# Online Renewals Make Life Easier For Albertans

...way we are making life easier for Albertans.”Tanya Fir, Associate Minister of Red Tape Reduction

To renew online, Albertans will log in with a verified account and will need to meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Be 18 to 75 years old to renew a driver’s licence or at least 18 years old to renew an ID card.
- Be a resident of Alberta.
- Have a driver’s licence that is not suspended.
- Not require changes to demographic information, such as address, height or sex, on

their driver’s licence or ID card.

- Have a card that has not been expired for more than six months.

- Not require a medical examination report to renew their driver’s licence.

- Have a photo and signature on the card that are less than 10 years old.

Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead, asked the following question in the House:

"Mr. Speaker, it is good to hear that the staff are working hard. It is too bad the government was not working as hard.

Kristen from Hinton mailed in her three sons' passports over two months ago and was still waiting for their passports to be renewed. After spending hours on the phone and taking two trips to Edmonton, which is three hours one way, she ended up having to pay for express service.

Will the NDP-Liberal government stop charging people more money to fix its backlogs, or does it need the money to pay for all the NDP-Liberal coalition promises?"

Reply:

Hon. Karina Gould (Minister of Families, Children and Social Development, Lib.):

"Mr. Speaker, as I have said, there is an unprecedented demand right now when it comes to passports. However, if all required documents have been submitted and Service Canada is outside service standards, the client will not be charged for expedited or transfer fees. This is not something that should be happening and, of course, if it is, I invite either MPs or citizens to follow up with Service Canada because they should be receiving their services without having to pay those expedited fees."

### NO ILLEGAL DUMPING

#### Rises in dumping are causing issues for the County

Everyday items such as bottles, cans and plastic soda rings can be fatal to unsuspecting wildlife. It also attracts rodents, birds, insects and other vermin while increasing the risks of ingestion of toxic substances.

On top of the natural issues that can occur, note that illegal dumping can also increase the risk of wildfire in the area. Dumping is illegal. Loitering and dumping can result in fines of \$1,000 (Bylaw 17-2021). If you see someone dumping, please note the vehicle description and license to contact Enforcement Services at Lac Ste. Anne County or contact your local RCMP.

## WHY WEEDS CAN BE FOUND EVERYWHERE

The ubiquitous nature of weeds can make them seem like they can grow anywhere, and that's because they can. Weeds can grow anywhere there's room for them to sprout, including gardens, sidewalks, driveways, and parking lots. One of the things that helps weeds spread so much is how productive they can be at producing seeds. An actively growing weed plant

will produce thousands of seeds and disperse those seeds throughout the season. One of the more recognizable weeds is the dandelion. During its growing season, a dandelion can effectively spread its seeds thanks in large part to the wind, which can blow seeds all over, thereby allowing a single dandelion to spread its seeds far and wide. Penn State Extension notes that

successful weed plants share many characteristics, including an ability to reproduce both sexually and asexually. Successful weed plants also are clever in terms of getting around, as their seeds can attach to people and animals and even float on water. Weeds also put up a fight when they're confronted by humans. Humans who try to pull weeds may instead break them. The bro-

ken weeds can then resprout, ultimately spreading their seeds again. The resiliency of weeds also is evident in their ability to stay dormant for long periods of time. For example, weeds can stay in the soil for years before germinating, proving that these unwelcome guests aren't just pesky, but also patient.

# WHITCOURT TOWN COUNCIL UPDATE

Submitted by Town of Whitecourt

Whitecourt Town Council passed Tax Rate Bylaw 1568 at the May 9, 2022 Regular Meeting of Council, and property owners can expect to receive combined assessment and taxation notices later this month. The 2022 Budget includes a 2.40% increase to the municipal tax rate. For details on how property taxes are calculated, and how tax dollars have been allocated in the 2022 Budget, please read the 2022

Budget Report. The report is available on the Whitecourt website at [www.whitecourt.ca/Government](http://www.whitecourt.ca/Government). If you have questions about your tax notice or the 2022 Budget, please contact the Town Office.

Town Council received an overview of 2022 assessment figures by the municipal assessor at the May 9 Council Meeting.

- The valuation date for 2022 taxation of properties is July 1, 2021.

- Assessment values for single family homes have

decreased by 0.6% in the valley; and 0.9% in the hill-top area. The average house value in Whitecourt is \$326,700.

- Property owners can view the assessment report for their property online. Visit the Whitecourt website at [www.whitecourt.ca/Services/Taxes-Assessment](http://www.whitecourt.ca/Services/Taxes-Assessment) and follow the link and instructions to view assessment reports.

