## **INVESTING IN DIPLOMACY TO** STRENGTHEN ECONOMIC TIES

MLAs van Dijken and Pitt will travel to the U.S. in June to build on progress made with lawmakers to protect and deepen the ties that bond our economies.



## CONFIRMED CASE OF MEASLES PROMPTS PUBLIC ALERT TO POTENTIAL EXPOSURES

Alberta Health Services (AHS) has been notified of a person with confirmed measles from outside of Edmonton Zone who travelled to Edmonton and has been in a public setting while infectious. Additional locations may be released if necessary.

Individuals who were in the following location during the specified dates and times may have been exposed to measles: Location:

112th Street Entrance, Foyer, and Information Desk, University of Alberta Hospital

Exposure time periods:

May 28: Exposure time: Approx. 7 p.m. - 9:45 p.m.

Anyone who attended this location at these times, who was born in or after 1970 and has less than two documented doses of measles-containing vaccine, may be at risk for developing measles. They should self-monitor for symptoms of measles and are strongly encouraged to review their immunization records.

Measles is an extremely contagious disease and the virus spreads easily through the air. Symptoms of measles include: - Fever of  $38.3^{\circ}$  C or higher; and

• Cough, runny nose and/or red eyes; and

• A rash that appears 3 to 7 days after fever starts, usually beginning behind the ears and on the face and spreading down to the body and then to the arms and legs. The rash appears red and blotchy on lighter skin colours. On darker skin colours, it can appear purple or darker than the skin around it, or it might be hard to see.

Complications of measles can include ear infections, pneumonia, inflammation of the brain, premature delivery, and rarely death. Persons who are pregnant, less than 5 years of age, or have weakened immune systems are at greatest risk of serious complications.

If symptoms of measles do develop, individuals are advised to stay home and call the measles hotline at 1-844-944-3434 before visiting any healthcare facility or provider, including a family physician clinic or pharmacy.

Measles vaccine is highly effective at preventing infection and complications. In Alberta, measles vaccine is offered, free of charge, through Alberta's publicly funded immunization program. The recommended schedule for measles vaccination is two doses, the first at one year of age and the second at 18 months.

If you think you have been exposed, and you are not protected against measles you may be able to receive immunization to reduce the risk of infection. A dose of vaccine needs to be given within 72 hours of exposure to prevent measles. Babies under 1 year of age, people with severely weakened immune systems, and those who are pregnant may be able to receive immunoglobulin within 6 days of exposure to prevent disease. Call the measles hotline at 1-844-944-3434 for more information if these situations apply to you or your family.

Albertans uncertain of their immunization history, or their child's immunization history, can check eligibility and/ or book an appointment by calling the measles hotline at 1-844-944-3434.

Individuals who are 14 years of age and older can check their My Health Record.

The measles hotline connects you to a professional who can assist with accessing your immunization records or offer general information; provide advice for those experiencing measles symptoms and are feeling unwell; and assist with booking measles immunization appointments or locating a public health clinic offering immunization in your area.

You can also text 'Measles' to 88111 to get measles health information texted to your mobile device.


## ALBERTA RCMP MAJOR CRIMES UNIT INVESTIGATES HOMICIDE IN MASKWACIS


On June 1, 2025, at 5:23 a.m. Maskwacis RCMP received a report of a shooting at a residence in Samson Cree Nation. Upon arrival, emergency responders located a 20-yearold male deceased. The deceased was taken to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner and the cause of death was determined to be homicide.

The deceased has been identified as Travis Jason Crier who also goes by Raven Crier.

"This is another tragic and senseless loss of a four nations community member. There is a direct relationship between this death and illegal firearms in Maskwacis. The community is saying it, we are saying it, and our leaders are saying it: enough is enough" says Inspector Richard McKay Detachment Commander Maskwacis RCMP. "During our meetings with the Chiefs and Counsels of all 4 Nations of Maskwacis, illegal guns and gun violence are a serious concern and one they want combatted. It's important that residents know they will have our full cooperation and support. If you know of the existence of illegal guns, there are ways to reach out to us safely, Call us." June 11, 2025




