PARKLAND RCMP RESPONDS TO VEHICLE COLLISION WITH DAYCARE

Parkland RCMP would like to advise the public that the evacuation order for the area around the daycare has been lifted as Atco has deemed it

safe. 48 street should reopen for travel in the area shortly though police will remain on scene to continue their investigation. Though investigation is ongoing, initial information ob-

tained by RCMP revealed that there were 18 children and 2 adults in the daycare. A female employee in her 20s was transported to hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

ALBERTA RCMP MAJOR CRIMES UNIT INVESTIGATES AGGRAVATED ASSAULT UPDATED

On May 28, 2026, RCMP Major Crimes Unit charged Neil Gow (52), a resident of Evansburg, with aggravated assault, dangerous driving causing injury and flight from police, because of this incident. After a Judicial

Interim Release Hearing, Gow was remanded into custody to appear in Albert Court of Justice in St. Albert on June 1, 2026. On May 28, 2026, the victim, Danielle Sanders (46), also an Evansburg resident, passed away in hospital. An autopsy was performed on May 29, 2026,

at the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner in Edmonton, and the cause of death was ruled a homicide. On June 1, 2026, the charge of aggravated assault was withdrawn, and a new charge of manslaughter was issued. The investigation continues.

ALBERTA RCMP ARREST MALE IN VEHICLE THEFT INVESTIGATION

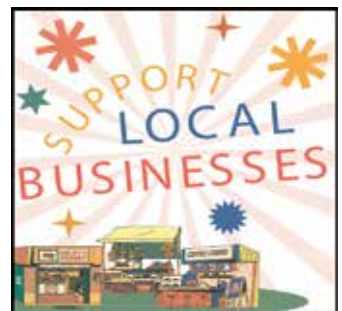

On May 12, 2026, Parkland RCMP initiated an investigation into a series of vehicle thefts exhibiting similar pat-

terns throughout Parkland County. The stolen property included multiple vehicles, including a white F350, a trailer, and several all-terrain vehicles.

Through investigative efforts, the Parkland RCMP Crime Reduction Unit (CRU) identified a male suspect linked to the incidents and began

Pursuant to Sections 216.1(1), 606(1), and 692(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended, the Council of the Summer Village of Seba Beach hereby gives notice of its intention to consider Bylaw No. 05-2026, a bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 5-2019 Summer Village of Seba Beach/Parkland County Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP). The purpose of this amendment (Bylaw 05-2026) is to include future opportunities for commercial uses in the IDP Plan Area and a specific change of future land use for a parcel of land located at SE-12-53-6-W5M from R- Residential District to C- Commercial District to facilitate future commercial land uses.

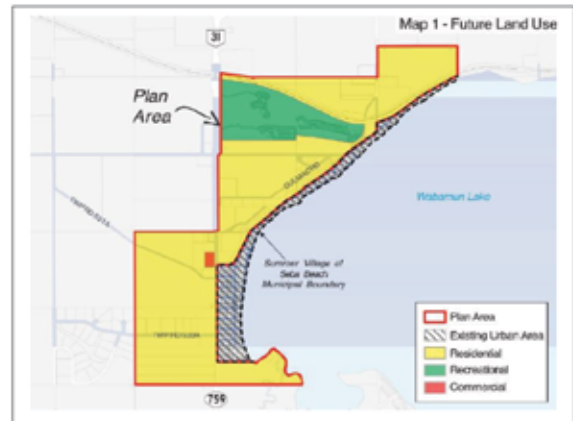

Bylaw 05-2026 Amendments to Bylaw 5-2019 Summer Village of Seba Beach/Parkland County Intermunicipal Development Plan			

The Summer Village of Seba Beach Council will consider the following amendment:

Intermunicipal Development Plan

An Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP) Amendment Application, which proposes to amend the Summer Village of Seba Beach/Parkland County IDP, Bylaw 5-2019 (Summer Village of Seba Beach) and Bylaw 2019-09 (Parkland County). Both a text and map amendment are being proposed to the IDP, to support commercial uses on a portion of SE-12-53-6-W5M and includes amendments as follows:

- 5.7 **Commercial** – The Plan Area shall allow for a variety of high-quality commercial, tourism, and recreational Uses that provide services to surrounding communities. The following uses shall be prohibited in the Plan Area:
- i. Vehicle Services, Maintenance and Sales, Light
 - ii. Vehicle Services, Maintenance, and Sales, Heavy
 - iii. Crematorium
 - iv. Data Processing Facility

approximately two and a half hours, the vehicle was observed driving into oncoming lanes, including on Highway 16. The individual narrowly avoided multiple collisions with members of the public, driving at high rates of speed, through fences, farmers fields; and ditches.

Police were eventually able to immobilize the vehicle. The

suspect then exited and ran toward a dark grey Ford F150 in attempt to steal it. RCMP Emergency Response Team and Alberta RCMP CRT intervened, pinning the vehicle and preventing it from moving. The individual exited from the passenger side and attempted to flee on foot but was quickly arrested without further incident.

Brad Turlock, (34), a prolific

offender of no fixed address, has been charged with multiple offences, including:

- Flight from Police;
- Dangerous operation of a motor vehicle;
- Have face disguised with intent to commit offence;
- Mischief over \$5,000 damage to motor vehicle (x2); and
- Property obtained by crime \$5,000 (x6).

