen-

tial to a solid swing. Practice rotating from your core to control your backswing and then maintain the same spine angle and posture on the downswing.

- Use the wind. Not every golf game will be played in perfect weather. A good player knows how to make adjustments for the wind depending on the shot. Use the wind to your advantage when you can, and adjust your swing when hitting into the wind.

- Become a better chipper. Many players put so much emphasis on their backswings and putt shots that they fail to devote any practice to chips. All shots are important for golfers trying to shed strokes off of their scores.

- Keep fit. Maintaining or improving your physical strength and overall health can help your golf game. Exercise and eat right, and you will have more endurance on the links.
