## ALBERTA RCMP MAJOR CRIMES UNIT INVESTIGATE HOMICIDE IN MASKWACIS

On Nov. 5, 2022, at 4:22 a.m., Maskwacis RCMP responded to a gun complaint in the Samson Cree Nation in the Samson town site. Upon arrival, officers located a victim with serious injuries. Unfortunately, despite rescue efforts by responding officers and Emergency Medical Services, the victim was pronounced deceased. The Alberta RCMP Major Crimes Unit was dispatched and has taken carriage of the investigation.

The victim has been identified as 19-year-old Maskwacis resident Riley Evan Bull.

The victim has been taken to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner where an autopsy will be performed on Nov. 8, 2022.

# ALBERTA SCHOOL BUS DRIVER SHORTAGE AT CRISIS LEVEL

Our children could be left out in the cold this winter

Government regulations and lack of funding is a big part of the problem

Every day there are 146,000 Alberta school children and their parents who rely on buses to get safely to and from school.

"Every day, there are fewer busses available and fewer certified operators to drive them." says Mark Critch, president of the ASBCA.

The major crises presently, is the shortage of certified drivers, with areas in the province reporting up to 30% less drivers than are required for adequate service.

Where are all the certified drivers? Bus drivers must complete the Alberta Ministry of Transportation's MELT driver training certification, which ensures that drivers are qualified and competent to drive. The 3 to 4 week course is mandatory for new drivers, costing applicants up to \$5000. They are unpaid for the duration of the course and application process. Following the course, there is a waiting period for scheduling a road exam. There are delays due to a shortage of certified instructors, as well as delays in the processing of certificates. Altogether, it can take up to six weeks of unpaid training time before a prospective driver can even get behind the wheel. Certified drivers will be looking at a

part time job paying as low as \$16.50/hour; and will be taking on the responsibility of driving kids to and from school in all types of road/weather conditions.

With the shortage of school busses and drivers, Alberta children are being put at serious risk. If a school bus is late, or worse doesn't show, for whatever reason (driver shortage, bus shortage, inclement weather), kids are being impacted by having to wait outside, in various weather conditions. They are at risk of losing valuable learning time, which will impact them for years to come.

"One bus that is 30 minutes late daily, carrying 40 kids, equals 1200 lost minutes per day. Multiply this by 200 buses across

the province and that is 240,000 lost instructional minutes per day" says Mark Critch, ASBCA

The Alberta Ministries of Education and Transport could easily work together to solve this issue.

They can reallocate the funds that are desperately needed to fund and assist school bus contractors and their drivers. Financially incentivize people to consider getting trained to become a neighbourhood school bus driver. Who should be expected to pay \$5000 for a course, to certify them for a part-time job paying minimum wage?

## Black Knot | Info & Pruning Guideline



### Black Knot - What Is It?

Yellowhead County's Agricultural Services Department has received numerous calls regarding black growths on residents' fruit trees.

These tar-like black swellings are a sign of Black Knot and will distort and stunt any tree species within the *Prunus* genus.

Black Knot reduces the aesthetic value of affected trees and, if left long enough, may result in eventual death of the tree.

The disease spreads in the spring, attacking new growth on branches. The spores released by the fungi can be carried by wind and splashing rain.

**The only reliable method of controlling Black Knot is pruning.**

### Black Knot - Pruning


1. Only prune between November and March.
2. Cleanly cut off at least 6 - 8 inches below the knot, better to prune back to a healthy collar, then leaving a stub.
3. For knots on branches or trunks that can't be removed, use a knife to cut away diseased tissue down to good wood and then 1/2 inch beyond the edge of the knot.
4. Cleaning your equipment properly is another good way to prevent the spread. Pruning shears should be dipped in a 1% bleach/water solution between cuts and once you are finished pruning ensure you run your tools under water for 10 minutes and dry thoroughly.
5. Treat pruned branches like hazardous waste, they can release spores for up to 4 months. Burn, bury, or wrap them in plastic and throw them in the trash. Do not compost.

One of the study's purposes is to "examine how governments could act to combat grocery price increases by way of greater competition in this industry."

The final report is expected to be published in June 2023.

reau invites stakeholders to provide submissions—either in writing or via oral interviews with Bureau staff—both in respect of the study questions and any other matters relevant to retail grocery competition in Canada. All written submissions will be made public and posted on the

Bureau's website in the language provided unless it is specifically requested that they be kept confidential.

# MLA MARK SMITH ARTICLE

Alberta's economy continued to move in the right direction in October.

According to Statistics Canada's latest labour force survey, Alberta created 14,000 new full-time jobs in October, marking the creation of approximately 80,000 new jobs since the beginning of 2021. This is the strongest job growth in the country.

The policies of our United Conservative government are working to create jobs and investment in constituencies like Drayton Valley-Devon. By introducing the job creation tax cut, cutting red tape, and keeping taxes low for families and businesses, we continue to do all we can to make Alberta the best place in the country to live, work, play, start a business, and raise a family.

# ALBERTA RCMP MAJOR CRIMES UNIT INVESTIGATE HOMICIDE NEAR BRETON

On Oct. 17, 2022, Breton RCMP received a report requesting a welfare check on a male at a rural property in Brazeau County. Upon arrival, officers spoke to and arrested a male on outstanding warrants.

