Our population now at 40 million continues to grow. The housing shortage has caused prices to skyrocket, leaving those looking to buy a home losing hope in their ability to afford one. Conservatives will get out of the way of municipalities so that they can build houses. We will tie Federal Infrastructure Funding to the number of homes being built. By doing so, Conservatives will bring down the cost of housing while also creating jobs.

The additional Energy Tax imposed on July 1st by the Liberals will continue to drive up the price of groceries. # CENTRAL ALBERTA DISTRICT RCMP CRIME REDUCTION UNIT ARREST AND CHARGE REPEAT OFFENDER

On June 22, 2023, at approximately 8:30 a.m., officers of the Crime Reduction Unit were conducting proactive checks on prolific property offenders in the area of Buck Lake. Officers observed a pickup truck matching the description of a vehicle reported stolen and previously fleeing from police. After initiating a traffic stop, the driver fled, however, he was later arrested at a property near

Winfield.

A search warrant was executed at a related property in Wetaskiwin County where several items, including those reported stolen from Winfield Fire Department, were recovered or seized, including:

- Hydraulic pump system and hydraulic hoses used in a "Jaws of Life" rescue system
- Makita gas-powered cut off saw
- Stolen Dodge truck
- Stolen holiday trailer
- 3.5 ounces of suspected

methamphetamine

•A machete

Murlin Scott Becker (40), a resident of Buck Lake, has been charged with numerous offences, some of which include:

- Possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose
- Obstructing a peace officer
- Possession of property obtained by crime over \$5,000 (x3)

After a judicial interim release hearing, Becker was remanded into custody and will be appearing in Alberta

Court of Justice in Breton on July 26, 2023.

Winfield Fire Chief Barry Clarkson states, "Not only has this impacted our ability to provide life-saving rescue services since this equipment went missing, the re-certification process for the bit of gear that was recovered will take time. Most of us are volunteers, so the frustration with acts like this, especially when it complicates our ability to conduct rescue operations, is significant."

## CONFIRMED HEPATITIS A CASE PROMPTS PUBLIC ALERT IN EDMONTON ZONE

Alberta Health Services

(AHS) has confirmed a case of hepatitis A in a food han-

dler working at a McDon-

ald's in Nisku (301 20th St.). Patrons who consumed food or drink from this location between June 20-23, 2023 from 7 a.m. to 11 a.m. and June 24, 2023 from 7 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. may have been exposed to hepatitis A.

"While we believe the risk to the public is low, hepatitis A is a serious infection," says Dr. Christopher Sikora, Medical Officer of Health, AHS – Edmonton Zone. "As a precaution, anyone who consumed food or drink at this location is advised to monitor themselves and their family for symptoms until August 13, 2023, and take advantage of getting immunized as a way to prevent illness."

There is no ongoing risk of infection associated with the above location. It has been inspected and approved as safe to operate by AHS Environmental Public Health inspectors.

Hepatitis A is an infection of the liver caused by a virus. Individuals primarily contract hepatitis A through direct contact with an infected person; however, individuals can also contract the illness indirectly by ingestion of contaminated food or water. If an infected individual does not properly wash his/her hands after using the washroom, the virus can be transmitted through food and

beverages prepared by the infected individual.

Illness can occur within 15 to 50 days after exposure to the virus, but usually does so within 28 to 30 days. Individuals can be infectious one to two weeks before symptoms occur until at least one week after the onset of illness.

Symptoms of hepatitis A may include: tiredness; poor appetite; nausea and vomiting; abdominal pain and fever; followed by dark-coloured urine, light-coloured stools, and yellowing of eyes and skin several days later. Some people, espe-

cially young children, may get hepatitis A infection without noticing any symptoms; however, they are still infectious to others.

Individuals who develop such symptoms between July 1, 2023 and August 13, 2023 are advised to immediately contact Health Link at 1-866-301-2668.

Individuals who have had hepatitis A infection in the past or who have previously received an appropriate series of hepatitis A vaccine are not at risk of infection.

There is no specific treatment for hepatitis A, but it can be prevented through immunization. For more information visit Hepatitis A

(HAV) Vaccine.

Only those who visited McDonald's on the dates and times listed above are considered potentially exposed. Those who meet the criteria can call Health Link at 1-866-301-2668 to book an immunization appointment during the following days & times. In this instance, a prophylaxis vaccine will protect those at risk of infection against this exposure.

### BRIDGE REPAIRS Sturgeon River at HWY 777

A reminder that Alberta Transportation is undertaking repairs to this bridge. As they work on replacing girders, an end date for this construction is unknown.

### BLUE-GREEN ALGAE ADVISORY

#### In Place for Area Lakes

Affected lakes include Lac Ste. Anne, Isle Lake and Lessard Lake.

AHS advises to avoid all contact with blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) blooms. If contact occurs, wash with tap water as soon as possible. Do not swim or wade, or allow your pets or livestock to swim or wade in any areas where blue-green algae is visible.

# CYANOBACTERIA (BLUE-GREEN ALGAE) ADVISORY ISSUED FOR LAC STE. ANNE

Submitted by Alberta Health Services

Cyanobacteria (blue-green algae) has been identified in the waters of Lac Ste. Anne, located in Lac Ste. Anne County. Residents living near the shores of this lake, as well as visitors to this lake, are advised to take the following precautions:

- Avoid all contact with cyanobacterial blooms. If contact occurs, wash with tap water as soon as possible.
- Do not swim or wade or allow your pets to swim or wade in any areas where cyanobacteria is visible.
- Do not feed whole fish or fish trimmings from this lake to your pets.
- Consider limiting human consumption of whole fish and fish trimmings from this lake, as it is known that fish may store toxins in their liver. (People can safely consume fish filets from this lake).
- Do not use water contaminated with cyanobacteria to water edible plants. This is particularly important for plants with edible parts exposed to the ground surface (such as cabbage, lettuce, tomatoes, and other salad vegetables).

As always, visitors and residents are reminded to never drink or cook with untreated water directly from any recreational body of water, including Lac Ste. Anne, at any time. Boiling of this water will not remove the toxins produced by cyanobacteria. An alternate source of drinking water should also be provided for pets and livestock, while this advisory is active.

Cyanobacteria is naturally occurring, and often becomes visible when weather conditions are calm. Appearing like scum, grass clippings, fuzz, or globs on the surface of water, cyanobacteria can be blue-green, greenish-brown, brown, and/or pinkish-red, and often smell musty or grassy.

People who come in contact with visible cyanobacteria or who ingest water containing cyanobacteria may experience skin irritation, rash, sore throat, sore red eyes, swollen lips, fever, nausea and vomiting and/or diarrhea. Symptoms usually appear within one to three hours and resolve in one to two days. Symptoms in children are often more pronounced; however, all humans are at risk of these symptoms. Exposure to the bacteria may be fatal

to pets.

Weather and wind conditions can cause algae blooms to move from one location in the lake to another. As such, this advisory will remain in effect for Lac Ste. Anne, until further notice.

Please note that waters of Lac Ste. Anne in which the cyanobacterial bloom is NOT visible can still be used for recreational purposes, even while this Health Advisory is in place.
