APPLICATIONS OPEN FOR 2021 INDIGENOUS INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY PROGRAM GRANTS

Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, wishes to advise applications for the 2021 Indigenous Intellectual Property Program grant is now open. This will provide greater opportunities for Indigenous peoples, including community organizations and Indigenous businesses, to build their intellectual property (IP) awareness and capacity, encourage use and participate in the development and implementation of related policies and programs in Canada and abroad.

The three funding streams for IIPP grants are:

1) Travel Stream
Grants for Indigenous organizations for travel to events, meetings, discussions and negotiations in Canada and abroad related to IP and IK and ICEs, up to \$5000 per person per organization for a single trip or up to \$15,000 per organization for multiple trips and/or multiple travelers in a funded year. Grants under this stream can fund required preparation work, travel costs, and registration fees.

2) Small-Scale Initiative Stream

Grants for IP-related activities, limited in scale and scope, duration and resources required, up to \$15,000. For example, these grants can fund activities such as a research project, drafting a policy paper, or developing educational materials and any eligible associated costs.

3) Project Stream

Grants for IP-related projects that are more complex or comprehensive than Small-Scale Initiatives, requiring more resources and a longer

duration and can include a combination of activities, up to \$50,000. These grants can fund multiple activities needed to carry out a project, including, but not limited to, related travel, research, development of resource material, event planning, business planning, etc.

Applications must be received by September 8, 2021 by 11:59pm.

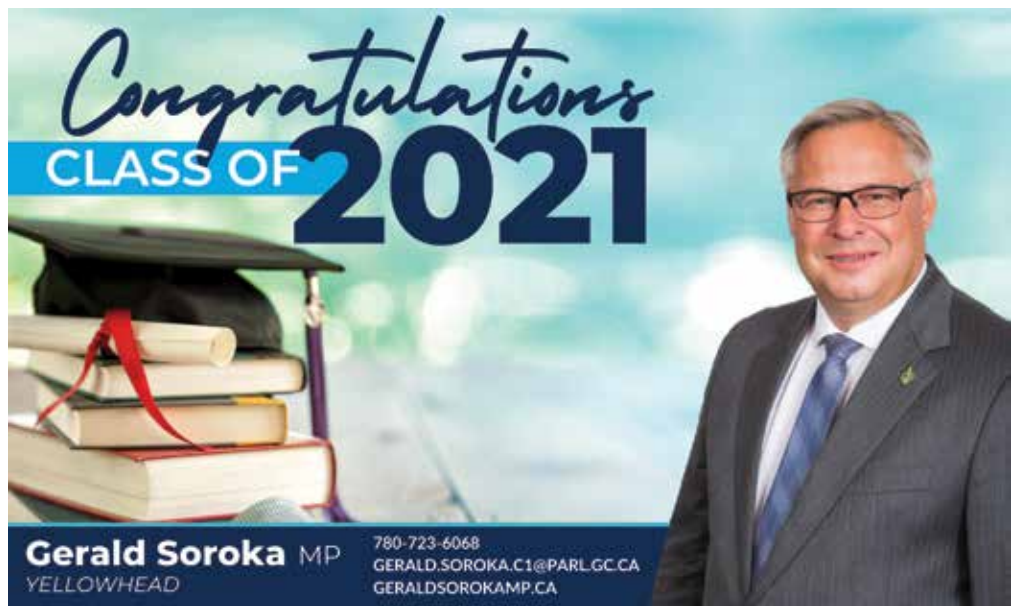

COVID-19 UPDATE FOR WHITECOURT

Submitted by Town of Whitecourt

Stage 3 of the Province's Open For Summer Plan starts on July 1. Alberta has hit the vaccination threshold set by the Province and all mandatory restrictions will be lifted, including the ban on indoor social gatherings. Isolation requirements for confirmed cases and protective measures in continuing care settings may remain. For more information please visit <https://www.alberta.ca/enhanced-public-health-measures.aspx>.

Masking may still be required in limited and specific settings, and the Government of Alberta will be sharing more details on this prior to the Stage 3 launch on July 1. The Town of Whitecourt Temporary Mask Covering Bylaw 1560 remains in effect, but will be discussed at the June 28, 2021 Regular Meeting of Council in light of the Province's announcement. Further information will be shared with the community as it is available.

Rotary Park's Whitecourt River Slides open July 1

With public health restrictions eased, the Whitecourt River Slides in Rotary Park will open for the 2021 summer season on Thursday, July 1. Operating guidelines remain the same as previous seasons:

• The facility will be open daily from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (weather permitting) as long as an outside air temperature of 16°C is reached. If the 16°C is not reached by 2:00 p.m., the slides will not open.

• The slides will be closed occasionally on Wednesdays from approximately 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon for maintenance. The slides will be open on these days when maintenance work is complete.

• The air filling station to fill tubes and floaties is located on the south side of the concession building.

All other amenities at Rotary Park, including the Splash Park and playground, are already open for the season. Concession services are offered daily from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (weather permitting).

