LEDUC RCMP ARRESTS MALE AFTER SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY COMPLAINTS

On May 29, 2026, the Leduc RCMP received multiple complaints about a male suspect wearing a black Chicago Bulls hoodie and beige mask in the Meadowview area of Leduc. The suspect entered a home without permission, then was seen entering neighboring yards and behaving

suspiciously. The suspect was located and arrested by responding members.

Dustin Slade Yellowbird, a 29-year-old of no fixed address, is facing the following charges:

- Unlawfully in a dwelling house
- Disguise with intent
- Obstruction
- Breach Probation

Yellowbird was held for

a judicial interim release hearing. He was remanded into custody and is set to appear in the Alberta Court of Justice in Leduc on June 11, 2026.

Starting July 2, driver's licences and ID cards will include your health number and citizenship marker – just one safe, secure card for the services you rely on.

Alberta government one card

Alberta's government is issuing new and renewed cards that will incorporate personal health numbers and Canadian citizenship markers. By combining identity, personal health numbers and citizenship information on one document, Albertans will no longer need to carry multiple pieces of ID to access programs and services.

The new cards will feature a new modern design that is reflective of the province's

rich history and identity. The new cards also include enhanced security features that will help protect against fraud. Over time, this transition will reduce and ultimately eliminate the need for paper Alberta Health Care cards.

“These redesigned cards are more than a visual update. They are a practical improvement that will make life easier for Albertans.

DRAYTON VALLEY COMMUNITY MEMBERS LAUNCH NEW FRIENDS OF MEDICARE CHAPTER

Community members from the Drayton Valley region have come together to launch the newest regional chapter of Friends of Medicare. This follows a recent town hall hosted by Friends of Medicare in Drayton Valley, where residents voiced their experiences with Alberta's health care and concerns about local access to care services, and determined it timely to get involved in advocating to protect and strengthen public health care in the Drayton Valley and surrounding Brazeau County communities.

At their founding meeting earlier this month, members elected an inaugural chapter board, including new Chapter Chair, Dr. Mike Murphy. Dr. Murphy brings a wealth of experience in health care, having worked as a family doctor in Drayton Valley and Evansburg for 38 years until his retirement in 2025.

"I have seen many changes for the better and for the worse in our health care system, from local governance to centralized management that takes little or no input from the public or health care providers," said Murphy. "Sooner or later, we will all require health care services in some form or other. Our new Drayton Valley Chapter of Friends of Medicare aims to support and protect access to these services for everyone in our town and surrounding rural communities."

The Drayton Valley Chapter is the latest community to launch a local Friends of Medicare chapter, joining Calgary, Fort McMurray Wood Buffalo, Leduc-Beaumont, Lethbridge, Palliser (Medicine

Hat), Red Deer (Central Alberta), and St. Albert-Sturgeon earlier this year.

"The continued expansion of Friends of Medicare's collective work reflects growing frustrations we continue to hear from Albertans when it comes to our health care: people simply can't access the health care services they need," said Chris Galloway, executive director of Friends of Medicare. "And in Drayton Valley, it's no different. This community-like so many

across Alberta right now—have had enough, and they're rising to the challenge of advocating for our treasured public health care."

Friends of Medicare members and supporters in the region are encouraged to join this group of advocates in their work to protect and strengthen public health care in the region and across the province.

"We invite all who are interested to join our chapter to support our efforts that are

focused on everyone's right to equal and timely access to quality health care," said Murphy. "We have significant work to do to support our local health care services and your support could certainly make the difference in making this happen."

Friends of Medicare's Drayton Valley Chapter's next meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 17 at 7:00 pm at Beehive Support Services Association (5056 50 Avenue).

ELECTIONS ALBERTA LAUNCHES LARGEST RECRUITMENT DRIVE IN ALBERTA'S HISTORY

Today, Elections Alberta is launching the largest electoral event worker recruitment campaign in Alberta's history and one of the largest referendum recruitment efforts ever undertaken in Canada ahead of the province's upcoming referendum on October 19, 2026.

With ten ballot questions, Elections Alberta will print 45 million ballots, far exceeding the 1.8 million ballots cast in Alberta's 2023 provincial general election and the 19.8 million ballots cast in Canada's 2025 federal general election.

To achieve the 48-hour deadline to complete the unofficial ballot count, a minimum of 60,000 workers will be required.

"This referendum will be a colossal undertaking and requires Albertans to work together to deliver the upcoming referendum. Working with us in the coming months provides a great

opportunity for students, teams, community groups, and Albertans from all walks of life to get involved in the democratic process," said Gordon McClure, Chief Electoral Officer.

Seeking to recruit more than 60,000 workers for the upcoming referendum

All Alberta residents 16 years or older and eligible to work in Canada are welcome to apply. Some positions will require applicants to be 18 years or older, all election workers will need to pass a criminal history check, and election workers will be unable to participate in any political activity during their employment. Elections Alberta is a non-partisan, independent Office of the Legislature, and all election officers must sign an oath requiring them to uphold the non-partisan mandate of the Office during the Referendum.

For day-to-day operations, Elections Alberta is staffed by 48 permanent staff. This expands significantly during election pe-

riods.

During the 2023 Alberta provincial general election, Elections Alberta hired 13,095 election workers, with the total cost for the election coming to approximately \$37 million.

Recruiting more than 60,000 workers for the upcoming referendum is no small task. For context, the 1995 Quebec referendum required the recruitment of 57,000 electoral workers to assist the 4.8 million voters and manage polling stations.

How to apply

Interested Albertans can apply online at <https://recruitment.elections.ab.ca/8400/8>.

Applicants are encouraged to apply early and should apply separately for each role they are interested in. Successful applicants will begin to be notified starting in mid-July.

Applications will be directed to the Returning Officer for the applicant's electoral division based on their residential address. Applicants may also be asked to

work in electoral divisions adjacent to where they live.

Applicants are asked to be patient due to the large volume of roles being recruited for and applications received. Only selected candidates will be contacted. Please do not contact Elections Alberta to inquire about the status of your application.

About the positions

Positions will include Election Officers who staff the voting places and Counting Officers who are responsible for vote-counting once voting places close.

A variety of roles are available including:

- Site Supervisors,
- Information Officers,
- Voting Officers,
- Ballot Box Clerks,
- Registration Officers,
- Record Clerks,
- Count Supervisors,
- Count Coordinators, and
- Count Officers.

All positions are paid, and the time commitment varies depending on the role. Some positions will begin October 13, with paid training scheduled in early October prior to the position start date. The training will involve a mix of online and in-person, depending on the role.

Applications from rural Albertans are especially encouraged to help support referendum administration and vote counting across the province.

Positions are available for the following periods:

- Advance Voting – October 13 - 17, 2026,
- Election Day – October 19, 2026, and
- Counting Ballots – October 19 - 21, 2026.

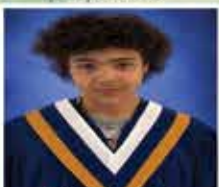

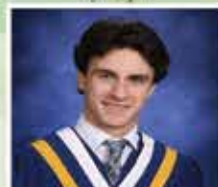