- Property owners will receive a combined assessment and tax notice later this month.

Whitecourt Town Council has awarded \$30,000 in funding under the 2022 Enhancement Grant Program. Recipients include:

- Royal Canadian Legion Branch 44 - \$3,277.93 for the Darts Program Upgrades
- Whitecourt Taekwondo - \$10,600.50 for the Second Dojang Training Space

- Whitecourt Golf & Country Club - \$10,056.03 for the Driving Range

- Whitecourt Indigenous Friends Society - \$6,065.54 for Orange Shirt Day Round Dance

The Whitecourt Youth Advisory Committee is hosting Town Hall events at Percy Baxter Middle School and Ecole St. Joseph School on May 26, 2022. The event aims to increase students' knowledge and understanding of municipal government.

# SIX SEARCH WARRANTS OVER TWO DAYS SEES SIGNIFICANT SEIZURE AND CHARGES LAID

Submitted by Maskwacis RCMP

In June 2021, members of the Maskwacis General Investigation Section (GIS) became aware through criminal intelligence of illegal trafficking of substances into the four communities that make up Maskwacis. In the following months, Maskwacis GIS would conduct a complete and thorough investigation focusing on disrupting and dismantling the trafficking network.

Between Tuesday, May 17, 2022, and Wednesday, May 18, 2022, Maskwacis GIS executed six search warrants in a joint operation with the Maskwacis General Duty Members, the Maskwacis Community Policing (CPVS) unit, the Wetaskiwin GIS, the Wetaskiwin Crime Reduction Unit (CRU), the Central Alberta District GIS, and the Edmonton Police Service. These warrants were executed at a residence on the Ermineskin Cree Nation along with two residences, and a storage locker within the City of Edmonton, and finally two vehicles associated to the illegal trafficking network. As a result, police located and seized the following items:

- 50,000 illicit cigarettes, valued at \$44,000
- 17lbs of illegal Cannabis, with a street value of \$75,000
- 1200 unidentified pills
- 1 liter of Cannabis resin
- \$38,000 in cash proceeds

The seizure is valued at \$160,000. The investigation is still ongoing, and more charges are pending.

"This was a significant seizure of illegal substances, and without the help of our RCMP partners and the Edmonton Police Service this wouldn't have been possible; a big thank you them," says Cst. Guillaume Wilson of the Maskwacis RCMP. "We will continue working on identifying and arresting persons engaged trafficking illegal substances on the four nations of Maskwacis. We encourage the residents in our community to report any illegal activity to

police and assist us in disrupting criminal groups by calling the detachment, speaking to an officer, or providing tips through crime stoppers." Sali Khoshnaw a 32-year-old male from the City of Edmonton was charged with the following Criminal Code of Canada offences:

- Possession of property obtained by crime over \$5000
- Possession of unstamped tobacco products for the purpose of selling

- Fraud over \$5,000
- Khoshnaw also faces one count of unlawfully sell tobacco product that was not stamped, contrary to the Excise Act of Canada.

Leslie Dennehy a 35-year-old male from the City of Edmonton was charged with the following Cannabis Act offences:

- Possess cannabis for the purpose of distribution
  - Possess cannabis for the purpose of selling
- Dennehy also faces one

count of Unauthorized possession of a weapon, under the Criminal Code of Canada.

Both Khoshnaw and Dennehy were held for bail hearings, and released by a Justice of the Peace with conditions. Khoshnaw is scheduled to appear in Edmonton Provincial Court on Wednesday, June 15th, 2022, at 8:15 a.m., and Dennehy is scheduled to appear in Edmonton Provincial Court on Friday, June 10th, 2022 at 8:15 a.m.

# CRIME PREVENTION TIPS TO PROTECT YOUR PROPERTIES FROM SPRING BREAK AND ENTERS

No one wants a “spring break” and enter. This May, Alberta RCMP are offering tips for how Albertans can protect their residential, seasonal and outbuilding properties from break and enters and providing information on how to file a report in the event that they are victims of crime.

In 2021, 10,529 reports

of break and enters were reported in Alberta RCMP jurisdictions. By practicing good crime prevention and deterring would-be criminals, we can work to reduce this number.

In order for Albertans to have an a-May-zing spring, the RCMP are hoping some of the following tips help protect them from break and enters:

- As the weather turns warmer and individ-

uals begin to use seasonal tools and equipment, we recommend that they are extra careful not to leave expensive items lying around or in unlocked sheds or garages.