After conducting a search of the property, RCMP located a deceased male. The Alberta RCMP Major Crimes Unit was called to investigate. The deceased has been identified as 67-year-old Robert Charles Marshall, a resident of Brazeau County.

On Oct. 19, 2022, an autopsy was conducted by the medical examiner who determined the manner of death is a homicide.

As a result of the investigation, RCMP have charged Shane Allen Marshall (37), a resident of Rimbey, with second degree murder.

Shane Marshall was taken before a Justice of the Peace where he was remanded in custody with his next appearance set for Nov. 9, 2022, at Breton Provincial Court.

As this matter is now before the courts, RCMP are not able to comment further.

Getting immunized against influenza and COVID-19 is the best way to protect yourself and your community. Vaccines help make your immune system stronger and help build antibodies.

Keeping the number of influenza cases and outbreaks low can help protect ourselves as

well as at-risk Albertans and reduce the pressure on our healthcare system.

Influenza is an infection of the nose, throat, and lungs that is caused by a virus. Symptoms start suddenly and may include:

- a fever and chills
- a sore throat or cough
- a headache
- muscle aches
- poor appetite

• feeling tired

Other symptoms may include feeling sick to your stomach (nausea), vomiting (throwing up), or having loose stool (diarrhea). These symptoms are more common in young children. In some cases, influenza can lead to a lung infection (pneumonia) or make other health problems worse. Even healthy, young people can get very sick or die from influenza.

It is important to get the influenza vaccine each year if you:

- have a high risk for influenza
- have close contact with someone who has a high risk, such as family members and caregivers

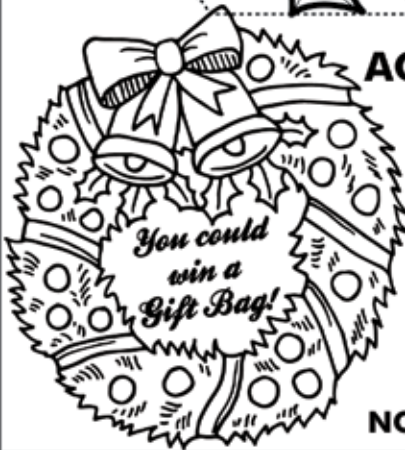

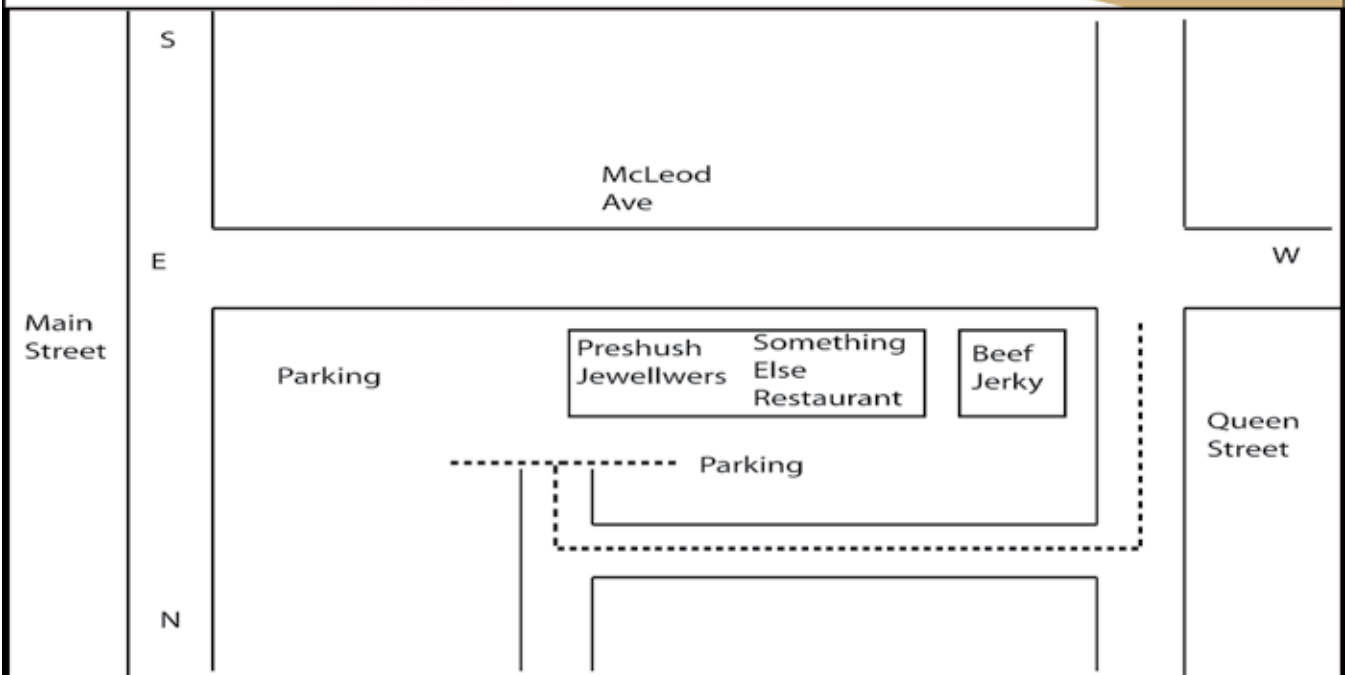
