As a result of the investigation, RCMP have charged 31-year old Maskwacis resident, Amie Lindsay Twins with, Second-Degree-Murder.

Twins was taken before a justice of the peace and remanded in custody with her next court appearance set for August 1, 2023, at the Alberta Court of Justice in Wetaskiwin.

As this matter is now before the courts further no further information will be released.

HIGHER CIVIL CLAIMS LIMIT NOW IN EFFECT

As of August 1, Albertans can represent themselves more effectively in civil claims court matters and save time and money on legal costs.

To make the civil claims process simpler and more cost effective, Albertans can now file civil claims of up to \$100,000 in the Alberta Court of Justice. This change is an increase from the previous limit of \$50,000 and the first time

in nine years that Alberta's government has increased the civil claims limit. Albertans will continue to have the option to pursue their civil claim at the Court of King's Bench of Alberta.

This will make the civil claims process easier for Albertans to navigate compared to the Court of King's Bench of Alberta. The Alberta Court of Justice currently handles about 10,000 civil claims annually. It is highly accessible to Albertans, with 72 locations across the province.

"This increase to the civil claims limit will make the justice system more affordable and accessible for Albertans. Our government is committed to a more effective justice system in Alberta and this is another positive step in that direction."

The higher civil claims limit will free up time in the Court of King's Bench of Alberta, as it means more matters can be heard in the Alberta Court of Justice.

"The Alberta Court of Justice has grown and evolved to meet the changing needs of Albertans. This increase reflects that evolution and our increased capacity as a forum for resolving civil disputes. This change empowers the court to handle a broader range of civil cases, easing the burden on higher courts and reducing delays in the judicial process."

PROTECT YOURSELF FROM SCAMMERS

Albertans should use caution if they receive a text message claiming

to be from government about affordability payments.

Alberta's government has received reports of text messages attempting

to defraud unsuspecting Albertans, including seniors and families who may be eligible for targeted relief payments. In one scam text, people are

asked to click on a link to register for automatic bank payments.

The Government of Alberta will never text you or make unsolicited calls to ask you for your personal information.

A secure, online application portal for affordability payments was launched by the government on Jan. 18. Families with household incomes below \$180,000 are eligible to receive \$100 per month for six months for each dependent child under 18. Seniors 65 or older who have household incomes below \$180,000 and do not receive the Alberta Seniors Benefit can also apply for monthly payments.

Anyone who cannot apply online can apply in person through any registry agent or Alberta Supports Centre.

Albertans who receive benefits through Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH), Income Support or the Alberta Seniors Benefit, or services through the Persons with Developmental Disabilities (PDD) program, are already registered for the program and will automatically receive payments.

WHAT IS PROSTATE CANCER?

Prostate cancer is the abnormal growth of cells in a man's prostate gland. The prostate sits just below the bladder. In young men, the prostate is about the size of a walnut. As men age, the prostate usually grows larger.

Prostate cancer is common in men older than 65. It usually grows slowly and can take years to grow large enough to cause any problems. As with other cancers, treatment for prostate cancer works best when the cancer is found early.

Experts don't know what causes prostate cancer, but they believe that your age, family history (genetics), and race affect your chances of getting it.

What are the symptoms?

Prostate cancer usually doesn't cause symptoms in its early stages. Most men don't know they have it until it is found during a regular medical examination.

When problems are noticed, they are most often problems with urinating. But these same symptoms can also be caused by an enlarged prostate (benign prostatic hyperplasia). An enlarged prostate is common in older men.

How is prostate cancer diagnosed?

The most common way to check for prostate cancer is to have a prostate-specific antigen (PSA) blood test. PSA tests can help find some prostate cancers early, when the cancer may be easier to treat. A large study of prostate cancer screening showed that PSA testing may prevent a small number of deaths from prostate cancer.

A higher level of PSA may mean that you have pros-

tate cancer. But it could also mean that you have an enlargement or infection of the prostate.

If your PSA is high, you may need a prostate biopsy to figure out the cause. A biopsy means that your doctor takes tissue samples from your prostate gland and sends them to a lab for testing.

How is prostate cancer treated?

Your treatment will de-

pend on what kind of cancer cells you have, how far they have spread, your age and general health, and your preferences.

You and your doctor may decide to manage your cancer with active surveillance or to treat it with surgery or radiation.

If you are over age 80 or have other serious health problems, like heart disease, you may choose not to have treatments to cure

your cancer. Instead, you can just have treatments to manage your symptoms. This is called watchful waiting.

Choosing treatment for prostate cancer can be confusing. Talk with your doctor to choose the treatment that's best for you. You may also wish to call Health Link at 811 to speak with a Registered nurse.

ENJOY WATER ACTIVITIES SAFELY THIS SUMMER

Summer means it's time to get outside and enjoy the weather. For many Albertans, that may mean time at the lake or by a pool or river.

There is always a risk of injury when you're around water or swimming, especially in unmonitored bodies of water. Here are some ways you can prevent water-related injuries and illness:

- Wear a Canadian-approved life jacket or personal flotation device in a

boat and make sure it fits.

- Young children should wear life jackets when they are in, on or around the water. Stay right beside your child and be aware of fast-moving water.

- Swim with others when there is no lifeguard present and be cautious in open water such as lakes or rivers.

- Avoid alcohol, cannabis and any other substance that may affect your judgment before and during water activities.

Lakes, rivers and streams may also contain disease-causing microorganisms or parasites that can

cause allergic reactions (swimmers' itch). Not all beaches are monitored for biological, chemical, and physical hazards. Check cyanobacteria (blue-green algae) advisories by visiting Active Health Advisories | Alberta Health Services or look for posted advisory signs at public beaches. Reduce your chance of getting swimmers' itch:

- Dry yourself with a towel as soon as you leave the water.

- Avoid beaches where swimmers' itch is a problem.

- Wash your hands and

rinse your body off after swimming or wading in lakes, streams or rivers.

- Don't wade or swim in areas with weeds.