- Opportunity crimes are iris-istible to thieves. While no one invites thieves in, practicing good crime prevention can help keep properties safer. Updating locks, deadbolts or security

measures on buildings frequently, makes them difficult to break into.

- Thieves “lilac” buildings that are unsecured and unlocked. If possible, individuals may want to look into installing motion sensor lights or alarm systems and cutting away overgrown shrubs that block any sightlines.

- “Branch” out when it comes to property security! Installing alarm systems and motion sensor lights on properties and outbuildings are good ideas to deter criminals.

- Knowing that your property is as secure from thieves as possible is a re-leaf! If you find that your property has been stolen or any buildings have been broken into, we encourage you to contact your nearest RCMP detachment immediately to file a report regarding the matter.

# UPDATED DRAFT K-6 CURRICULUM READY FOR PILOTING

Submitted by Government of Alberta

School authorities can pilot three updated draft K-6 subjects with students in classrooms across the province this fall.

Alberta's government is continuing to take a balanced, phased approach to kindergarten to Grade 6 (K-6) curriculum renewal based on advice from the Curriculum Implementation Advisory Group. In September, classroom piloting for updated draft K-6 curriculum will begin with Science, French First Language and Literature, and French Immersion Language Arts and Literature.

"We have updated the draft K-6 Science, French First Language and Literature, and French Immersion Language Arts and Literature curriculums with insights we heard from this year's classroom piloting process and engagement with Albertans, including our francophone education partners and their communities. School authorities will have the opportunity to pilot these subjects with teachers and students to help us understand how the updated curriculum transfers to classrooms." Adriana LaGrange, Minister of Education

"I'm pleased that Minister LaGrange and Alberta Education have worked closely with francophone stakeholders, including Alberta's four francophone school authorities, to ensure that francophone

identity and perspectives are authentically reflected in the new draft K-6 curriculum." Dan Williams, MLA for Peace River and parliamentary secretary for la Francophonie

Classroom piloting

Alberta's government is providing maximum flexibility in how school authorities participate in optional classroom piloting of the updated draft curriculums. The piloting experience will include:

- supporting teachers with professional learning opportunities
- information and tools to work with the updated subjects in classrooms
- collecting feedback from teachers piloting the draft curriculums

By June 6, school authorities will identify their intent to participate in classroom piloting, including how many teachers are involved, the subjects and grade levels they will pilot.

While classroom piloting is underway, Albertans will also be able to provide feedback on the updated draft K-6 subjects. In spring 2023, the feedback from classroom piloting and Albertans will inform final updates to the three curriculums prior to province-wide implementation during the 2023-24 school year.

"The College of Alberta School Superintendents is appreciative of the opportunity for teachers to pilot draft curriculum. We are pleased that the government continues to seek feedback from experts in the field and believe that

piloting not only provides the government with valuable information but better prepares teachers for implementation." Wilco Tymensen, president, College of Alberta School superintendents and member of Curriculum Implementation Advisory Group

Content updates in the three subjects

The draft K-6 Science, French First Language and Literature, and French Immersion Language Arts and Literature curriculums were updated by considering all feedback from classroom piloting and engagement activities between March 2021 and March 2022. The content was also aligned with top-performing jurisdictions within Canada and internationally, as well as those jurisdictions with knowledge-rich curriculums. Updates included:

- Revisions and additions to the draft K-6 Science content to integrate scientific methods and hands-on activities, emphasize connections to nature and address digital literacy and ethics.
- Enhancements to the draft K-6 French First Language and Literature content will support the development of francophone identity through inclusion of francophone perspectives and cultures.
- Enhancements to the draft K-6 French Immersion Language Arts and Literature curriculum to strengthen francophone perspectives and culture, provide logical learning progressions, devel-

op effective and meaningful communication, and support critical thinking and language skills.

• Changes across the three K-6 subjects to address instances of concern with content load, age appropriateness, wording clarity and First Nations, Métis and Inuit content.

"Starting in September 2022, the four francophone school boards in Alberta will pilot this updated French first language and literature program. The Fédération des conseils scolaires francophones de l'Alberta (FCSFA) and the francophone school boards appreciate the openness shown by Alberta Education in recent months regarding the update of the curriculum. Teachers and educational consultants from the four boards had the opportunity to analyze the curriculum and to provide recommendations to Alberta Education." Tanya Saumure, president, Fédération des conseils scolaires francophones de l'Alberta

"We've been anticipating the modernization of the curriculum. The fact that the four francophone authorities are ready to pilot the subjects mentioned is reassuring. Learning French as a first language is of primary importance to parents and we are willing to work with the ministry, through school authorities, for implementation." 
