• Elections Canada offices will open soon in each of the 338 federal electoral districts. For complete information on the health and safety measures in place at Elections Canada offices, visit our website.

• Canadian citizens who are at least 18 years old on election day are eligible to vote.

• To vote, they must:

• Be registered. Most Canadians who are eligible to vote are already registered in the National Register of Electors. To

check if they are registered or register to vote, electors should use the Online Voter Registration Service at elections.ca, call us at 1-800-463-6868 or contact their local Elections Canada office. They can also register in person at their polling station when they go to vote.

• Show proof of their identity and address. There are many different pieces of ID that can be used to prove identity and address. The full list is available online.

• Given the ongoing pandemic, Elections Canada, in consultation with public health

authorities, has implemented a range of measures at polling places and Elections Canada offices to protect electors, election workers and political participants.

The 32-year-old male pedestrian, of Edmonton, was transported to a local hospital by STARS, with serious non-life threatening injuries.

Police are requesting additional information between 3 and 4 a.m., during the

morning of Aug. 15, at this specific location. Parkland County RCMP would like to speak with anyone who has not yet spoken with police regarding this incident, who has surveillance footage, dash camera recordings, witnessed this incident, or is able to potentially identify those who are responsible.

An RCMP Collision Analyst was engaged and is assisting in this investigation. Evidence seized on scene suggests the vehicle involved sustained damage to the front end.

Parkland County RCMP investigation is ongoing.

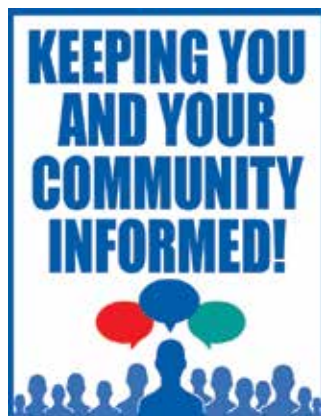

SUPPORTING TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS IN RURAL ALBERTA

Alberta's government is investing over \$1 million to support rural roads by upgrading bridges and culverts in the Lac St. Anne County, Parkland County and Brazeau County.

This money will help the counties complete various rural road projects through the Strategic Transportation Infrastructure Program (STIP).

• \$251,250 is going towards three culvert maintenance and design projects from the STIP fund in Parkland County

• \$262,500 will be invested in bridge maintenance, and the replacement of another

bridge; and, • \$521,250 will help replace pipes on two bridges in Brazeau County.

"I want to thank Transportation Minister, Rajan Sawhney, for approving these important projects for our rural communities. This will add around 10 jobs locally and we know how important it is in rural Alberta to have structurally sound roads and bridges. AGRIRECOVERY FUNDING

Once assessments are completed, work will be expedited to finalize an agreement with each province.

PARKLAND RCMP INVESTIGATE MOTORCYCLE FATAL COLLISION

On August 14, 2021 at about 10:50 PM, Parkland RCMP, Parkland Fire and EMS responded to a single vehicle motorcycle collision on the overpass of Range Road 40B (Wabamun Exit) and highway 16 west.

A male and female both in their 30's were on the motorcy-

cle and had exited off of highway 16 onto Range Road 40B heading west bound. Upon initial examination, it appears the male driver of the motorcycle failed to see a concrete median with signs at the intersection of the overpass. The driver reacted too late and lost control of the motorcycle causing both him and the female passenger to fall off while the motorcycle

was moving toward the median.

Emergency crews attempted to resuscitate the male driver however, he was pronounced deceased at the scene. The male driver was not wearing a helmet at the time, but the female was. The female passenger was stabilised and transported to hospital by EMS with non-life threatening injuries.