Canada Day Fireworks will be moved to Graham Acres

With gathering restrictions lifted, the Canada Day fireworks will be moved to Graham Acres for public viewing. Originally the fireworks were scheduled to be set off from Eastlink Park and higher aerial fireworks were to be used. With gathering restrictions lifted, the most suitable location for this type of display, with the best seating option, is Graham Acres.

• Seating for fireworks will be available in the baseball fields and soccer practice field closest to the Golf Course entrance road.

• The Graham Acres parking lot will also be open for fireworks viewing.

Vaccine Information

All Albertans aged 12 and up are now eligible for second doses. If your first dose was an mRNA vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna), you can book your second dose 4 weeks after your first dose through Alberta Health Services (online or 811) or by contacting a participating pharmacy and physician clinic.

If you first dose was AstraZeneca, you can book your second dose 8 weeks after your first. You can choose which vaccine you get for your second dose:

- mRNA vaccine - book with Alberta Health Services online or a pharmacy
- AstraZeneca - book by calling Health Link 811

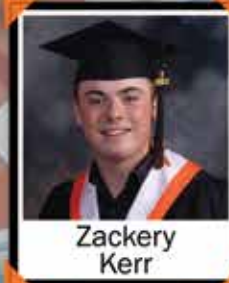
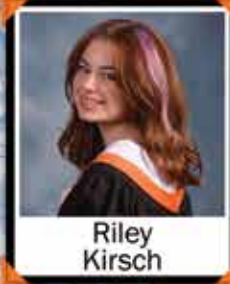
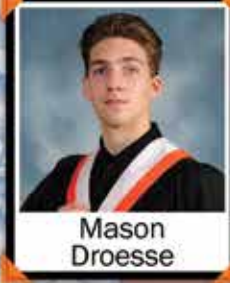

OTTAWA: Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, asked the following question today during Question Period.

He asked:

“Mr. Speaker, my constituents are very frustrated with the government’s handling of

the border. The government has insisted on forcing Canadians into hotel quarantine despite the Liberals’ own science expert panel recommending that the government scrap the program. These are the same hotels that have had reports of sexual assaults and lack of food and water.

On what date will the Liberals finally listen to the science

and end the hotel quarantine program?”

Reply:

Hon. Patty Hajdu (Minister of Health, Lib.): “Mr. Speaker, Canada has some of the strongest measures to protect against the importation of COVID-19. We have been guided by science and evidence and Canadians have made extraordinary sacrifices over the last

year and a half to protect each other. We will continue to use that science and evidence as we adjust the border measures, reflecting the best science and evidence and ensuring that we protect Canadians from another surge of COVID-19.”

FULL REFUNDS FOR SUNWING FLIGHTS CANCELLED

OTTAWA: Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, wishes to advise that Sunwing will be offering full customer refunds after reaching a deal with the Canada En-

terprise Emergency Funding Corp. allowing more customers to receive refunds.

Those with non-refundable bookings whose vacations were cancelled due to the pandemic, and who have received a future travel credit or travel vouchers, can now request a full refund or keep their travel

credit.

Future travel credits are available for travel up to Sept. 30, 2026.

To request a refund, eligible customers and travel agents must submit a request through an online COVID-19 refund request form by Aug. 27.

The new policy applies to

hotels, flights and vacation packages booked on or before Friday, June 25, 2021 for travel scheduled on or after Feb. 1, 2020.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO GRADE CROSSINGS REGULATIONS

Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, is pleased to advise that

Transport Canada has announced the publication of proposed amendments to Grade Crossings Regulations in the Canada Gazette, Part I,

for a 30-day public comment period.

The proposed amendments establish new compliance deadlines to meet the requirements of the Regulations based on the various levels of risks posed by grade crossings. This includes:

- a one-year extension for existing public grade crossings

which present a higher risk;

- a three-year extension for all remaining public and all private grade crossings; and

- an exclusion from the construction and maintenance requirements for very low-risk grade crossings (such as field-to-field crossings with minimal train traffic).

These proposed amendments

will ensure that the Grade Crossings Regulations are more effective in focusing the efforts of railway companies, public road authorities and private crossing owners on grade crossings that present the greatest risks to community safety.

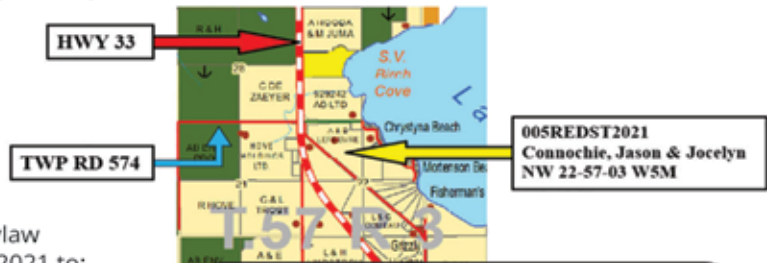

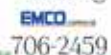
