### FATAL COLLISION ON HIGHWAY 43

Stony Plain RCMP have completed the scene examination and the roads were reopened July 10, 2022, at 1:15 a.m.. Stony Plain RCMP would like to thank the public for their patience while

the scene examination was conducted.

The initial investigation indicates that a motorcycle was westbound on Hwy. 43 approaching the intersection with Hwy. 33. A southbound car entered the intersection and collided with the motorcycle. The motor-

cyclist, a 65 year old male from Sangudo was pronounced deceased at the scene. Two occupants from the car were transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

## TWO NEW RAIL SAFETY MEASURES ANNOUNCED

Gerald Soroka, Member of Parliament for Yellowhead wishes to advise that two new rail safety measures have been announced:

- One focusing on railway-related fire prevention
- Another focusing on improving the resiliency of Canada's railway infrastructure against flooding, landslides, or fire

These new rules require railway companies to:

• Reduce train speeds and perform extra track inspections during high temperatures to reduce derailment risks caused by track conditions.

• Inspect locomotive exhaust systems more frequently to ensure that there are no hazardous deposits that could pose a fire risk

• Implement a fire risk reduction plan.

## REEVE'S REPORT ON THE UPCOMING PAPAL VISIT AND PILGRIMAGE

*The Lac Ste Anne Pilgrimage is a one-of-a-kind gathering that has drawn hundreds of thousands of visitors to our sacred lake each summer for the past 123 years.*

*With the presence of His Holiness Pope Francis, attendance at this year's event is certain to be on an entirely different scale. While this is a truly historic occurrence — both for the devout and the County at large — it does require focused and coordinated effort from multiple stakeholders. Here are some highlights on how things are taking shape.*

### STAKEHOLDERS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

To be clear: Council and Administration had no prior knowledge of the papal visit, nor the authority to say no to its occurrence. Further, an event of this magnitude takes about two years to properly plan (rather than the two months we were given). Regardless, the County is committed to making this event as safe and memorable as possible while minimizing any negative impacts on our communities.

To help achieve these outcomes, the County is part of a larger group that includes:

- Alberta Health Services and EMS
- Alberta Transportation
- Alexis Nakota Sioux Nation
- Catholic Archdiocese of Edmonton
- Government of Alberta
- Lac Ste. Anne Pilgrimage
- Metis Association of Alberta
- Provincial Office of the Papal Visit
- Royal Canadian Mounted Police

In addition to working closely with these organizations, the County has reached out to adjacent municipalities for their support with policing, signage, emergency services and logistics. I am grateful for their camaraderie and willingness to help.

### PILGRIMAGE AND PAPAL VISIT SCHEDULE

The Lac Ste. Anne Pilgrimage is scheduled to place July 26-29. Pope Francis has been confirmed to attend the Lac Ste. Anne Pilgrimage for one hour on July 26 after hosting an open-air mass at Edmonton's Commonwealth Stadium that same day.

## ROUTES, TRAFFIC AND ROAD CLOSURES

The County is primarily taking direction from Alberta Transportation and the RCMP regarding approved routes for traffic, park-and-rides to the pilgrimage site, road closures and other logistical details.

Residents should factor in considerable traffic congestion on provincial highways and County roadways before, during and after the pilgrimage. It goes without saying that pedestrian traffic will be unusually high at the pilgrimage site and in surrounding communities. Throughout this timeframe the County will prioritize public safety, and will work to mitigate any harm to property or our environment.

For anyone planning to circumvent traffic via back roads or summer villages: **this will not happen**. There will be no access to the pilgrimage grounds via Val Quentin, Sunset Point, Alberta Beach or any other non-approved route. These roadways will be reserved for local traffic only.

## MAPS, SCHEDULES AND UPDATES

Here you'll find approved routes, road closures, boat launch closures, bus shuttle schedules and other important event details. Most of this information will be County-generated, but we will also share any relevant information provided by other stakeholders.

To find out what's taking place in other communities, I encourage you to contact the administration offices of Alberta Beach, Sunset Point, West Cove and Val Quentin — or visit their respective websites.

## FINAL THOUGHTS

Lac Ste. Anne County and its neighbouring municipalities recognize the importance of reconciliation. The wisdom, tradition and pride of Indigenous communities are woven into the social fabric of our communities, adding to the rich history of the Lac Ste. Anne region. Because of these influences, we are keenly aware of the importance of this visit. We understand what it means to our communities going forward, and the legacy it will leave behind.

Speaking on behalf of Lac Ste. Anne County Council and Administration as well as neighbouring municipal leaders, I sincerely thank local families and business owners in advance for their patience and understanding during this important — yet impactful — historic spiritual gathering. I also want to commend all staff involved for going above and beyond to provide for the safety and security of visitors and community members alike.

# WHITECOURT TOWN COUNCIL UPDATE

Whitecourt Town Council has adopted the 2022 Strategic Plan. The Plan provides Council and staff with a common focus to be pursued over its term to achieve the municipality's vision. The Town will use the Strategic Plan to define its priorities, activities, short and long-term plans; and, to prioritize budget and resource allocations. A copy of the 2022 Strategic Plan Report is available for viewing at [www.whitecourt.ca/your-municipality](http://www.whitecourt.ca/your-municipality).

