POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE LOCATING 29-YEAR-OLD MAN

The Edmonton Police Service is seeking the public's assistance in locating a 29-year-old male who was last seen yesterday evening.

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Submitted by Yellowhead County

Public Hearing – A Public Hearing was held for proposed Bylaw No. 05.23 to repeal Bylaw no. 24.02 (Hinton West Urban Fringe Area Structure Plan) as it doesn't align with the Intermunicipal Development Plan. The proposed bylaw will be brought back to an upcoming Council meeting for continued deliberation.

Letter of Support – Council approved a letter of support for Novus Earth Energy Operation's Latitude 53 project. Latitude 53 is a proposed geothermal facility in Yellowhead County.

Policy Updates – Council rescinded policies 1100.02 and 1100.05 and adopted policies 1100.01 through 1100.23. The new policies can be found in the September 26, 2023 Council Agenda Package.

Public Library Request for Funding – A request for \$378,000 towards the Edson & District Public Library renovations will be included in the upcoming 2024 budget discussions. This amount is in addition to funds previously committed by Yellowhead County towards the project.

Grand Trunk School Facility Usage – Council did not approve funding assistance of \$5,000 to the Grande Yellowhead Public School Division (GYPSD) towards rental costs of the Pembina Rec-Plex. GYPSD is looking for locations and financial support for Grand Trunk High School physical education classes while their school is being renovated. The Pembina Agricultural and Recreation Society (PARS) will continue to work with the school to help meet their needs.

Road Plan Closure Request

– Council denied a road plan closure request for Road Plan 1260EU in SW-34-52-19-W5M. Closure of the road plan would no longer guarantee public access on this road plan and would go against Council policy.

Public Access Policy – Council will look at options to amend the County's Road Allowance Policy (3200.04) at a future council meeting to provide road plan adjacent property owners options for their land while still allowing road plans to remain accessible to the public under a set of prescribed criteria.

Niton Fire Station Tender – Council approved the tender for the construction of the Niton Fire Station to the lowest bidder, Vantage Builders for \$2,024,000. The amount was \$672,850 over the budgeted amount but was approved to prevent additional potential future cost increases.

The additional funding will come from the Facilities Replacement Reserve.

Wildfire Damage – Due to damage caused from the wildfire fighting efforts this spring, the repair and replacement of Yellowhead County Fire Department equipment and vehicles was approved by Council in the amount of \$367,632 from the Equipment Replacement Protective Services Reserves, as well as of \$185,702.45 for the repair and replacement of portable emergency radios and batteries from the Equipment Replacement Communications System Reserve.

Wildfire Finance Admin Support – Council approved funding for a new temporary position for administrative work associated with the 2023 Spring Wildfires.

Work continues by the Town of Edson and Yellowhead County towards the construction of a Multi-Use Facility for the region.

the-art multiplex facilities, including complex renovation projects. The firm's extensive experience and sustainable design approach make them an ideal firm for this project.

