WESTLOCK RCMP RECOVER STOLEN VEHICLES AND LAY CHARGES

Submitted by Westlock RCMP

On Oct 3, 2023, at 9:15 a.m. Westlock RCMP were notified of a break and enter to a local business where two pickup trucks were stolen.

One of the pickups had tracking services which were utilized and provided its location to Police. Westlock RCMP along with the assistance of Parkland RCMP, Mornville RCMP, Barrhead RCMP, and Westlock Traffic Services were engaged and located both vehicles and arrested

the occupants.

A search of the vehicles resulted in the seizure of 22.05 grams of suspected Methamphetamine, 6.78 grams of suspected Heroin, and 5 ml of suspected Fentanyl.

As a result of that investigation, Ryan Calvin Grant (40), a resident of Busby, AB, Wallace Arthur Millar (40), Charlotte Gileen Mills (38), Rodney Wendell Prince (56), residents of Barrhead, AB, have been jointly charged with:

- Mischief over \$5,000
- Possession of break in tools

• Possession of stolen property
Prince and Mills were also charged with:

- Possession for the purpose of trafficking Methamphetamine
- Possession for the purpose of trafficking Heroin
- Possession for the purpose of trafficking Fentanyl

Trina Mae Paul (31), a resident of Alberta, has been charged with:

- Mischief over \$5,000
- Possession of break in tools
- Possession of stolen property