The 2022 20-Year Capital and Major Maintenance Plan has been adopted. The Plan, which includes 130 projects, provides a vision for the long-term development of Whitecourt's infrastructure; land development; parks and trails; and building and recreational/cultural facilities to meet the needs of our

growing community. The Plan incorporates projects and timelines identified through engineering studies, planning sessions, workshops, budget deliberations, and public engagement activities. The Plan is available to view at [www.whitecourt.ca/your-municipality](http://www.whitecourt.ca/your-municipality).

The Whitecourt Economic Development Committee provided a semi-annual update on its activities and current projects at the June 27 Regular Meeting of Council. Activities have been focused on encouraging investment attraction across key sectors and implementing business retention and expansion strategies in support of local businesses.

The annual review of Off-Site Levies is complete and, based on the study, rates will be changing as of January 1, 2023.

Off-Site Levies are a cost recovery tool that help pay for infrastructure projects

that allow the community to grow, including roads, and water and sewage treatment.

- Single Family Dwelling Units \$4,375/dwelling unit \$4,586/dwelling unit

- Multi-Family Dwelling Units \$1,906/dwelling unit \$1,997/dwelling unit

Non-Residential \$50,983/hectare \$53,446/hectare

The Collision Report is prepared annually, and the 2021 report shows an overall increase in collisions from the previous year; however, the number of collisions is still under the 5-year average. The report identifies areas of concern so that measures can be undertaken to assist with decreasing collisions and injuries on local roadways. A copy of the report will be provided to the Whitecourt Protective

Services Committee and Alberta Transportation for review.

Whitecourt is partnering with other regional municipalities to apply for funding to develop an electric vehicle charging network in northwest Alberta.

Whitecourt has approved requests from the Whitecourt Golf & Country Club and Whitecourt Curling Club to join the Alberta Municipalities Energy Program. By joining through Whitecourt's energy agreement, the Clubs will benefit from the wholesale and aggregate pricing that Whitecourt receives.

Updates have been made to the Fees, Rates and Charges Bylaw.

• Water meter costs have been amended to align with the Town's third party billing policy.

• Concrete disposal fees have been updated to reflect current crushing and disposal costs.

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of Lac Ste. Anne County, in the Province of Alberta, has given first reading to borrowing Bylaw No. 15-2022 which will, upon final passage and approval, authorize the proper officers of the said Lac Ste. Anne County to borrow monies from the Province of Alberta or an authorized financial institution by way of debenture issue, to pay for the cost of the following municipal purposes(s), namely the re-construction of Twp Rd 590 of four (4) miles within the limits of the said municipality.

The total cost of the aforesaid project amounts to \$1,200,000 which will be the net amount to be borrowed on the credit and security of Lac Ste. Anne County at large by the issue of debentures is ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,200,000). The debentures are to be repayable to the Province of Alberta or an authorized financial institution in twenty (20) equal consecutive semi-annual instalments of combined principal and interest, the annual interest not to exceed the interest rate as fixed from time to time by the Province of Alberta or an authorized financial institution, and not to exceed six (6.00%) percent.

**NOW THEREFORE NOTICE** is hereby given by the Council of Lac Ste. Anne County that, unless a petition of the electors for a vote on Bylaw 15-2022 is demanded, as provided for by the terms of Section 231 of the Municipal Government Act, the said Council may pass the said borrowing Bylaw.

All persons interested are hereby notified and they are required to govern themselves accordingly.

### Information for Electors

Pursuant to Section 1(i) of the Municipal Government Act an “elector” means:

A person who is eligible to vote in the election for a councillor under the Local Authorities Election Act.

Pursuant to section 47(1) of the Local Authorities Election Act, a person is eligible to vote in an election if the person:

- a. is at least 18 years old,
- b. is a Canadian citizen, and
- c. has resided in Alberta for the 6 consecutive months immediately preceding election day and is a resident in the area on election day.

A poll may be demanded in Lac Ste. Anne County by electors equal in number to at least 10% of the population of 10,832 (1,083 electors), in accordance with the provisions of section 223 of the Municipal Government Act and in accordance with the provisions of section 251 of the Municipal Government Act.

The petition for a vote must be received by the Chief Administrative Officer within 15 days of the last publication of this notice and shall contain on each page “an accurate and identical statement of the purpose of the petition”. (Further requirements of the petition are provided in section 224 of the Municipal Government Act).

**BYLAW 16-2022 TO AUTHORIZE AN INTEREST FREE LOAN**

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of Lac Ste. Anne County to authorize a loan up to a maximum of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000) to the Onoway Curling Association, for the purpose of assisting with the Onoway Curling Rink Ice Plant Replacement project.

The rate of interest on the loan to the Association shall be zero (0%) percent.

The issuance of the loan shall be provided subject to the Association and the County executing security documentation satisfactory to the County.

The loan shall be issued in such a manner that the principal is payable in, as nearly possible, equal instalments over a maximum period of ten (10) years.

Anne County by electors equal in number to at least 10% of the population of 10,832 (1,083 electors), in accordance with the provisions of section 223 of the Municipal Government Act and in accordance with the provisions of section 251 of the Municipal Government Act.

The petition for a vote must be received by the Chief Administrative Officer within 15 days of the last publication of this notice and shall contain on each page "an accurate and identical statement of the purpose of the petition". (Further requirements of the petition are provided in section 224 of the Municipal Government Act).