Brad Turlock has been remanded into custody with his next court appearance on June 3, 2026, at the Alberta Court of Justice in Edmonton.

“The behaviour we observed that day was an extraordinary risk to public safety. The individual continued driving erratically, regardless of whether police were in view or not,” said Sergeant Collin Kuca of the Parkland RCMP plainclothes unit. “Our priority is to protect the public, and we took every measure available to bring the situation under control and ensure the individual was safely taken into custody.”

PARKLAND RCMP RESCUE STRANDED BOATERS ON DEVIL’S LAKE

On Jun. 3, 2026, at approximately 7:55 p.m., Parkland RCMP received a report of a disabled inflatable sport boat on Devil’s Lake, just East of Onoway. An adult male and two children were on board when the motor failed, leaving the vessel stranded in weeds.

The adult male was prepared and made extensive efforts to restart the motor; however, once exhausting all available options they contacted police for assistance. Thanks to the detailed information provided by the caller, first responders were able to quickly deploy the detachment boat, locate the adult male and two children, and safely rescue them without incident.

9.1 ACCESSORY BUILDINGS AND USES

9.1.2 In residential districts, all accessory buildings, including detached garages and guest houses (garage suites and garden suites) shall be located according to the following:

- d. An accessory building shall not be more than 9.0 m (29.5 ft.) 4.5 m (14.8 ft.) in height, unless it is a garage suite on the second floor over a garage, in which case the accessory building shall not exceed 9.0 m (29.5 ft.) in height.

EXPANDING CAPACITY FOR DEATH INVESTIGATIONS

Submitted by Government of Alberta

Alberta's government is investing in critical infrastructure and technology to strengthen death investigations and provide faster answers for grieving families.

To meet the needs of a growing population, Budget 2026 is investing \$125 million over four years for a new facility for the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) in Edmonton. Budget 2026 also includes \$4.4 million to replace and upgrade toxicology equipment to improve the detection of new and emerging synthetic drugs.

The new Edmonton facility will support the OCME to complete death investiga-

tions more quickly and help provide faster answers for grieving families. The new facility will offer expanded and specialized space for examinations and autopsies, improved laboratory and storage capacity, and enhanced ability to respond to complex cases and mass casualty events.

"By building a new Edmonton facility and upgrading the tools used by our forensic experts, we are strengthening a service that Albertans rely on in some of their most difficult moments, helping families get more timely answers, supporting the justice system and maintaining the highest standards of medical examiner services."

The new toxicology equipment will improve identifying and measuring alcohol, drugs and opioids in deceased individuals. With this addition, the lab will continue to operate at a high standard with faster completion times, im-

proved accuracy and stronger reliability.

ONE CARD. THAT'S IT.

Submitted by Government of Alberta

Starting July 2, driver's licences and ID cards will include your health number and citizenship marker – just one safe, secure card for the services you rely on.

Alberta government one card



Alberta's government is issuing new and renewed cards that will incorporate personal health numbers and Canadian citizenship markers. By combining identity, personal health numbers and citizenship

information on one document, Albertans will no longer need to carry multiple pieces of ID to access programs and services.

The new cards will feature a new modern design that is reflective of the province's rich history and identity. The new cards also include enhanced security features that will help protect against fraud. Over time, this transition will reduce and ultimately eliminate the need for paper Alberta Health Care cards.

"These redesigned cards are more than a visual update. They are a practical improvement that will make life easier for Albertans. The new features modernize Alberta's driver's licences and ID cards, making them more secure, more reliable and more useful for everyday service access. Having one secure card is a prac-

tical improvement that will better serve Albertans now and into the future."

Albertans applying for or renewing a driver's licence or ID card will need to show proof they are legally entitled to be in Canada. Those who confirm Canadian citizenship will have a citizenship marker added to their card. Eligible non-citizens can still obtain a licence or ID card, and a one-time 60-day grace period may be available for Albertans needing additional time to obtain the required documents.

"These new cards will make accessing services simpler and more convenient for eligible Albertans. By integrating personal health numbers into driver's licences and ID cards,

we are streamlining access to health services and improving how information connects across the system, making care more efficient and responsive for Albertans."

To add the personal health number onto their card, eligible Albertans must bring their Alberta Health Care card, valid ID and proof of legal entitlement when applying for or renewing a driver's licence or ID card. Registry agents will verify Alberta Health Care eligibility in person, including for dependent family members. Once this process is complete, the personal health numbers will be added to the licence or ID card.

FOREST TENT CATERPILLARS

Forest Tent Caterpillars are once again being spotted in Yellowhead County this summer. This puts us in year 2 of an outbreak.





What to Know:

- Populations peak approximately every 10 years, with outbreaks lasting from 2 to 5 years.
- They are easily identified by the blue stripes running down the length of the body, and a row of white, key-shaped markings down the back.
- They often appear in large clusters and feed on host trees. Once a cluster has completely defoliated a tree, they will move together to a new location.
- While healthy trees usually survive an infestation, you may wish to remove them. To do so, you can **scrape** the caterpillars off the host tree, or use a strong jet of water to **blast** them off.
