...violence a way to get information about their partners so they can make informed choices about their safety.

- The right to ask: Anyone who feels suspicious or at risk about a partner or potential partner can apply to find out if their partner has a history of domestic violence, stalking or harassment, breach of no contact order or other relevant acts.

- The right to know: Po-

lice will now be able to disclose an individual's criminal record to people at risk, without an application, in an attempt to help prevent violence. For example, during a suspected domestic violence call, police can later contact the individual to inform them of their partner's abusive past.

- The right to privacy: The person of disclosure will not be told there was an application for information about them. People

can trust that their personal information will be protected and that only certain details will be disclosed to those who are authorized to receive it.

St. Albert RCMP Domestic Violence Unit, in conjunction with St. Albert Victim Services Unit, will educate clients about Claire's Law and provide direction on the application process. Regardless of any circumstance that may arise in the process, the Claire's Law program

will focus on providing information and support to the persons at risk so they can protect themselves.

BUSINESS SUPPORTS EXTENDED TO SUPPORT STRONGER ECONOMIC RECOVERY

Gerald Soroka Member of Parliament for Yellow-head wishes to advise the following extensions of support measures for Canadians and Canadian businesses:

1) Extending the eligibility period for the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy, the Canada Emergency Rent Subsidy and Lockdown Support until October 23, 2021 and

increasing the rate of support employers and organizations can receive during the period between August 29 and September 25, 2021.

2) Extending the Canada Recovery Benefit (CRB), the Canada Recovery Caregiving Benefit (CRCB), and the Canada Recovery Sickness Benefit (CRSB) until October 23, 2021.

3) Increasing the maximum number of weeks available for the CRB, by an additional 4 weeks,

to a total of 54 weeks, at a rate of \$300 per week, and ensuring it is available to those who have exhausted their employment insurance (EI) benefits.

4) Proposing to offer businesses greater flexibility when calculating the revenue decline used to determine eligibility for the wage and rent subsidy programs and the new Canada Recovery Hiring Program.

5) Draft legislation to provide further clarity on

previously announced changes to the wage subsidy for furloughed employees.

CANADA STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (CSFA)

Gerald Soroka Member of Parliament for Yellow-head wishes to advise that students under the new Canada Student Financial Assistance Program (CSFA), will have access to direct financial support through the form of Canada Student Grants (CSG), Canada Student Loans and Canada Apprentice Loans,

making it easier for them – as well as recent graduates – to pay off their student debt.

As of August 1, 2021, the Government is extending the doubling of CSG for an additional two years. This means that the maximum amount available for CSG will be up to \$6,000 for full-time students and \$10,000 for students with disabilities until July 31, 2023. The flexibility for students to use their cur-

rent year's income when applying for the CSG will be permanent so those in financial need will not have their previous workforce participation count against them.

Also, the waiver of interest accrual on student and apprentice loans has been extended to March 31, 2023.

Disability supports under the CSFA Program will be extended beyond recipients with life-long disabilities to recipi-

ents whose disabilities are persistent and prolonged. This will allow access up to \$22,000 in grants, in-study supports, and specialized repayment assistance on their loans.

As well, the Repayment Assistance Plan will be enhanced so that no one with an income of \$40,000 or less will have to make payments on their student loans.

Golfer's GUIDE

FIVE TOP GOLF TIPS TO HELP BOOST YOUR GAME

(NC) When it comes to golf, it's the little things that can have the biggest impact on your game. Whether it's your first attempt, or 10th season, golf expert Bob Weeks has got you covered at the links this summer with these five tips:

Choose the right clubs: Regardless of your experience or skill level, choosing the right equipment can be the difference between duffing it and striking the ball straight down the fairway. It's important to work with a professional to get the clubs best-suited to your

game and then, to have them custom fit. You should be fit for the length, loft, lie angle, shaft flex and even the grip size. If your clubs aren't custom fit, it will be like walking around in shoes that are the wrong size.

Get on the ball: Choose the right kind of golf ball for your game. While golf balls all look the same, it's what's inside that determines if it's right for you. Golf balls fall into two categories: distance or control. Distance balls are generally two-piece balls with a

large core and a cover. They are harder and better suited for higher handicappers or beginners. Control balls, usually three- or four-piece balls, are softer and spin more meaning they will land on the green and stop. More skillful players should use these.

Consider the elements: Weather is always a factor in golf and dealing with it must always be considered. For instance, in cold temperatures, the ball will travel shorter distances, so take more club. The opposite is true for warmer

temperatures. If you're playing into the wind, swing easy as that will keep the ball from spinning too much and rising up into the breezes. And downwind, make sure to judge the intensity of the breezes so you can choose the proper club. Your ball will roll further than normal on a downwind shot so take that into account.

Putting and chipping is priority: Lots of players like to boom their drives and will spend a lot of time on the range hitting their drivers. But if you want to improve your scores, you should spend more time working on your putting and chipping. Since most average players miss a lot of greens, the best way to save strokes is by chipping it close and making more putts. Focus more on your short game than your drive and you will improve.

Play the 19th hole: Win or lose, there's no better way to celebrate than hitting the 19th hole. Less is often more in golf and the same applies when considering what to eat and drink after a round.
