PARKLAND RCMP REQUESTING PUBLIC ASSISTANCE IN A HIT AND RUN INVESTIGATION

The Parkland RCMP are investigating a hit and run collision that occurred on June 3, 2025 at the intersection of Harvest Ridge and Grove Drive in Spruce Grove between the hours

of 3:30PM and 4:00PM. A youth on their scooter was going through the designated pedestrian crosswalk when they were struck by a vehicle sustaining injuries, the vehicle driver waited for the youth to stand up before driving away.

The vehicle is described

as a black car with a female driver. The Parkland RCMP is attempting to ID the vehicle and the driver and ask anyone in the area at the time of the incident to review their dashcam footage.

Students can start applying for Alberta and Canada student financial assistance for the 2025-26 academic year starting on June 2.

attend a post-secondary institution. Students are encouraged to apply at least 60 days in advance of their study period start date.

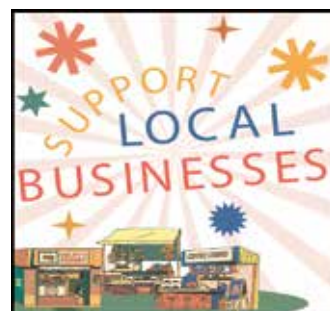

ST. ALBERT RCMP WARN PUBLIC OF FRAUD SCAM

St. Albert RCMP are warning the public about a fraud scam that saw a local senior lose close to \$100,000 over the past year. The individual believed they were sending money to an investment platform put on by the Liberal Party and its Leaders. It started by clicking on a fake AI generated "Liberal Investment Ad" on Facebook and signing up for this

investment scheme. After the senior signed up to the investment scam, the fraudsters would reach out via online messaging or by phone, asking for money transfers to invest. Months past before family members became aware of the money transfers, and realizing it was a scam.

St. Albert RCMP want to remind the public that fraud can happen to anyone. These fraudulent individuals are professional criminals, their online scams are elaborate,

sophisticated, and very convincing. In 2024, Investment Fraud cost Canadians \$310 million dollars.

Over the last few weeks, being out of the legislature and meeting with regular folks has been an absolute godsend. As I tend to get focused on the Economic Corridor

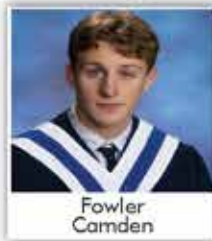

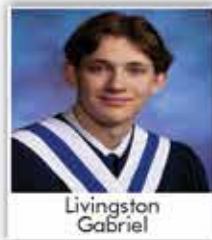

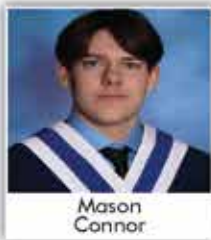

CONFIRMED CASE OF MEASLES PROMPTS PUBLIC ALERT TO POTENTIAL EXPOSURES

Alberta Health Services (AHS) has been notified of a person with confirmed measles from outside of Edmonton Zone who travelled to Edmonton and has been in a public setting while infectious. Additional locations may be released if necessary. Individuals who were in the following location during the specified dates and times may have been exposed to measles:

Location:

112th Street Entrance, Foyer, and Information Desk, University of Alberta Hospital

Exposure time periods:

May 28: Exposure time: Approx. 7 p.m. - 9:45 p.m.

Anyone who attended this location at these times, who was born in or after 1970 and has less than two documented doses of measles-containing vaccine, may be at risk for developing measles. They should self-monitor for symptoms of measles and are strongly encouraged to review their immunization records.

Measles is an extremely contagious disease and the virus spreads easily through the air. Symptoms of measles include:

- Fever of 38.3° C or higher; and
- Cough, runny nose and/or red eyes; and
- A rash that appears 3 to 7 days after fever starts, usually beginning behind the ears and on the face and spreading down to the body and then to the arms and legs. The rash appears red and blotchy on lighter skin colours. On darker skin colours, it can appear purple or darker than the skin around it, or it might be hard to see.

Complications of measles can include ear infections, pneumonia, inflammation of the brain, premature delivery, and rarely death. Persons who are pregnant, less than 5 years of age, or have weakened immune systems are at greatest risk of serious complications.

If symptoms of measles do develop, individuals are advised to stay home and call the measles hotline at 1-844-944-3434 before visiting any healthcare facility or provider, including a family physician clinic or pharmacy.

Measles vaccine is highly effective at preventing infection and complications. In Alberta, measles vaccine is offered, free of charge, through Alberta's publicly

funded immunization program. The recommended schedule for measles vaccination is two doses, the first at one year of age and the second at 18 months.

If you think you have been exposed, and you are not protected against measles you may be able to receive immunization to reduce the risk of infection. A dose of vaccine needs to be given within 72 hours of exposure to prevent measles. Babies under 1 year of age, people with severely weakened immune systems, and those who are pregnant may be able to receive immunoglobulin within 6 days of exposure to prevent disease. Call the measles hotline at 1-844-944-3434 for more information if these situations apply to you or your family.

Albertans uncertain of their immunization history, or their child's immunization history, can check eligibility and/or book an appointment by calling the measles hotline at 1-844-944-3434.

Individuals who are 14 years of age and older can check their My Health Record.

The measles hotline connects you to a professional who can assist with access-

ing your immunization records or offer general information; provide advice for those experiencing measles symptoms and are feeling unwell; and assist with booking measles immunization appointments or locating a public health clinic offering immunization in your area.

You can also text 'Measles' to 88111 to get measles health information texted to your mobile device.

BUILDING SAFER FUTURES FREE FROM FAMILY VIOLENCE