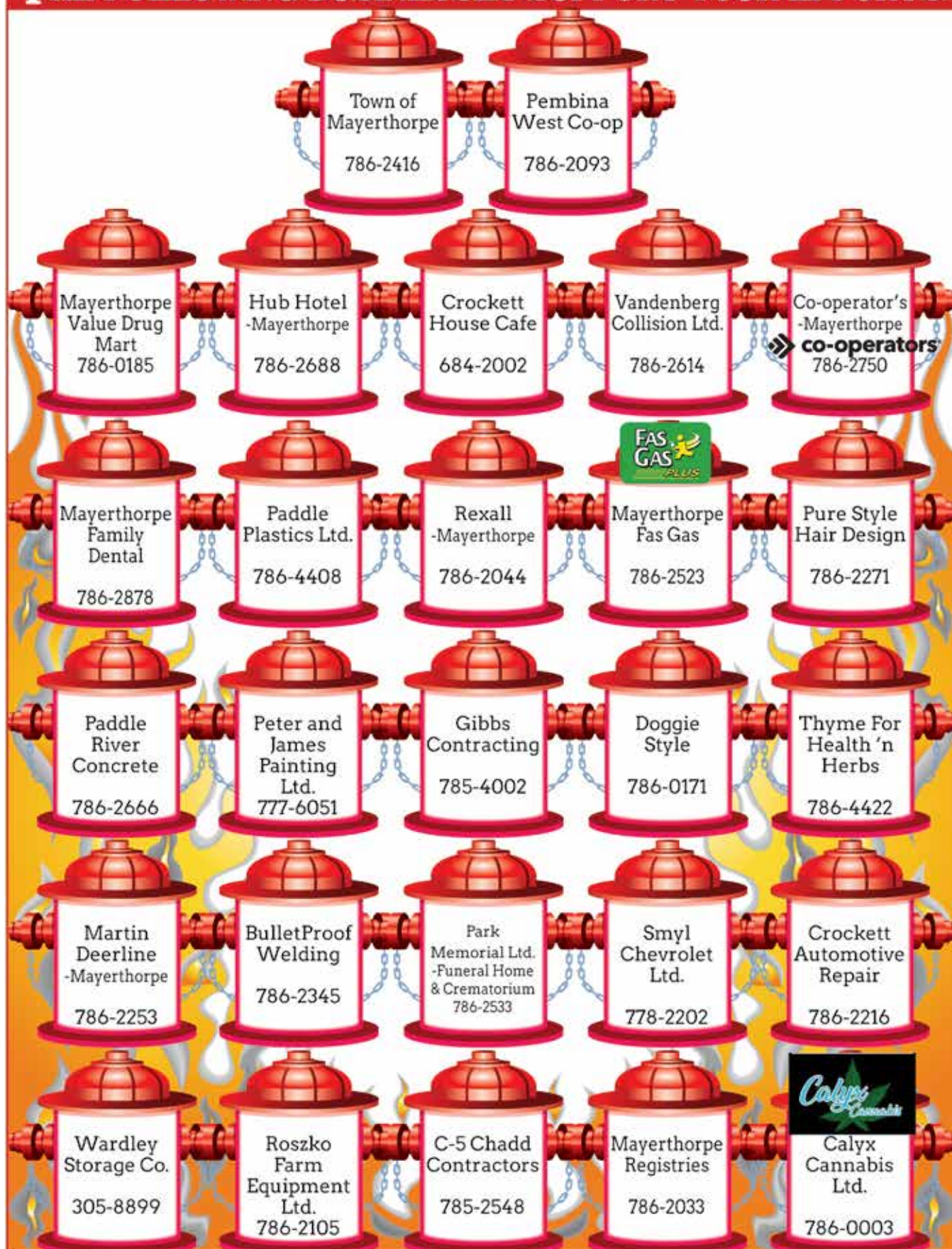

- Store matches and lighters in a place where children cannot reach them.
- Keep space heaters at least three feet from curtains, newspapers and other things that can burn, and never leave heaters unattended.
- Have your chimney, furnace, fireplace and wood or coal stove inspected every year.
- Install smoke alarms on every level of your home and inside or near every bedroom. Test alarms monthly, and replace batteries once a year.
- Develop and discuss a home fire escape plan with your family. Identify two exits from every room, and pick a meeting place outside the home.

- KEEP THINGS THAT CAN BURN, SUCH AS DISHTOWELS AND PLASTIC BAGS, AT LEAST THREE FEET AWAY FROM THE RANGE TOP.
- THOROUGHLY SOAK CIGARETTE AND CIGAR BUTTS WITH WATER BEFORE DUMPING THEM IN THE TRASH.
- NEVER LEAVE BARBECUE GRILLS UNATTENDED WHILE IN USE.
- NEVER LEAVE BURNING CANDLES UNATTENDED.
- DON'T OVERLOAD ELECTRICAL OUTLETS, EXTENSION CORDS AND POWER STRIPS.

Follow these 9 tips to help protect yourself, your family and your property against fire hazards.

1. Install a fire alarm in every sleeping area and on every level of your home, and be sure to test alarms every month. Working smoke alarms reduce the risk of death in a home fire in half.

2. Check the manufacture date on the back of your home's smoke alarms. Smoke alarms should be replaced at least every 10 years! Batteries should be replaced every year.

3. Never leave burning candles unattended, and always keep matches and lighters out of reach from children.

4. Make a fire action plan, so every member of your household knows how to escape and where to meet outdoors.

5. Over half of home heating fire deaths are caused by equipment being placed too close to things that can burn. Make sure furniture, clothing, mattresses and bedding are at least three feet from heating sources.

6. Always turn off space heaters when you leave the room or go to sleep. Space heaters are the cause of about 79 percent of fatal home heating fires.

7. Remain in the kitchen when frying, grilling or broiling food. Turn off the stove whenever you leave the kitchen, and never leave home while food is cooking.

8. Inspect electrical cords regularly, and replace cords that are cracked or damaged or have broken plugs or loose connections.

9. In the event of a fire, crawl to safety. Use the back of your hand to see if a door is hot before opening it. If it feels hot, try to use another exit.

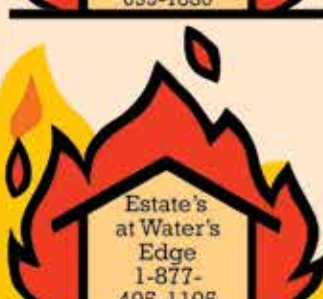
