## TACKLING IMPAIRED BOATING ON ALBERTA'S WATERWAYS

A new pilot program will help keep Albertans safe this summer by removing impaired boaters from lakes and rivers.

Operating a boat while under the influence of alcohol

or drugs places everyone at risk and is one of the leading factors in recreational boating deaths in Alberta. To help tackle this issue, Alberta Fish and Wildlife Enforcement Services (FWES) has launched a pilot program this summer to enhance safety on lakes and

rivers by targeting potential impaired boaters in key areas.

Between May 16 and Sept. 1, fish and wildlife officers will enhance their patrols on lakes and rivers in and around Spruce Grove, Wetaskiwin, Ponoka,

Call 1-800-667-0604 to book an appointment or learn more about the program. A mammogram is an X-ray of the breast. Screening mammograms are the best way to find breast cancer early when treatment may work better. Getting screened for breast cancer saves lives.

Individuals aged 45 to 74 can discuss their breast cancer risk with their healthcare providers to determine whether screening is appropriate for them and book with a radiology clinic or with Screen Test mobile mammography.

# Tackling Impaired Boating On Alberta's Waterways

Camrose and Red Deer with the ability to determine the sobriety of boat operators by using Approved Screening Devices (ASDs) – commonly known as breathalyzers. If there is reasonable suspicion that the boat operator has consumed alcohol, fish and wildlife officers will administer breath tests. If the officer determines the operator is impaired, they will be arrested for further processing and could face criminal charges.

"Alberta families have a right to enjoy our beautiful summers safely. The pilot program we've announced today sends a clear message: impaired boating has no place on Alberta's waterways. Full stop. Operat-

ing a boat while impaired is just as dangerous and illegal as driving a car impaired. I want to commend our fish and wildlife officers for taking concrete steps to prevent accidents and keep Albertans safe."

During routine patrols where fish and wildlife officers monitor for compliance with fishing regulations, they will also check for valid boating licences and compliance with safety equipment requirements, monitor speed and wake

zones, and educate Albertans on responsible boating practices.

tool to better detect those suspected of boating while impaired and enhances our ability to ensure a safe and enjoyable boating season for everyone."

to cancer screening – particularly in rural, remote and Indigenous communities.

Launched as a pilot in 2022, the Alberta Lung Cancer Screening Program was designed to assess whether a provincially coordinated approach could improve lung cancer outcomes through earlier detection and timely treatment. After a promising launch, it is being extended with a \$2-million investment and an additional \$500,000 from the Alberta Cancer Foundation. This funding will allow the pilot to continue offering screenings to eligible individuals for an additional year while plans are finalized to transition the program to a

permanent, provincewide program.

“We’re making progress, with more people in Alberta surviving lung cancer than ever before, but more work remains. That’s why we’re funding the Alberta Lung Cancer Screening Program to support early detection and improved patient outcomes.”

Treatment for early-stage lung cancer is significantly more effective, less burdensome for patients and their families, and more cost-effective for the health care system. Since its launch, the Alberta Lung Cancer Screening Program has screened more than 3,800 eligible people in Alberta,

with almost 90 per cent of detected lung cancers identified at an early stage.

"Late-stage lung cancer is much harder to treat or cure because the cancer has already spread to other parts of the body or there's too much cancer in the lungs. Screening with low-dose CT scans can detect lung cancer earlier, before someone has symptoms."

More funding available for screening, prevention

Detecting cancer early is crucial to saving lives, and Alberta's government continues to make early detection more accessible and easier to navigate.

The Cancer Research in Screening and Prevention Program is providing about \$3 million to support cancer prevention and screening initiatives to improve health outcomes for people living in Alberta, including research, education, marketing and public policy development. Eligible Alberta-based health agen-

cies and organizations, post-secondary institutions, non-profits, First Nations and Métis communities, as well as municipalities, can apply for funding under the program.

Four organizations received funding for their projects in 2024:

- Alberta Health Services – Optimizing screening for subsequent primary cancers in recipients of hematopoietic cell transplantation – \$343,518
- Lakeland Métis Nation Association – Lakeland Métis Nation cancer screening awareness program – \$600,000
- Siksika Health Services – Siksika Nation cancer screening and prevention – \$997,850
- University of Al-

berta – A Phase 3 randomized trial of prostate cancer screening using high resolution micro-ultrasound versus MRI – \$987,000

# SUPPORTING ALBERTA'S WILDFIRE EVACUEES

Alberta's government provides emergency evacuation payments to assist those who have been forced from their homes for an extended period of time.

Emergency evacuations due to the threat of a wildfire or other natural disaster can cause incredible emotional and financial stress for those affected. To help ease the costs of evacuating and provide some peace of mind, Alberta's government provides emergency evacuation payments to assist those who have been forced from their homes for an extended period of time.

"Being forced from your home is one of the most difficult things a family can face. Our government is here to support Albertans every step of the way – helping cover urgent costs and providing reassurance during an incredibly stressful time. We're committed to ensuring families have the help they need, when

they need it most."

Each adult resident of an affected community who has been evacuated for seven days or more is eligible to receive a one-time payment of \$1,250 and \$500 for each dependent child under the age of 18. These evacuation payments help pay for temporary accommodations, food and other necessities while evacuees are away from their homes. Most insurance policies will also provide coverage for additional living expenses if the insured are forced to leave due to a disaster.

"Whether flood or fire, evacuations due to natural disasters can be incredibly stressful. As always, our government is working hard to ensure help is there for those who need it and do everything we can to support Albertans through this wildfire season."

Evacuees can apply for the payments online and

will have up to 60 days to apply following the start of an evacuation order for their respective community. Payments will be made by e-transfer within 24 hours of application, which is the fastest and most efficient way to receive these payments. Evacuees unable to apply online or receive e-transfer can call the Alberta Supports Contact Centre at 1-877-644-9992 for assistance and to make alternate payment arrangements.

"In the face of floods and fires, Alberta's government remains committed to providing essential support and resources to protect and assist Albertans during this wildfire season, ensuring that help is always within reach for those affected."

tans or those in acute financial need who may need additional financial support for items such as food, clothing, transportation and temporary shelter as they leave their community should contact the Income Support Emergency Contact Centre at 1-866-644-5135.
