## LOCAL ELECTIONS, COUNCILLOR ACCOUNTABILITY: HAVE YOUR SAY

Submitted by Government of Alberta

A new online survey is asking Albertans about how to improve election processes and accountability for locally elected officials.

Input from the survey, open until July 22, will help inform potential changes to the Municipal Government Act (MGA) and the Local

Authorities Election Act (LAEA).

Alberta Municipal Affairs is seeking feedback from Albertans related to candidate eligibility, codes of conduct for elected officials, privacy of voter information and third-party advertising rules. Any changes would apply to Alberta municipalities, school divisions and Metis Settlements.

"As is always the case, we continually work to improve our local elections so that Albertans can feel confident when entering a polling station. I encourage all eligible Albertans to complete this short survey and have their say on how we can strengthen local democracy in Alberta."

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 692 of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of Lac Ste. Anne County is considering an application for amendment to Land Use Bylaw 22-2017, by amending the following through proposed Bylaw 22-2017-07-2022:

- Adding a new Section 11.2.100 as follows: Short term Rental Homes
- These new regulations will establish rules for the potential allowance of short term rentals. The limits will include:
  - Limit the maximum number of bedrooms in a Dwelling Unit used for a Short Term Rental Homes shall be four (4), with a maximum of two (2) guests per bedroom
  - No multiparcel subdivision shall be able to have Short Term Rentals operating in more than 30 % of the parcels within the named multiparcel subdivisions
  - Plus other restrictions on their general operation
- Short Term Rental Homes will be added as a Discretionary Accessory Use in the following districts:
  - Agricultural '1' (AG1), Agricultural 2 (AG2), Country Residential Ranch (CRR), Country Living Residential (CLR), Existing Country Residential (CRX), Country Residential 3 (CR3), Lakeside Residential (LR)

The proposed amendment and/or application may be reviewed during regular business hours at the County administration office located at 56521 Range Road 65 or on the County website at [LSAC.ca/Hearings](http://LSAC.ca/Hearings).

OK, so what all this fancy language means is that the County is considering allowing short term rentals like Air BnB's under certain circumstances within the County. So if you own land that is zoned/adjacent to land zoned Agricultural '1' (AG1), Agricultural 2 (AG2), Country Residential Ranch (CRR), Country Living Residential (CLR), Existing Country Residential (CRX), Country Residential 3 (CR3), Lakeside Residential (LR) there is potential that sometime in the future a Short Term Rental may be approved and start operation within the area.

## GOLF COURSES MANAGE PESTS TO PROTECT THEIR TURF

Golf courses are valuable green spaces in many communities, and the sport is enjoyed by Canadians of all ages.

We want our favourite course to be healthy, but this requires a lot of attention. Despite best efforts, sometimes golf courses are affected by pests. These can include turf diseases like dollar spot and snow mould, which affect normal growth of grass and can cause significant turf loss, according to experts. Turf insects feed on the grass and can inflict severe damage. Weeds are also a threat, because they compete with grass for moisture and affect the playability of a course.

To control pests, golf courses practice inte-

grated pest management, using the right tool at the right time to treat an infestation. This includes pesticides, which are regulated by Health Canada to ensure they are safe and effective in controlling the pests they are designed to target. They help maintain

healthy vegetation and playing surfaces, and also offer many environmental benefits.

Golf courses are often located in urbanized areas and can be valuable green spaces that help preserve habitats for wildlife and waterfowl. Data show that healthy

turf and trees act as natural air conditioners by producing large amounts of oxygen, while removing carbon dioxide. Did you know that healthy turf grass can sequester almost 900 kilograms of carbon per hectare each year?

Anne County, in the Province of Alberta, has given first reading to borrowing Bylaw No. 15-2022 which will, upon final passage and approval, authorize the proper officers of the said Lac Ste. Anne County to borrow monies from the Province of Alberta or an authorized financial institution by way of debenture issue, to pay for the cost of the following municipal purposes(s), namely the re-construction of Twp Rd 590 of four (4) miles within the limits of the said municipality.

The total cost of the aforesaid project amounts to \$1,200,000 which will be the net amount to be borrowed on the credit and security of Lac Ste. Anne County at large by the issue of debentures is ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,200,000). The debentures are to be repayable to the Province of Alberta or an authorized financial institution in twenty (20) equal consecutive semi-annual instalments of combined principal and interest, the annual interest not to exceed the interest rate as fixed from time to time by the Province of Alberta or an authorized financial institution, and not to exceed six (6.00%) percent.

**Information for Electors**

Pursuant to Section 1(i) of the Municipal Government Act an “elector” means:

A person who is eligible to vote in the election for a councillor under the Local Authorities Election Act.

Pursuant to section 47(1) of the Local Authorities Election Act, a person is eligible to vote in an election if the person:

- a. is at least 18 years old,
- b. is a Canadian citizen, and
- c. has resided in Alberta for the 6 consecutive months immediately preceding election day and is a resident in the area on election day.

A poll may be demanded in Lac Ste. Anne County by electors equal in number to at least 10% of the population of 10,260 (1,026 electors), in accordance with the provisions of section 223 of the Municipal Government Act and in accordance with the provisions of section 251 of the Municipal Government Act.

The petition for a vote must be received by the Chief Administrative Officer within 15 days of the last publication of this notice and shall contain on each page “an accurate and identical statement of the purpose of the petition”. (Further requirements of the petition are provided in section 224 of the Municipal Government Act).

Anne County to authorize a loan up to a maximum of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000) to the Onoway Curling Association, for the purpose of assisting with the Onoway Curling Rink Ice Plant Replacement project.

More criteria are listed in the request for expression of interest.

# GROUND BEEF AND PORK WILL NOT REQUIRE WARNING LABELS

Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead wishes to advise that Health Canada has exempted ground beef and pork from

front-of-package labelling.

"We Conservatives called for ground beef and pork to be exempt from front-of-package labelling. It didn't make sense if roast beef and whole hams are exempt, but the same source of protein

is no longer acceptable after being ground. I was pleased to hear that Health Canada has listened," said MP Soroka.

These regulations will require a new symbol to be displayed on the front of

packaged foods that are high in saturated fat, sugars and/or sodium. Manufacturers have until January 1, 2026, to change their labels and comply with the new requirement.