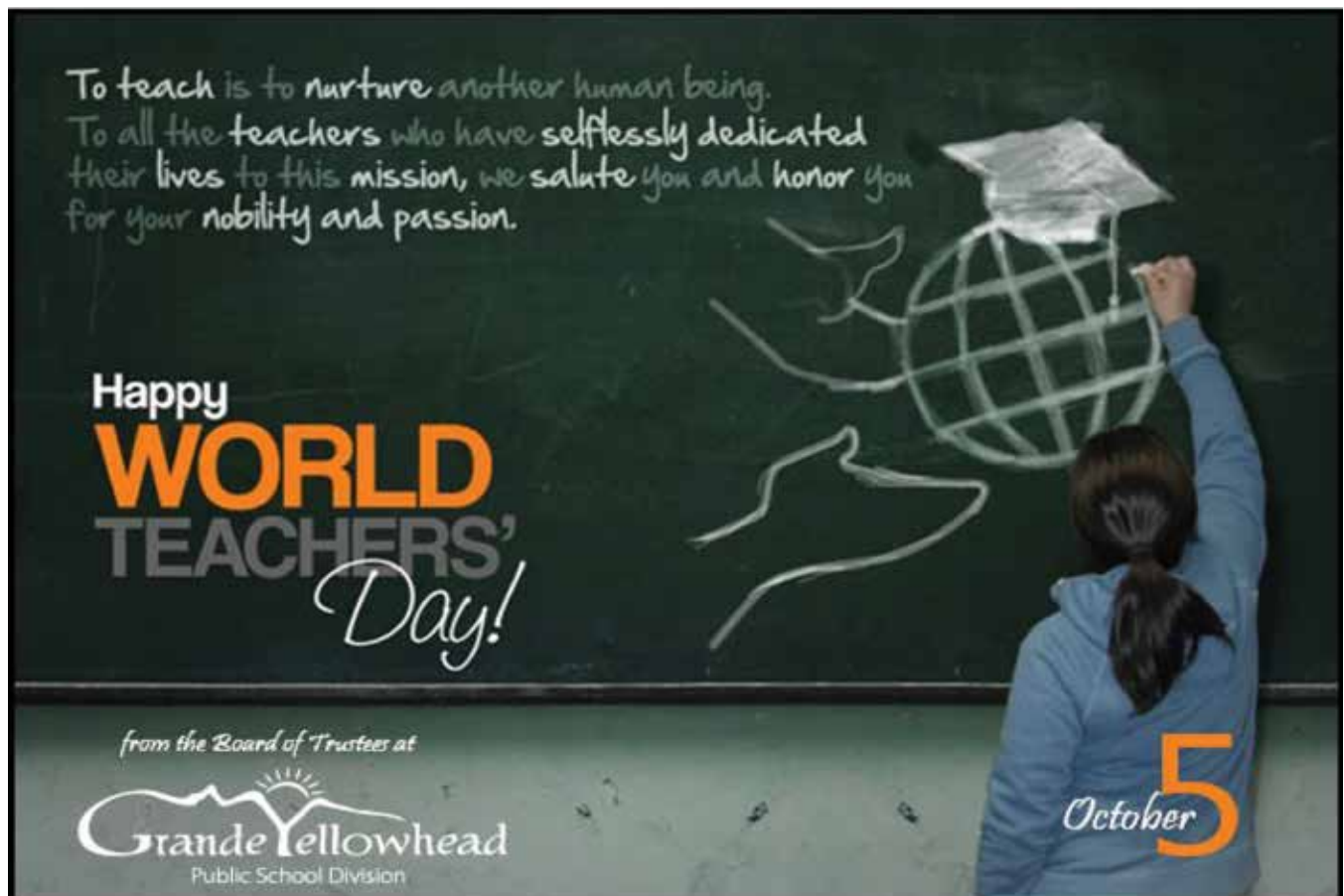

12 WAYS TO MAXIMIZE VERTICAL SPACE

Who hasn't, at one point in their lives, lamented a lack of space and organization at home? A lifetime's worth of items have to be kept somewhere, and without the right organizational strategy, clutter can quickly take over.

7. Take kitchen cabinets all the way to the ceiling. Store lesser used items on the uppermost shelves and the items you use each on the most accessible shelves.

8. Install a shelf over the entryway to a room to utilize this seldom-used space. Shelves also can be custom cut and placed

in oddly shaped areas, such as in attic rooms under the eaves or on slanted walls.

9. Dowels or curtain rods and some fabric can be used to fabricate slings to hold books or magazines.

10. Invest in some magnetic boards that can hold keys or notes by the front door or store knives on a kitchen wall.

11. Install two towel bars parallel to one another on the wall of a bathroom. These can hold extra toilet tissue or rolled hand towels.

12. Use rope plant hangers to store potatoes or onions near prep areas. The same plant hangers can wrangle stuffed animals and small toys in kids' rooms.

Utilizing vertical areas

in a home is a great way to increase storage capacity and keep rooms more organized.

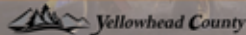

Auto TUNE-UP

HOW TO DRIVE MORE EFFICIENTLY

Many people aspire to drive more efficiently in an attempt to conserve fuel, save money and reduce the carbon footprints of their vehicles. But driving efficiently can also make driving safer for motorists, their passengers and everyone else, including pedestrians, sharing the roads.

Drivers who want to drive more efficiently can implement a variety of strategies to do just that.

- Obey the speed limits. Speed limits are determined with safety in mind, and drivers should always adhere to posted speed limits to protect themselves, their passengers and others on the road. The U.S. Department of Transportation notes

that, in 2015, 27 percent of motor vehicle crash deaths were speeding-related. But according to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, obeying the speed limit is also cost-effective. The EPA notes that miles per gallon begins to dip dramatically when vehicles travel above 55 miles per hour. While each vehicle is different, the EPA notes that increasing highway cruising speed from 55 miles per hour to 75 miles per hour can raise fuel consumption by as much as 20 percent.

- Do not idle a vehicle. The Environmental Defense Fund notes that electronic engines do not need to warm up, even in winter when temperatures are especially cold.

Vehicles that are idling can produce as much pollution as vehicles that are in motion, and idling for as little as 10 seconds wastes more gas than restarting the engine. Drivers concerned about overtaxing their engines shortly after starting them can warm their engines by easing into their drives and avoiding excessive revving.

- Use cruise control wisely. Drivers concerned about fuel economy may be accustomed to turning on their vehicles' cruise control when driving long distances on the highway. While that is an effective and fuel-efficient way to maintain steady speeds, turn cruise control off when traversing roads with steep hills. On such roads,

fuel efficiency can be lost because the vehicle engine is working harder to maintain steady speeds.

- Tighten the gas cap. When gas caps are loose, fuel evaporates. The Car Care Council notes that loose, missing or damaged gas caps contribute to the evaporation of roughly 147 million gallons of gas per year. That's both wasteful and costly. When filling up at the gas station, turn the cap until your hear it click.

Driving efficiently can make roadways safer, benefit the environment and save drivers considerable amounts of money.
