prepared and served Anne-liese & crew.

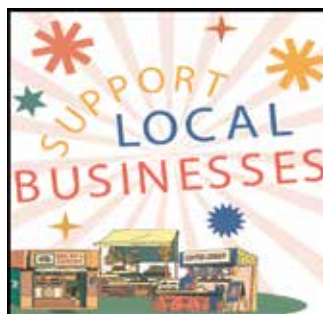

velopment responsibilities within the Town of Jasper, and how the Municipality of Jasper and Parks Canada could work together in the delivery of these services. Following consultations, a 'What We Heard Report' will be published summa-

rizing the feedback received and will outline the next steps for Parks Canada to respond to the Municipality of Jasper's request.

SOLID WASTE UTILITY NOTICES

Will be mailed out in early April

The Solid Waste Utility was created to make billing of this essential service equal for everyone who owns residential properties within Lac Ste. Anne County.

The 2023 Solid Waste Fee is due upon receipt of the bill. Any unpaid utilities amounts, as of July 1, 2023, are subject to a penalty of 3.5%.

BE PREPARED FOR ROAD BANS

Seasonal Road Bans will come into effect in the near future!

A friendly reminder that Seasonal Road Bans usually come into effect the last week of March continuing until approximately early-June.

Lac Ste. Anne County is responsible for the preservation and maintenance of all municipal roads, highways and bridges within the County which are under its direction, control and management.

A very important part of this responsibility is the protection against unnecessary degradation of our roadways during spring thaw.

What to expect when Road Bans are put in place:

- Road Ban information/restrictions are posted on our customary media channels.

- Reduced weight percentage signs are placed on all oiled and paved roadways.

- A 75% weight restriction is placed on all gravel surfaces. Posting signage on all of these roadways is cost prohibitive therefore it is the user's responsibility to check and know when reduced weight restrictions are in place.

- Lac Ste. Anne County Enforcement Services will be actively educating and ensuring compliance.

TAX PREPAYMENT PLAN

Make monthly property tax payments instead of an annual lump sum!

Property owners can enroll in this program at any time, however your tax account must not be in arrears to be eligible for the plan.

SECTION 251 – The *Municipal Government Act*

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of Lac Ste. Anne County, in the Province of Alberta, has given first reading to borrowing Bylaw No. 08-2023 which will, upon final passage and approval, authorize the proper officers of the said Lac Ste. Anne County to borrow monies from the Province of Alberta or an authorized financial institution by way of debenture issue, to pay for the cost of the following municipal purposes(s), namely the construction of a Wastewater Transmission Line from Darwell to Tri-Village.

The total cost of the aforesaid project amounts to \$11,820,000. After deducting from this cost the amount of \$10,620,000 to be received by way of the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP) Green Infrastructure Stream Grant, the net amount to be borrowed on the credit and security of Lac Ste. Anne County at large by the issue of debentures is \$1,200,000. The debentures are to be repayable to the Province of Alberta or an authorized financial institution in fifty (50) equal consecutive semi-annual installments of combined principal and interest, the annual interest not to exceed the interest rate as fixed from time to time by the Alberta Finance, and not to exceed seven (7.00%) percent.

NOW THEREFORE NOTICE is hereby given by the Council of Lac Ste. Anne County that, unless a petition of the electors for a vote on Bylaw 08-2023 is demanded, as provided for by the terms of Section 231 of the *Municipal Government Act*, the said Council may pass the said borrowing Bylaw.

All persons interested are hereby notified and they are required to govern themselves accordingly.

Information for Electors

Pursuant to Section 1(i) of the *Municipal Government Act* an "elector" means:

A person who is eligible to vote in the election for a councillor under the *Local Authorities Election Act*.

Pursuant to Section 47(1) of the *Local Authorities Election Act*, a person is eligible to vote in an election if the person:

- a. is at least 18 years old,
- b. is a Canadian citizen, and
- c. has resided in Alberta for the 6 consecutive months immediately preceding election day and is a resident in the area on election day.

A poll may be demanded in Lac Ste. Anne County by electors equal in number to at least 10% of the population of 11,300 (1,130 electors), in accordance with the provisions of Section 223 of the *Municipal Government Act* and in accordance with the provisions of Section 251 of the *Municipal Government Act*.

The petition for a vote must be received by the Chief Administrative Officer within 15 days of the last publication of this notice and shall contain on each page "an accurate and identical statement of the purpose of the petition". (Further requirements of the petition are provided in Section 224 of the *Municipal Government Act*).

INDICATORS IT'S TIME TO CHANGE AIR FILTERS

Vehicle maintenance can protect drivers' investments and help their automobiles run efficiently.

One area drivers should pay particular attention to is their vehicles' air filters. When operating at optimal

capacity, an air filter improves fuel efficiency while ensuring vehicles accelerate smoothly without taxing the engine. But when air filters are clogged, fuel efficiency is reduced and emissions are increased, a 1-2 punch that costs motorists money and hurts the planet at the same time. Drivers can check their owners' manuals to determine the recommended intervals to replace air filters, but the following are a handful of indicators that suggest it's time to change them.

less you just purchased your vehicle, you likely know how many miles you can drive on a full tank of gas. If that gas mileage is suddenly slipping and you find yourself visiting the filling station more frequently, then it might be time to replace your air filter.

Engine light: Drivers may be alerted to engine issues when the "Check engine" lights up on the vehicle's dashboard. This light may come on to indicate a problem with the air filter,

Indicators It's Time To Change Air Filters

as clogged air filters reduce air flow to the engine, resulting in an imbalanced air-fuel mixture that adversely affects the engine.

- Starting and idling problems: Vehicles sometimes don't start up as smoothly as they once did, and drivers may also notice vehicles are not idling smoothly. These symptoms may indicate misfiring spark plugs that are being polluted (and made less effective) by a dirty air filter that is reducing the flow of air to the engine.

- Acceleration diffi-

culties: Automobiles that are operating at peak capacity accelerate quickly. But dirty, worn out air filters adversely affect acceleration. Drivers who notice that their cars are struggling to accelerate when stoplights turn green or on highways may need to replace their vehicles' air filters.

- Dirty air filter: Perhaps the biggest indicator that an air filter needs to be replaced is the filter itself. If you cannot find the air filter on your own, consult your vehicle owner's manual to determine where it

is. Once you find the air filter, examine it in broad daylight. Clean air filters are white, so if the filter has

darkened, it may need to be replaced.
